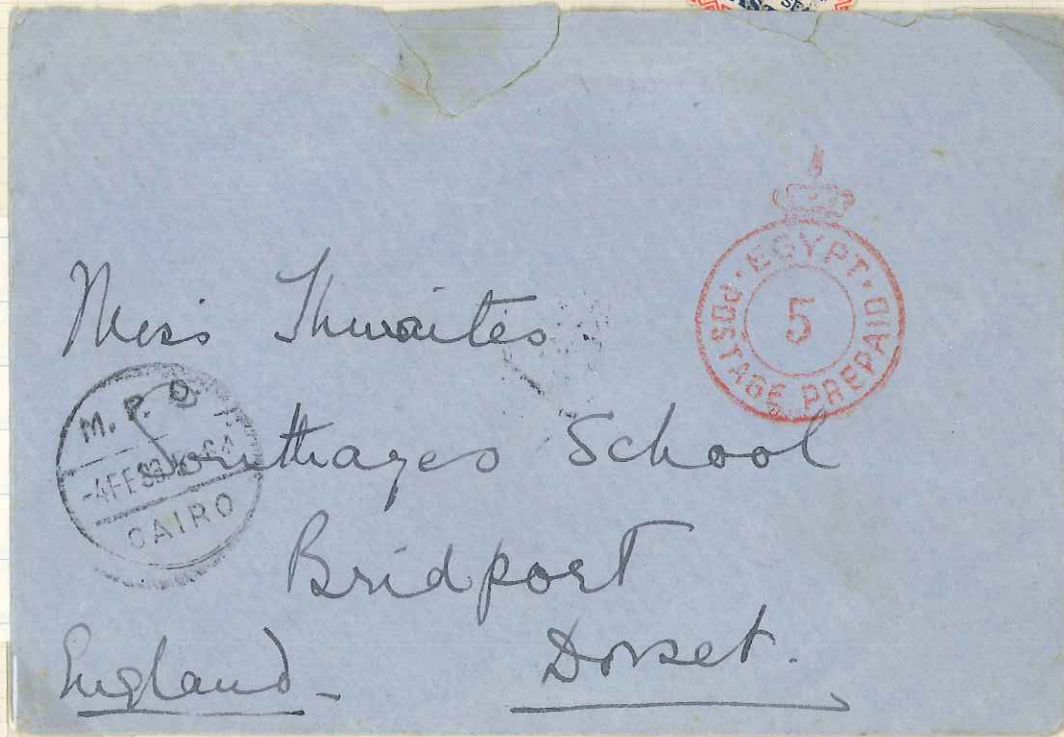

BRITISH FORCES IN EGYPT

From 1 Nov. 1932 members of British Forces in Egypt and their families were allowed to send letters to the British Isles at reduced rates. Special seals on sale at NAAFI Institutes had to be placed on reverse of envelopes.

1932 Seal inscribed 'POSTAL SEAL'



August inscription changed to 'LETTER SEAL'
