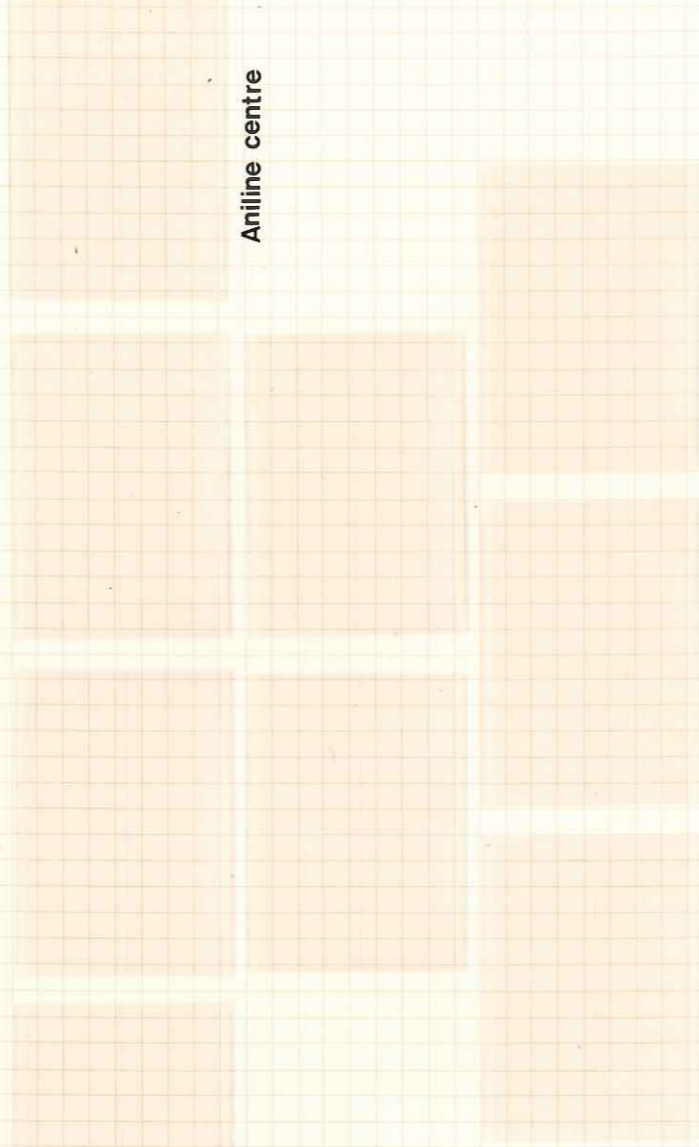

Type I.

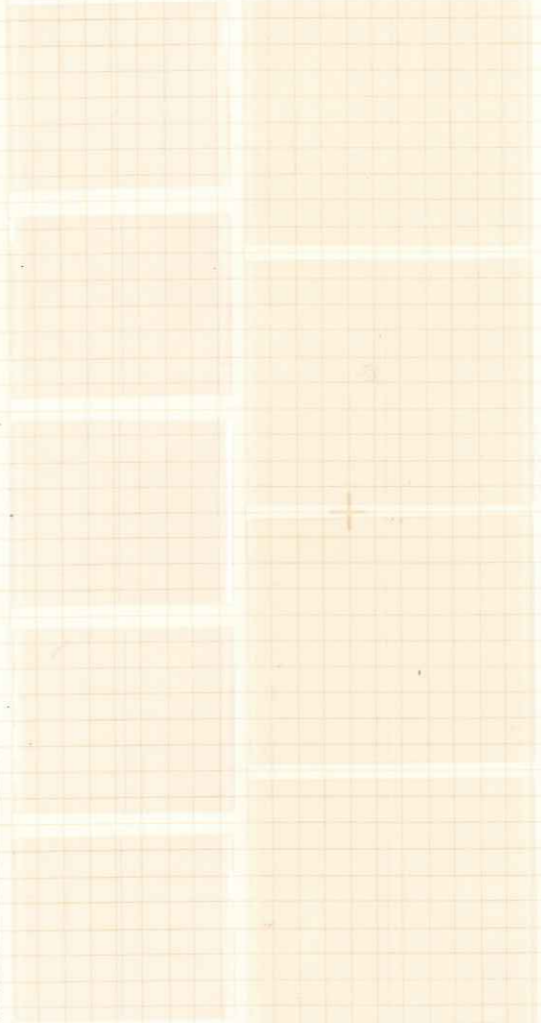

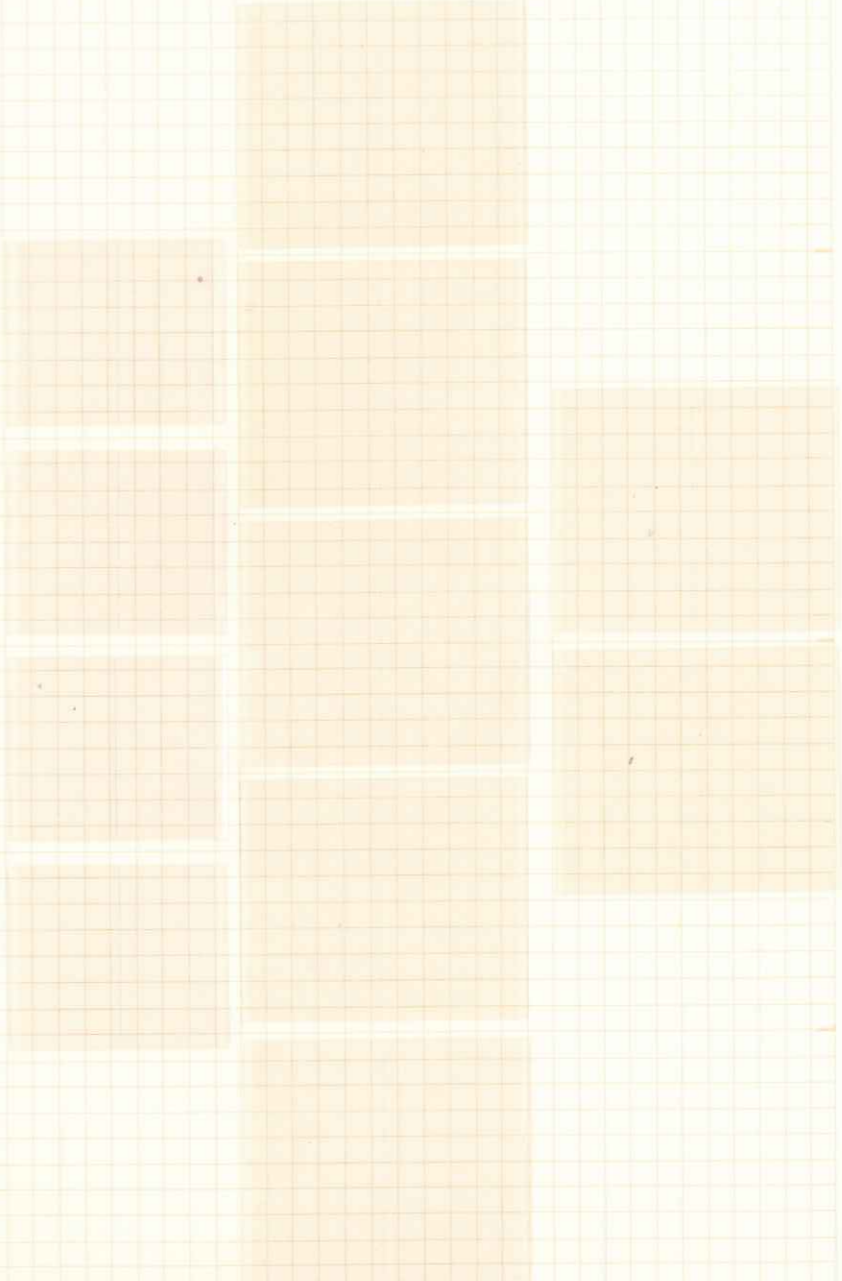

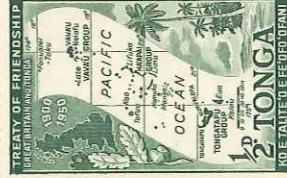
