Fairoaks, Pennsylvania (backstamp) to Luzern, Nov. 20-Dec. 3, 1929

Prepaid rate: 5 cents/20gr, 3c/20gr, 3c/20gr = 11c postage + 15c registration fee = 26c

Deficiency: 9c = 45c gold = 54c Swiss

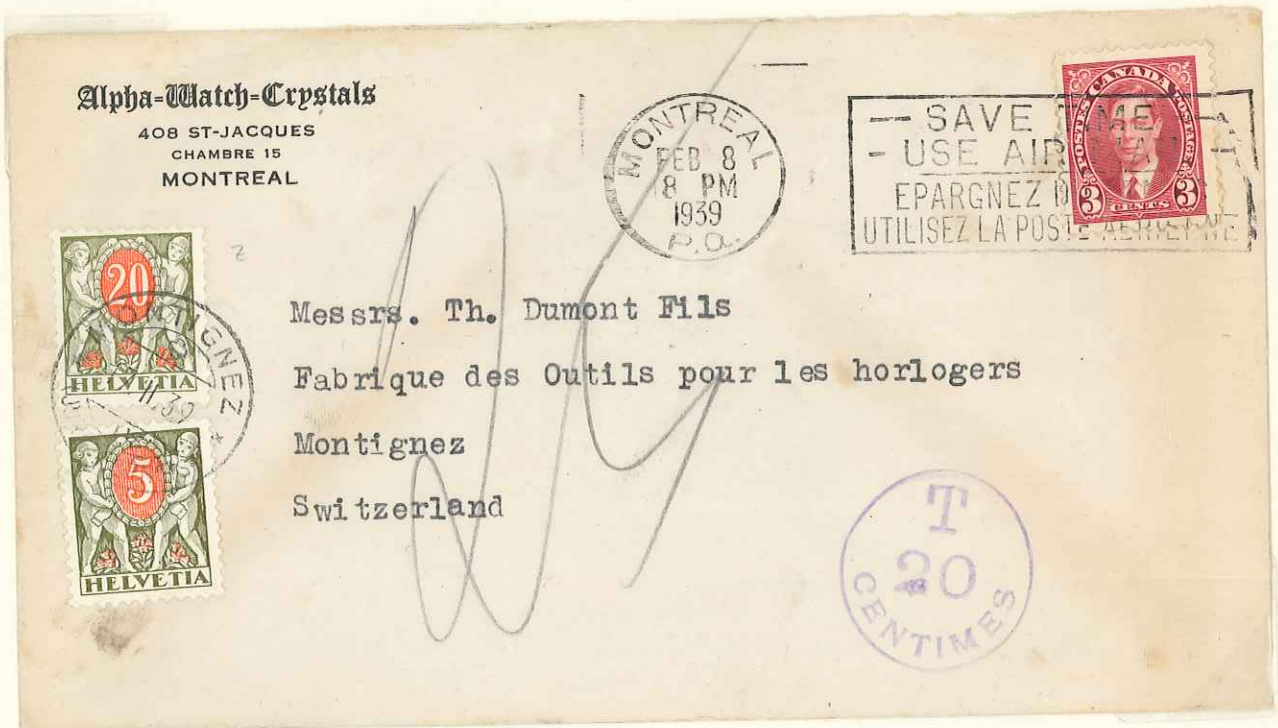
Postage due: 2 x 54c Swiss = 108c rounded up to 110c

Underpaid Letter: Air Mail Surtax



Lake Arrowhead, California, United States, to Bern, May 16 to 26, 1936.
 Prepaid rate: 8 cents/1oz x 2 for **domestic air mail** and trans-Atlantic surface mail
 + 3¢/½oz for **European air mail** via France for 29½gr = 25¢.
 Deficiency: 10¢ U.S. = 50c gold = 60c Swiss. Postage due: 2 x 60c Swiss = 120c.

Underpaid Letter: Misused U.S. Rate



Montreal, Canada, to Montignez, Feb. 8 to 17, 1939. Prepaid: **special 3¢ U.S. treaty rate**.
 Prepaid rate: 5¢/1oz. Deficiency: 2¢ Canadian = 10c gold = 12c Swiss. Tax handstamp:
 20c double deficiency in gold. Postage due: 2 x 12c Swiss = 24c rounded up to 25c.

February 1, 1921, Swiss Increased Postage Rates

Higher Prepaid Swiss Rates

Letter	40c/20gr
Card	25c
Printed Matter	10c/50gr

Minimum postage due charge of 25c introduced on January 1, 1922.

February 1, 1921, Swiss Increased Postage Rates

Europe: France

Underpaid Letter: Too Little Postage Due



Philadelphia, United States, to Florence, Italy, July 10 to 30, 1923.

Prepaid rate: 5 cents/1 oz,

Deficiency: 3¢ U.S. = 15c Latin = **60c Italian**.

Postage due: 2 x 60 Italian = 120c.

Forwarded to France, arriving on ?

Postage due: 120c Italian = 30c Latin = **60c French**,
but **France mistakenly charged only 30c** (single instead of double deficiency).

Forwarded to Lucerne, Switzerland, arriving Aug. 15.

Postage due: 30c French = 15c Latin = **24c Swiss, rounded up to 25c**.

Switzerland correctly based its postage due on incorrect preceding French charge,
according to international procedures.

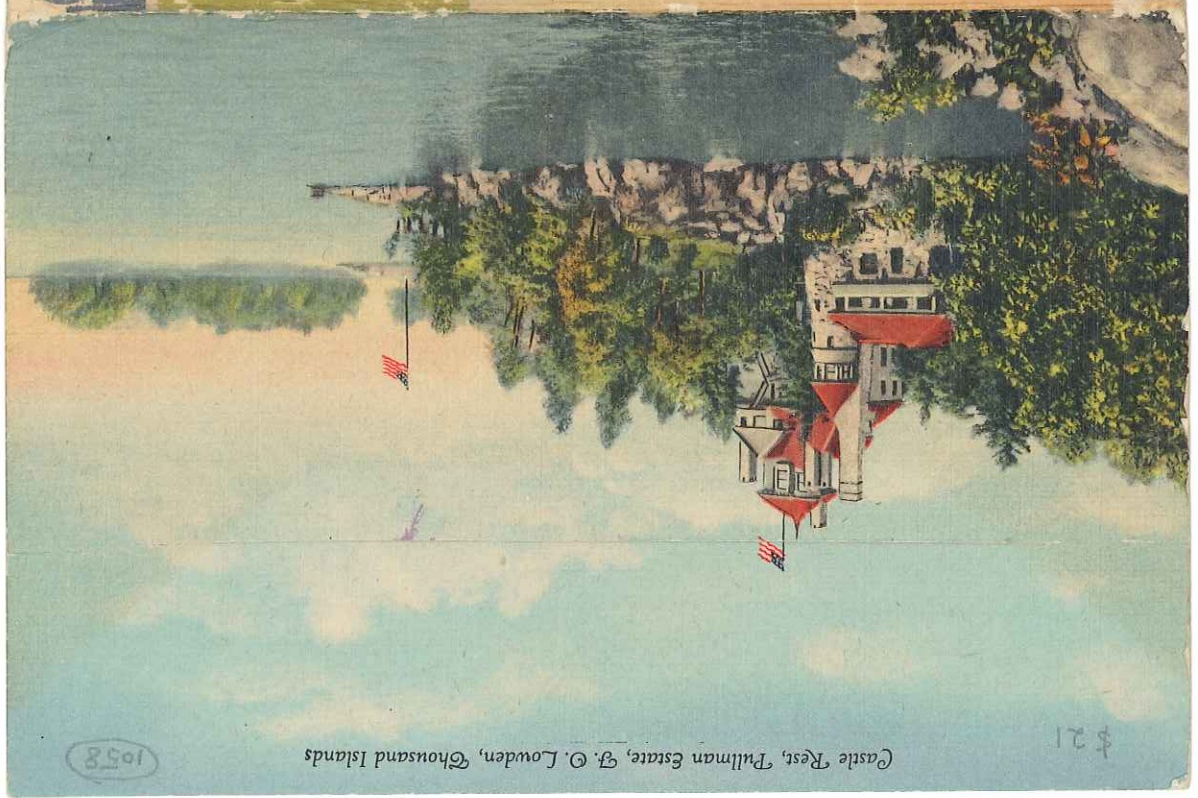

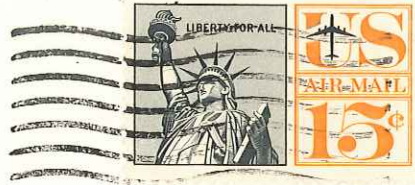

April 1, 1879, UPU Charges

North America: United States

Underpaid Letter: Unacceptable Private Photo Postcard



New York, New York, to Lüsslingen, Canton Soleure, Oct.5-16,1901. Payment: 2 cents for **French card with unacceptable photo and Swiss stamps**. Prepaid rate: 5 cents/ $\frac{1}{2}$ oz for letter. Deficiency: 3¢ U.S. = 15c Latin = 15c Swiss. Postage due: 2 x 15c Swiss = 30c. Postage due stamps: 1900 olive-green Type II (25th printing), 10c normal, 20c inverted.

Underpaid Letter: Two-Country Postage Due

Allegheny, Pennsylvania, to London, England (backstamp), Mar.2-13,1906. Prepaid rate: 5 cents/ $\frac{1}{2}$ oz x 2 for $\frac{1}{2}$ -1oz = 10¢. Deficiency: 5¢ U.S. = 25c Latin = 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ pence British. Postage due: 2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ p British = 5p, but letter forwarded to Geneva, arriving Mar.15. Postage due: 5p British = 50c Latin = 50c Swiss. Due stamp: 1900 dark olive-green Type II normal (25th printing).

TWICE-FORWARDED MAIL

UNITED STATES



Boston to Alameda, California, Nov.26-30,1915

Prepaid correctly 2 cents/loz

Forwarded to Kusnacht, Switzerland, arriving Dec.23.

Prepaid rate: 5¢/20gr

Deficiency: 3¢ = 15c gold = 15c Swiss

Postage due: only missing 15c Swiss for forwarded mail

Refused (etiquette), postage due stamp annulled (ungultig), sent to dead letter office (rebutts) at Zurich, and returned to sender in United States

Deficiency: 15c Swiss = 15c gold = 3¢ U.S.

Postage due: only missing 3¢ U.S. for forwarded (returned) mail

1948 Swiss Increased Postage Rates

North America: United States

Underpaid Letter: Overtaxed



Miami Beach, Florida, United States, to Bern, July 2 to 17, 1950. Prepaid rate: 5¢/1oz. Deficiency: 2¢ U.S. = 6c gold = 8.58c Swiss. Tax mark: 12c double deficiency in gold. Postage due: 2 x 8.58c Swiss = 17.16c. **Double deficiency incorrectly doubled again** to 34.32c Swiss, rounded up to 35c, and collected on 2nd attempt on July 20.

Underpaid Letter: Undertaxed



New Canaan, Connecticut, United States, to Geneva, Feb. 13 to 16, 1953. Prepaid rate: 15¢/½oz x 2 for ½-1oz = 30c. Deficiency: 24¢ U.S. = 72c gold = 102.96c Swiss. Postage due: 2 x 102.96c Swiss = 205.92c. Tax mark: "145" = 144c gold double deficiency rounded up to 145c. **Incorrect collection: 145c instead of 210c Swiss.**
