First day set for Griffith stamp

The first day of issue ceremony for the D. W. Griffith 10-cent U.S. commemorative stamp will be held in Beverly Hills, Calif., on May 27, the U.S. Postal Service reports.

According to USPS it is expected that Postmaster General Benjamin F. Bailar and many film notables will participate in the ceremony, to be hosted by the American Film Institute at Greystone, its Center for Advanced Film Studies.

Collectors interested in first day cancellation of the stamp honoring motion picture pioneer Griffith should send requests to "D. W. Griffith Stamp, Postmaster, Beverly Hills, Calif. 90213."

Ten cents and a self-addressed envelope should be enclosed for each stamp to be canceled. The envelope with canceled stamp will be returned through the mail.



The D. W. Griffith stamp features a predominant brown color, applied by the Giori press, with green, blue, violet and pink being added by offset.

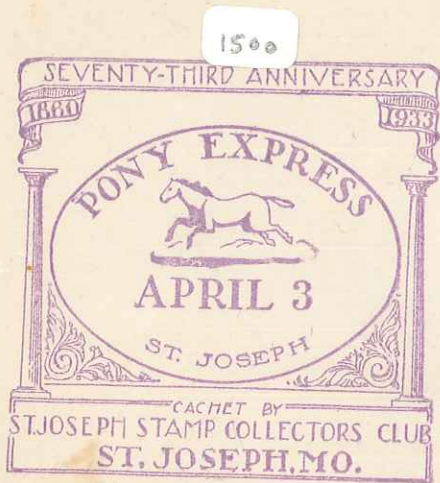
