I have used the freedom of giving your name to Fort Duquesne, as I hope it will in some measure be the being actuated by your spirits that now measure the being of the place. I hope the name Fathers will take (it) under their Protection, in which case these dreary deserts will soon be the richest and most fertile of any possess'd by the British in N^o. America."

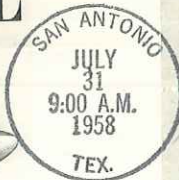

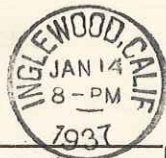

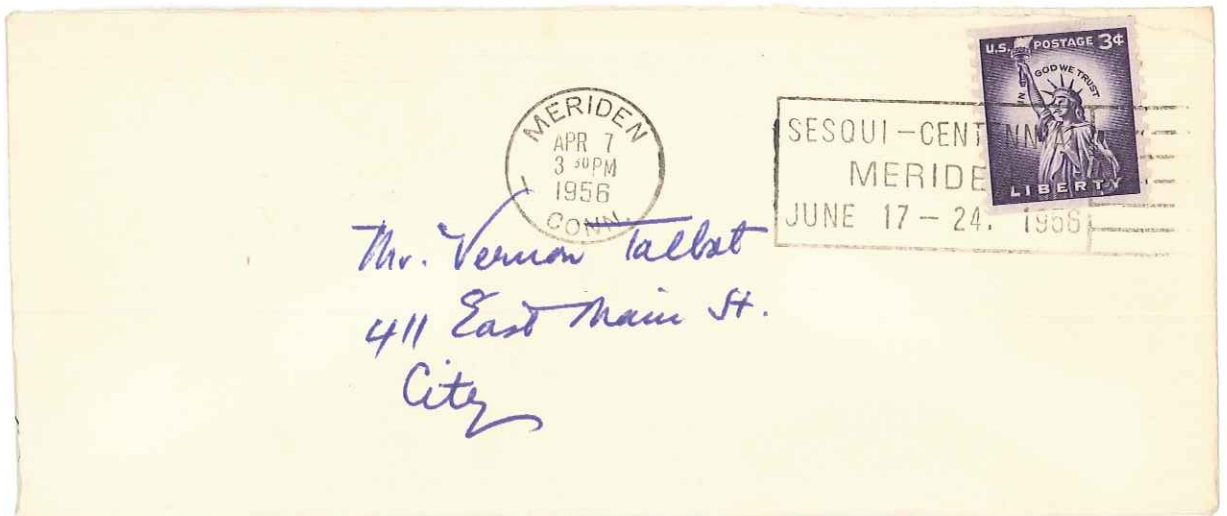
