

Saudi Arabia

1937, Postage Due 1 qr. (pair) and 1 ½ qr. (pair), cancelled in manuscript, on censored underpaid business envelope from Edinburgh (17.7), franked 2 ½ d. to Mecca via Jeddah (transit cds. 19.8 on reverse), with "T" postage due cachet.

The first postage due stamps of the Kingdom are extremely rare postally used.

Commercial airmail cover with 2x20 Öre from Stockholm (17.1) with on reverse Berlin-Sassnitz TPO (18.1), Alexandria "RECU PAR AVION" (21.1), Port Taufiq (22.1) and Jeddah arrival cds. (25.1).
