



I examined the air mail cover sent from Daharam on October 1950 and direct to Denmark, franked with two copies of ½ guerch, two copies of 5 guerches and ¼ of guerch charity tax stamp (Stanley Gibbons 331, 338 and 348).

To take advantage of more frequent B.O.A.C. flights transiting from Bahrain direct to Europe, the envelope was embarked on the daily flight of Gulf Aviation directed in Manama, Bahrain. To explicitly indicate the demand for this route, on the envelope was affixed the black linear seal "VIA BAHRAIN" of clear made locally. Here is a photo reproduction united.

In my opinion the cover in its entirety is original, as well as postmarks and stamps are in very fine condition. Given the rare use of this routing seal, recorded only in two other covers, I signed it:
