



*I examined the air mail cover sent from Djeddah on 5 May 1958, franked with ½ guerch postage and 3 and 4 guerches air stamp + ¼ of guerch charity tax stamp (Stanley Gibbons n 331, 351, **358** and 359 of Saudi Arabia). The 3 guerches air stamp show an indisputable lack of perforation. Here is a photo reproduction united.*

In my opinion the cover in its entirety is original, as well as postmarks and stamps are in very fine condition. Given the rare occasional use on cover of unperforated air stamp of 3 Guerches blue, moreover mentioned as "existing but not issued" in the SG catalog, I signed it:
