In my opinion the Tibetan cover illustrated here is

a genuine cover of the 1933 issue sent from Lhasa via Phari to Gangtok in Sikkim 1945.  
Postmarked a blurred Lhasa postmark Hellrigl T42 and a Gangtok arrival postmark.

This is Waterfall number W150 and W177, both in a Deep Scarlet-Vermilion 10C8 colour

Although opened so the British India stamp is damaged this has little importance  
since covers from Tibet to Sikkim are very scarce.
