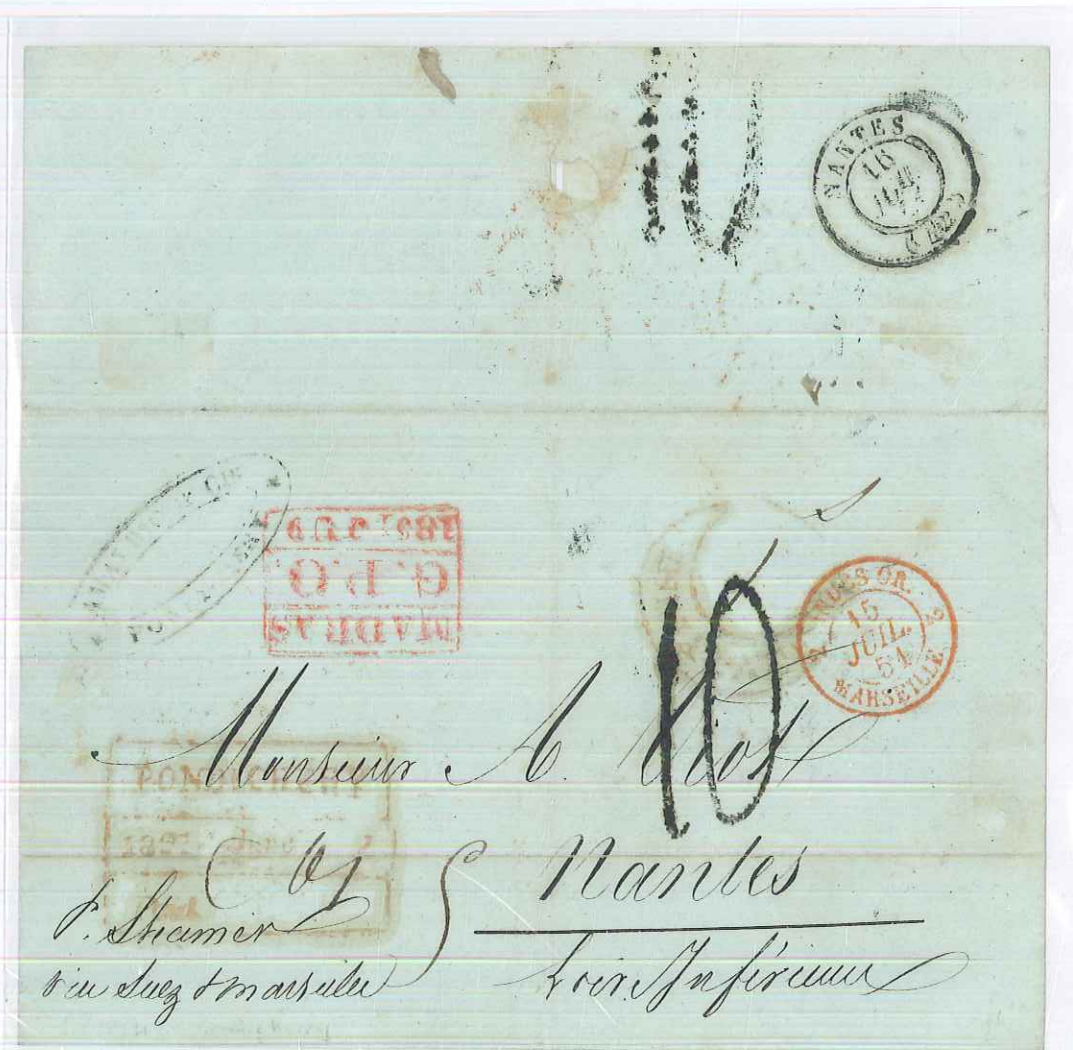

The Tri-Segmented bearing Handstamp used as a receiving mark.



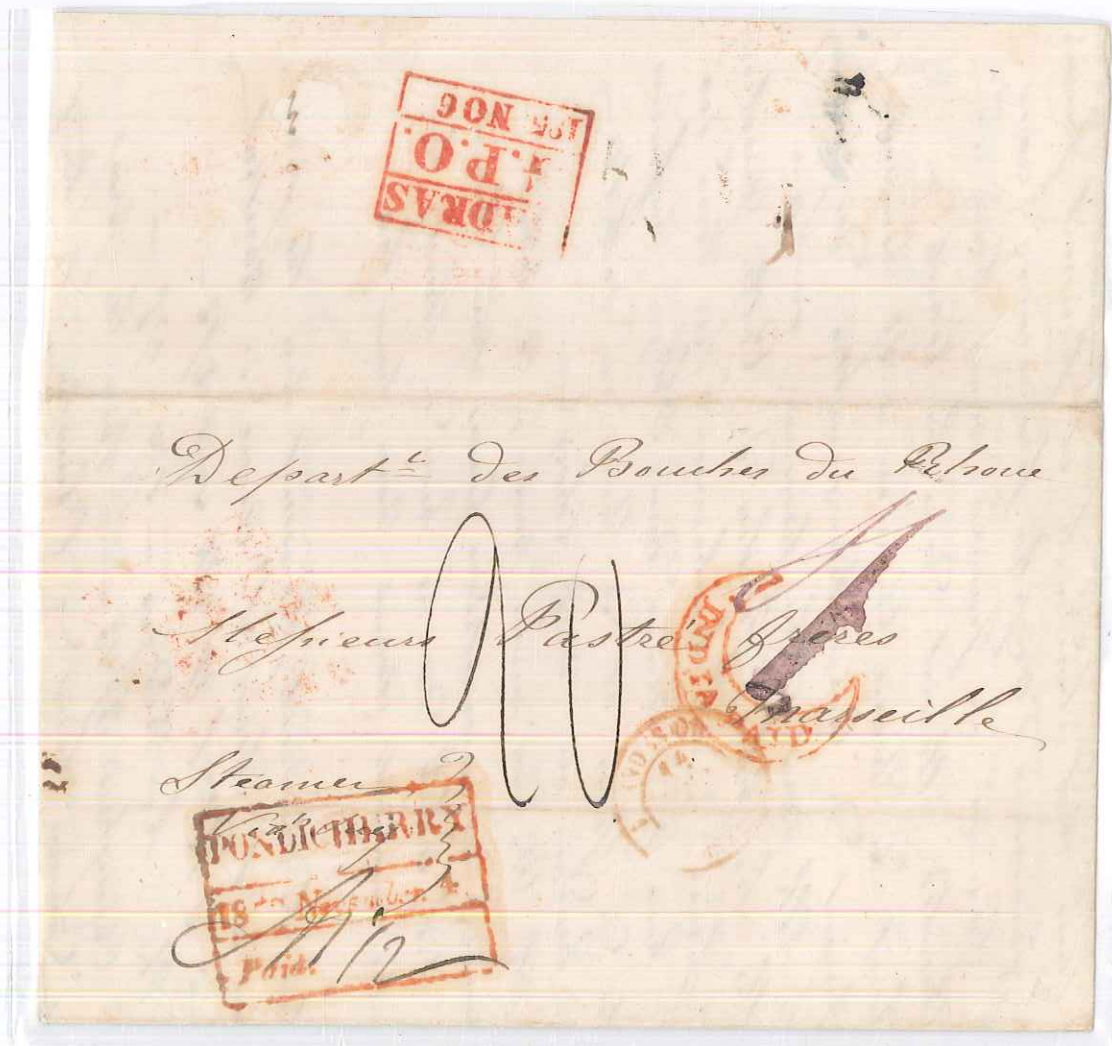
