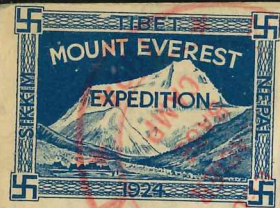

**MOUNT EVEREST STAMP.**

Mr. B. Leslie Cottam, of Folkestone, sends to *The Daily Mail* a postcard he received from a member of the Mount

Everest Expedition bearing the Mount Everest Expedition stamp here reproduced. According to the postmark, it was posted at Rongbuk Glacier Base Camp, and there

also are two Indian half-anna stamps. Headed "Mount Everest Expedition, 1924; Leader, Gen. Hon. C. G. Bruce, C.B.," the postcard consists of a print of a photograph showing Mount Everest from the base camp in the Rongbuk Valley, Tibet, with the printed words "Dispatched by Postal Runner to India." Under this are the words "Best wishes" and the signature.



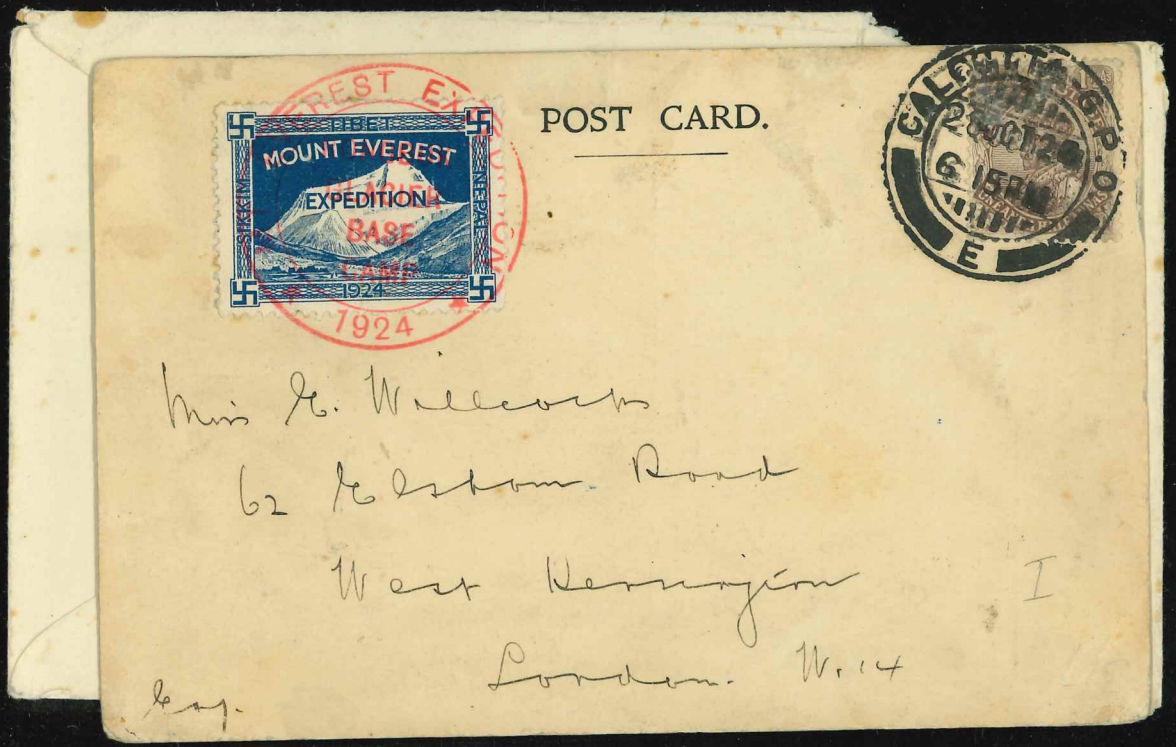
The Everest stamp and postmark.
