The Letter was sent by an Armenian Turk to a Merchant of the same persuasion in Saphran Khani - Der Ahye.

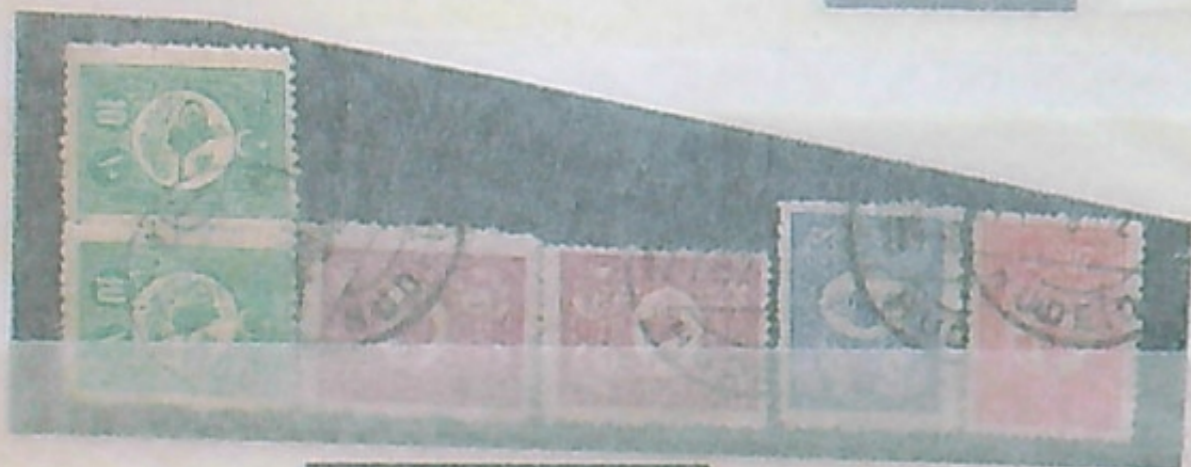

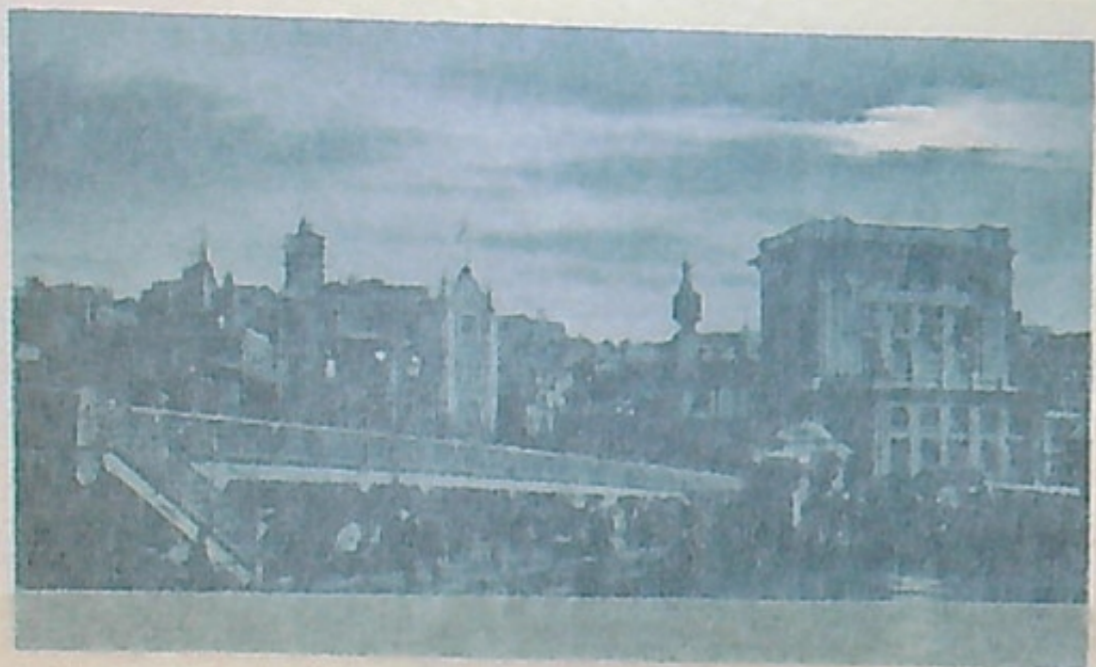
BAGHDAD IN BRITISH OCCUPATION PROVINCIALS

The majority of letters posted during the brief period of one of the provincials were local and philatelic interest in Sir Percy Cox's words "being produced for the pleasure of entering the country by overprinting his stamps". However a few registered covers are known bearing English provincial stamps in combination with British overprinted stamps addressed to England.

21 September 1917 Registered letter to London with 2 annas overcharge on Turkish provincial issue of 1917 together with 1 anna British provincial making up the registration rate. Received London 8 November from a civilian correspondent, not concerned in Mesopotamia but endorsed "Central London" (see 207)



22 November 1917 Registered letter, endorsed "On Active Service" to Rotherham. Franked by a 1 anna British provincial and the 2 annas English provincial on the Turkish Post Office provincial issue, perf 12% of 1916. With Pencil Centre of marking in red (see 207)

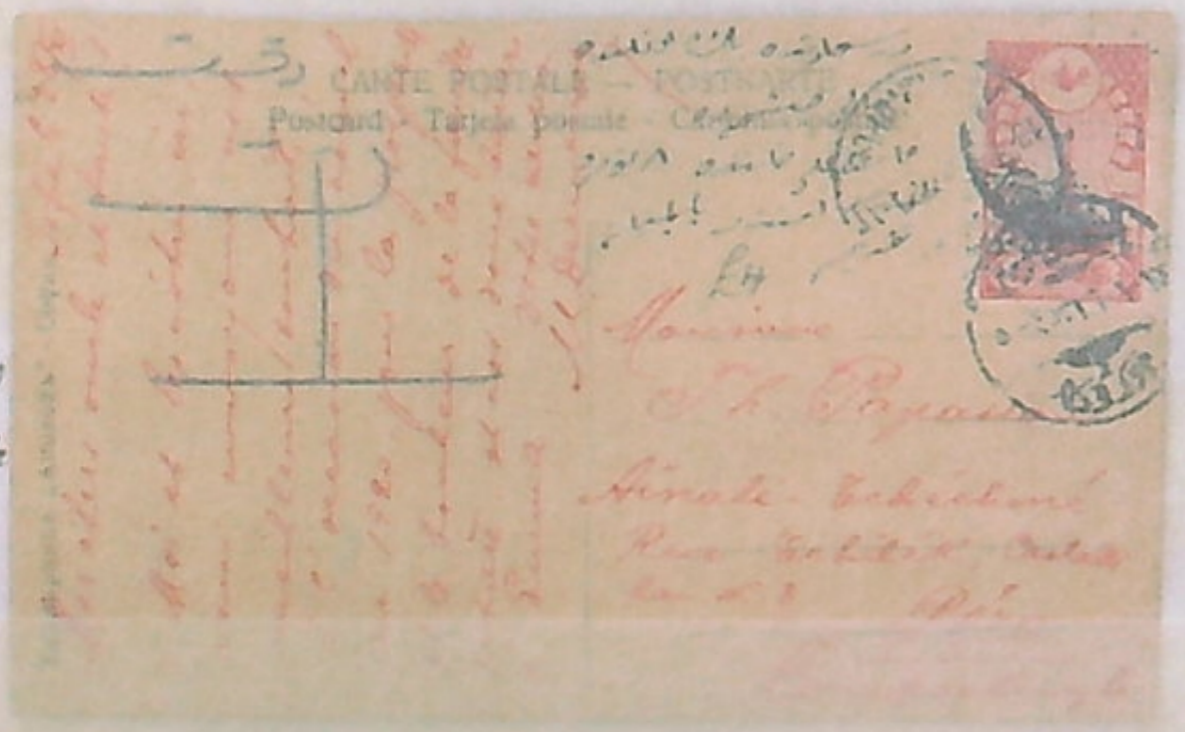


1635 Charles I opened the Royal Mail to the public. All postmasters had to have enough horses to deliver the mail
May 6, 1840 The Penny Black, the world's first adhesive stamp, became valid for postage on any letter weighing up to half an ounce (14.2g) anywhere in the UK

1881 Henry Fawcett, the Postmaster-General, introduced the postal order, originally for people without bank accounts

1919 First airmail service started when the RAF delivered mail between London and Paris

1925 Imperial Airways became the private carrier of mail

This letter sent from Aleppo to Munich via **IZMIR** & Istanbul & carried by the Oriental Express through the Mustafa Pasha Agency, was despatched in 1894 (All on back of cover). On this front side is the Haleb Posta Shuba Si 311 and again different to A. & P. diagrammatical illustration. It can not be the same canceller. The Original is in the Izmir Book, 155 Box (middle left of Desk).

"Haleb Posta Shuba Si 311" dated 15/7/1897, is an earlier Variant of A. & P. Illustrated on a ~~previous~~ ^{previous} page. It may well be a Rarer Variant. I'll send A. & P. a photo of this. There are many differences in shape & script. find.
