Two types of local official letters with the free frank. The one above, dated November 7, 1822, requests payment for two persons for four days work on the roads, at 30 oboli per day. The other, dated March 21, 1826, is a receipt for sedeci (16) shillings, tre (3) pence. While both have the "SERVIZIO PUBBLICO" written out in full, the "Polizia Esecutiva" is only initialled on the second.
