I-6. Double transfer at the top over CORREOS ME. No lines above IC of MEJICO. Offset 0.2 mm.

I-6. The two curved lines at the top of the portrait oval are doubled to 2:00. Offset 0.15 mm.

I-6. There is a diagonal weakness in the value tablet to the right of the L of REAL. It runs from 10:30 to 4:30.

I-6. The frame lines extend beyond their junction. The vertical one extends at least 1.2mm and the horizontal one 2.2mm.
