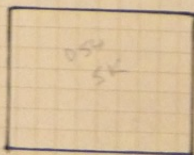

When, after a short time, it was discovered that the new postal arrangements proved unsatisfactory an agreement was negotiated with the Swiss Government by which Liechtenstein became an independent postal administration within the postal territory of Switzerland.

Under this agreement Swiss postal regulations applied but Liechtenstein had the right to issue its own stamps and keep its own accounts. A fixed sum was paid to Switzerland for the services rendered. Control of the postal affairs was handed over to the Swiss on 1 February, 1921, and Swiss internal postal rates and currency applied to Liechtenstein from then onwards.

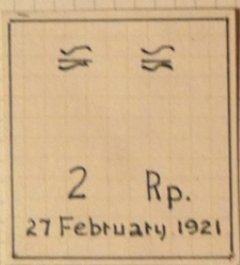
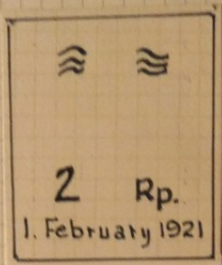

Prior to this flight, which was from the capital Vaduz to adjoining Switzerland, Liechtenstein issued its first airmail stamps comprising a set of six stamps on the 12th August 1930, two of which, the 15Rp and 35Rp feature on the cover. The 35Rp shows a biplane over Vaduz Castle.

Covers received a rectangular cachet in red reading '1. Postflug VADUZ - ST. GALLEN 31 August 1930' in three lines.

These were the first stamps to be overprinted for official use by the different Government departments. They first appeared on 1. April 1932. The stamps used were taken from the definitive issue of 1930 featuring a range of views from across the country.

The overprint consisted of a small crown at the top of the stamp and towards the bottom two lines which read:-
REGIERUNGS
DIENSTSACHE

(Government Service)

The overprint was printed in three colours, blue, red and green.
