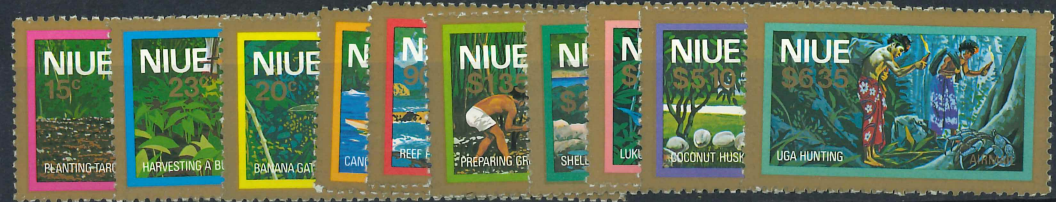

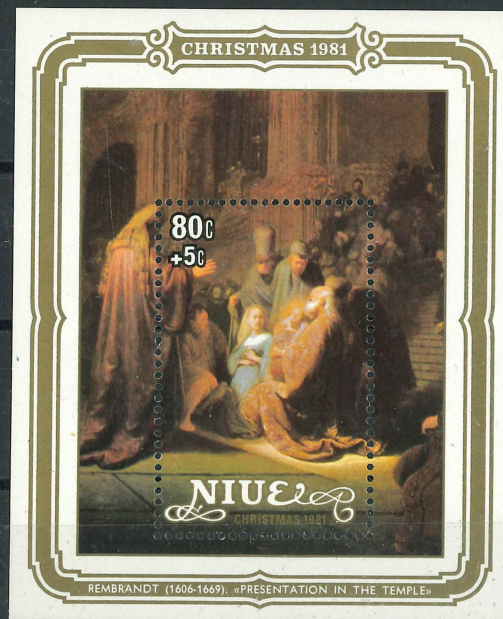

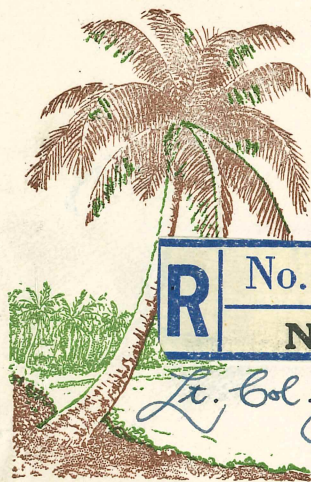

When certain postage stamp denominations were non-existent or in short supply New Zealand fiscals were adapted for use in the Niue postal service.

A traditional display of the stamps of the south pacific island of Niue covering some of the early issues and also examples of the diversity of the more modern stamps of this New Zealand dependency.

The first "Niue" stamps were New Zealand issues of 1898 and 1901 which were surcharged with the value in the island language and came into use in 1902.



Prior to the introduction of the "Niue" stamps of 1902 the stamps of Cook Islands were used. The above issues of 1893 continued in use in Niue until 1920.

4 values of the New Zealand peace set of 1946
overprinted for use in Niue.



1940, printed as three half pence value, however it was
only issued in its surcharged form.

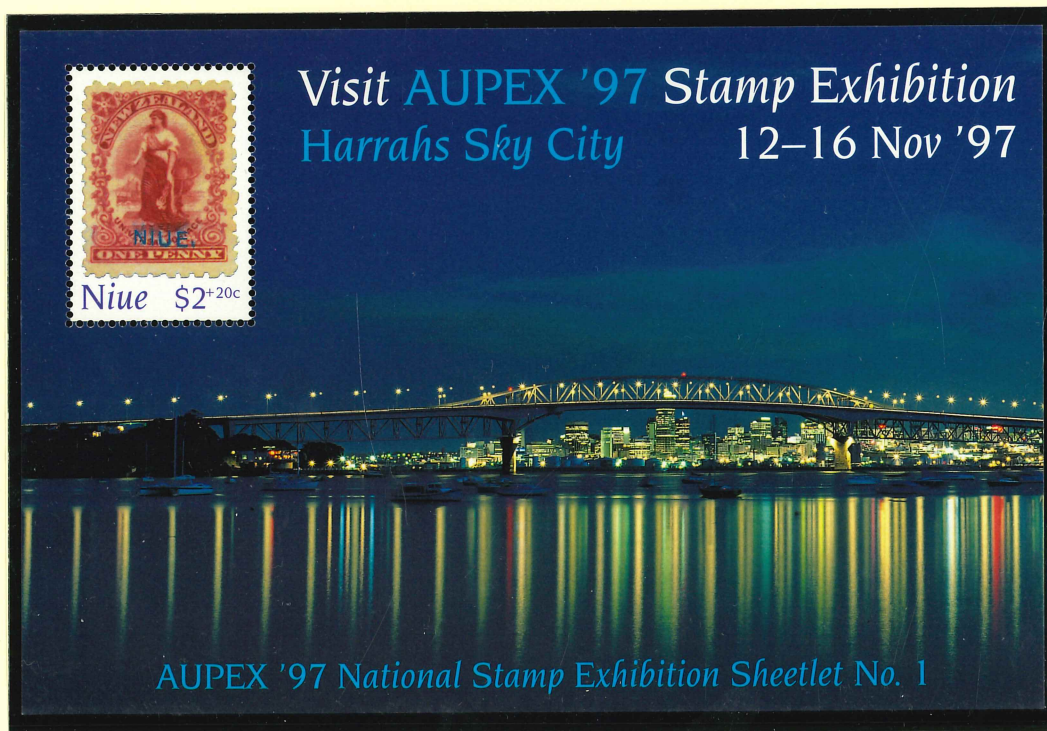
