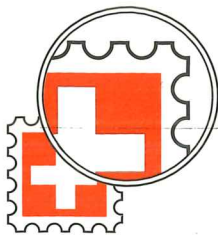

MAURITIUS, 1859.

I have examined the postage stamp issued by the Colonial Administration of Mauritius in November of 1859, "**Queen Victoria by Lapirot**" 2 pence pale blue, imperforate, on thin fish wove paper without watermark, of average thickness 0.059 mm, from a **very worn impression**, Scott Classic Specialized Catalogue #14d; Stanley Gibbons #39, used, with a blue barred oval cancellation, a colour reproduction of which is below, magnified to 100% of true size, and am of the opinion that:

The stamp submitted is genuine, corresponds to **Position 8** in the setting of 12 subjects on a very worn plate, and was postally used. The margins are large on three sides, but the stamp is cut into the design at right. It is ripped at top and the two parts rejoined, held together by a backing.

I have examined the postage stamp issued by the Mauritius Colonial Administration in 1857-1859, "Queen Victoria - Barnard" 1 penny red, imperforate, on thin bluish wove paper without watermark, **worn impression**, Scott Classics Specialized #5b; Stanley Gibbons #18, used, with a two-ring numeral cancellation (numeral unclear), a colour reproduction of which is below, magnified to 125% of true size, and am of the opinion

the stamp is **genuine**, postally used. It has adequate margins on three sides, but is cut into a design at bottom. There is a central thin on reverse, and substantial abrasion in front. The stamp corresponds to **Position 2** in the setting of 12 subjects.

I have examined the postage stamp issued by the Mauritius Colonial Administration in the month of 1859, "Queen Victoria - by Dardenne" 2 pence pale blue, lithographed, perforate, on medium white horizontally laid paper without watermark, Scott Classic Specialized Catalogue #17; Stanley Gibbons Catalogue #44, used, with the "PAID" in a circular cancellation, a colour reproduction of which is below, magnified to 125% of size, and am of the opinion that:

The stamp submitted is **genuine**, postally used. It has complete margins well clear of the cancellation on all four sides. However, there are three thin lines towards the central part of the stamp, and a horizontal crease.






