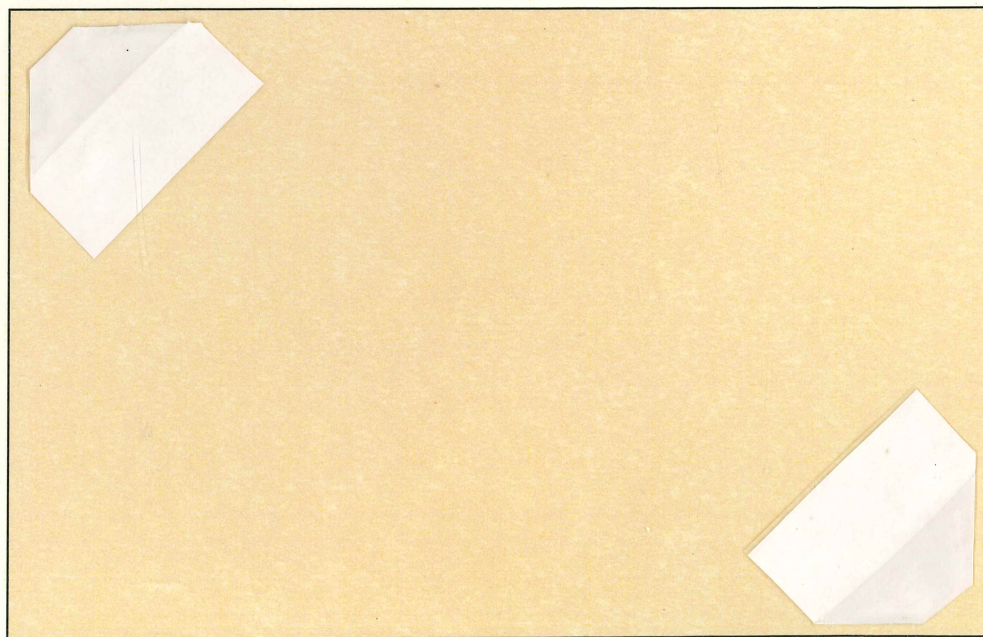

April 1863, to Paris, France, delivered on 15 May. Rated 1s 2d in red crayon, franked with a single 4d lilac and a single 1s, both from the 22nd and last consignment of Perkins & Bacon, invoiced on 21 December 1861. Probably a double rated letter overpaid one penny. The first 4d stamps from De La Rue arrived around June 1862.

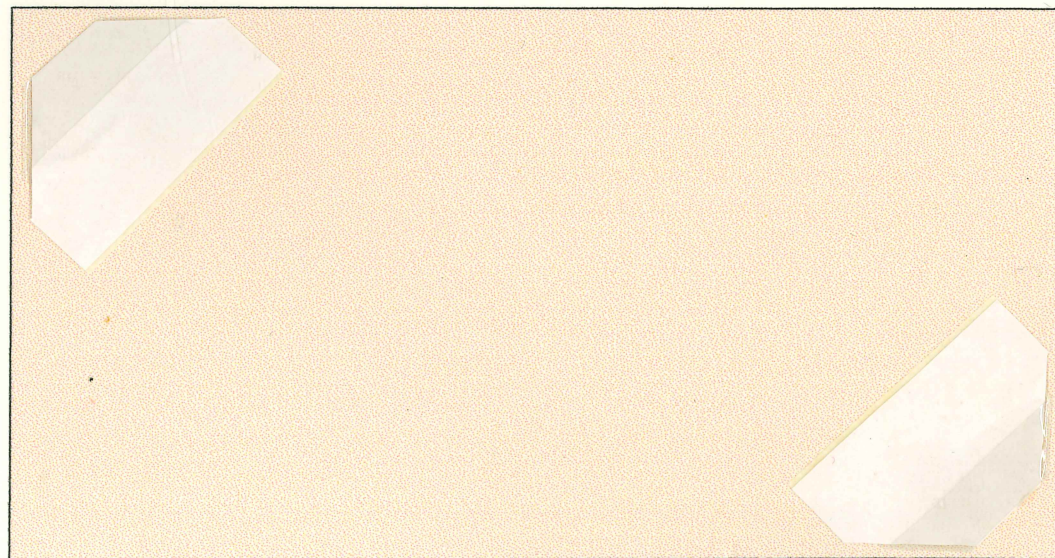

Franked with a single 1d rose-red rough-perforated 14 to 16 1/2 from the second consignment of December 1860 (22nd consignment from P & B), cancelled '20' in a square of bars. The stamps supply to small offices was usually lasting for long.

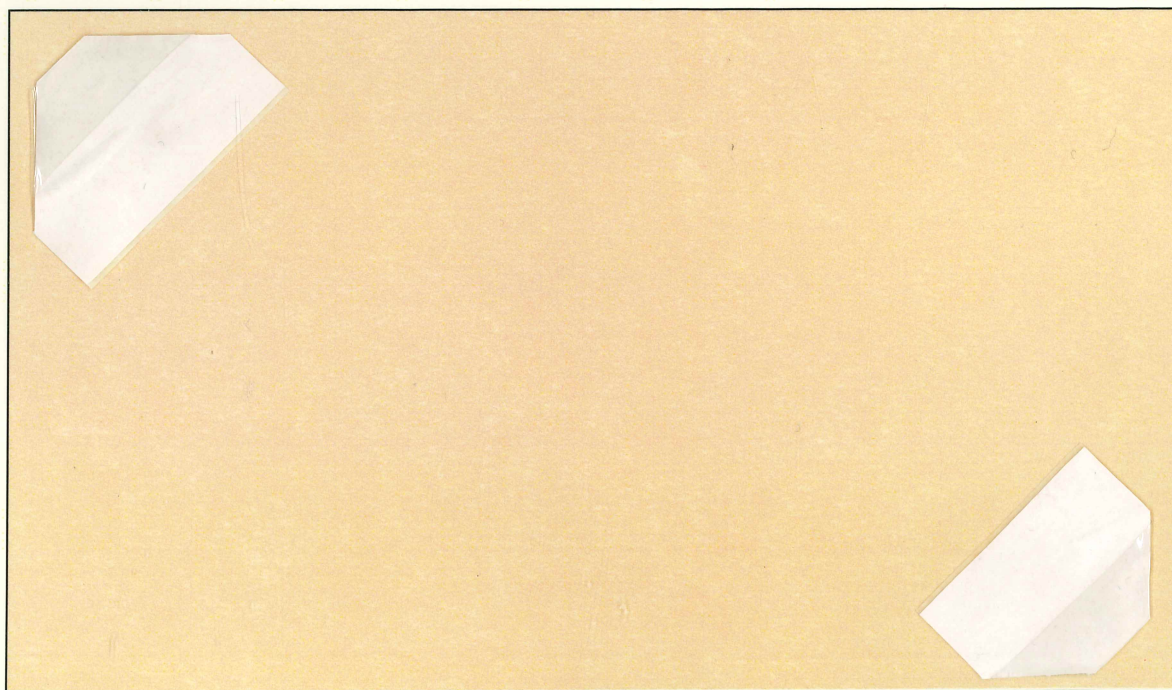

The cover showing Crowned Circle 'Paid at Trinidad' has been charged on arrival 30 décimes.

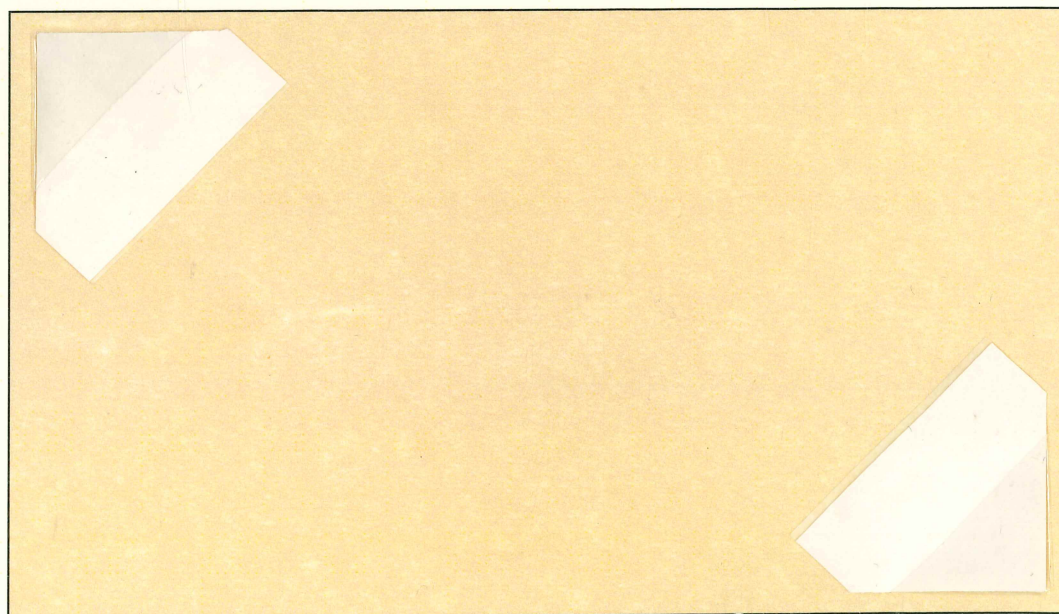

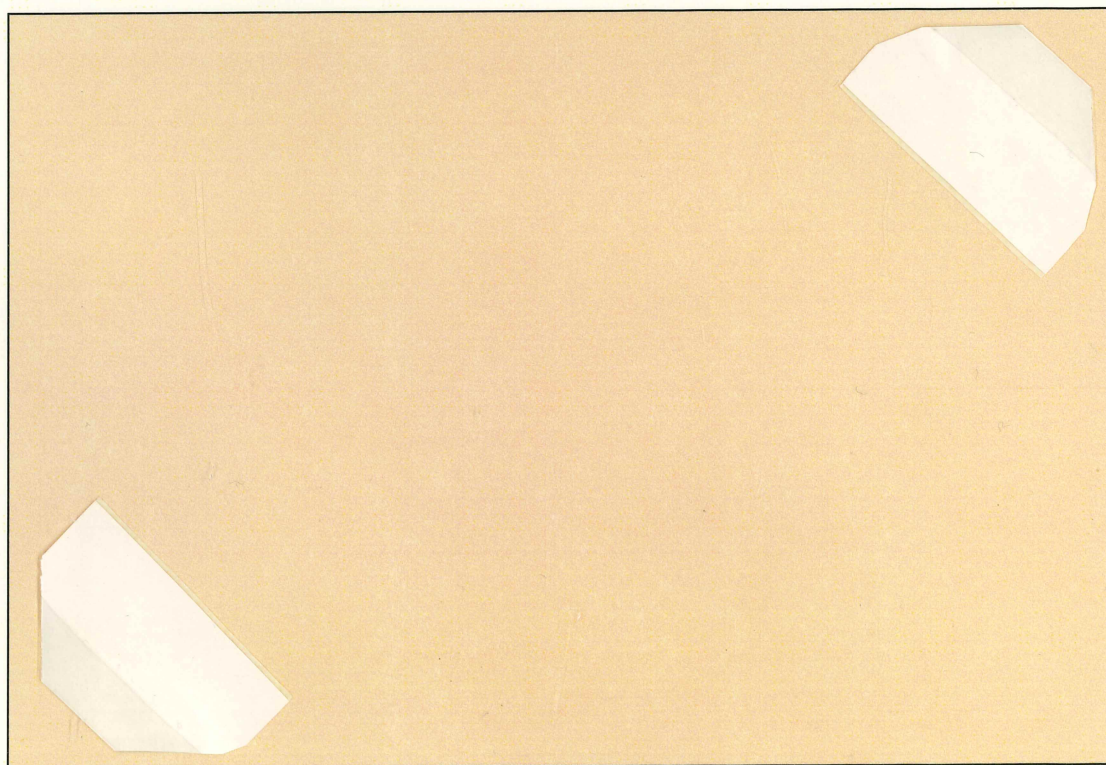

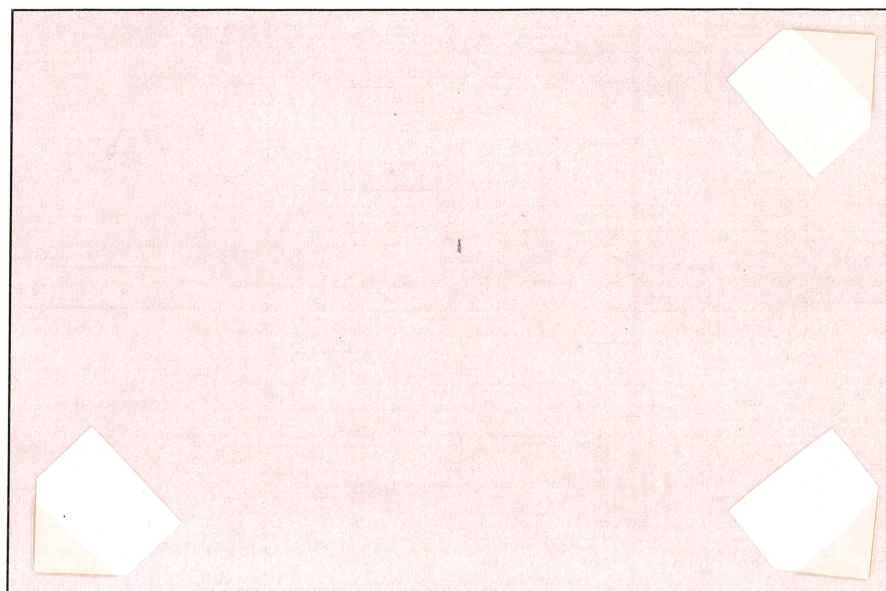

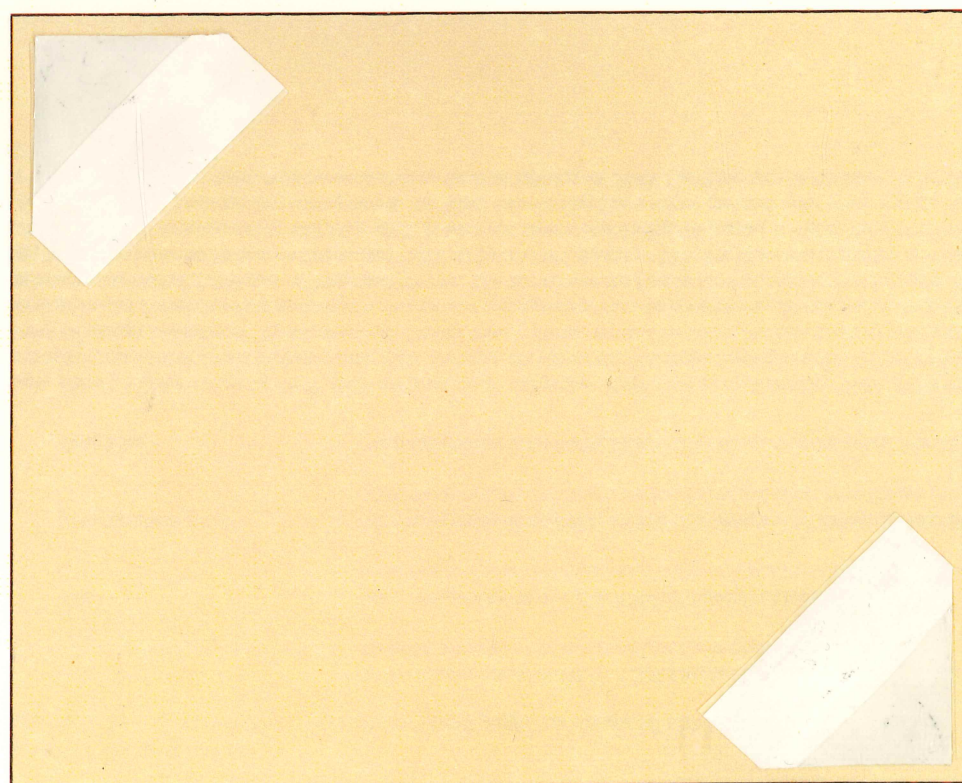

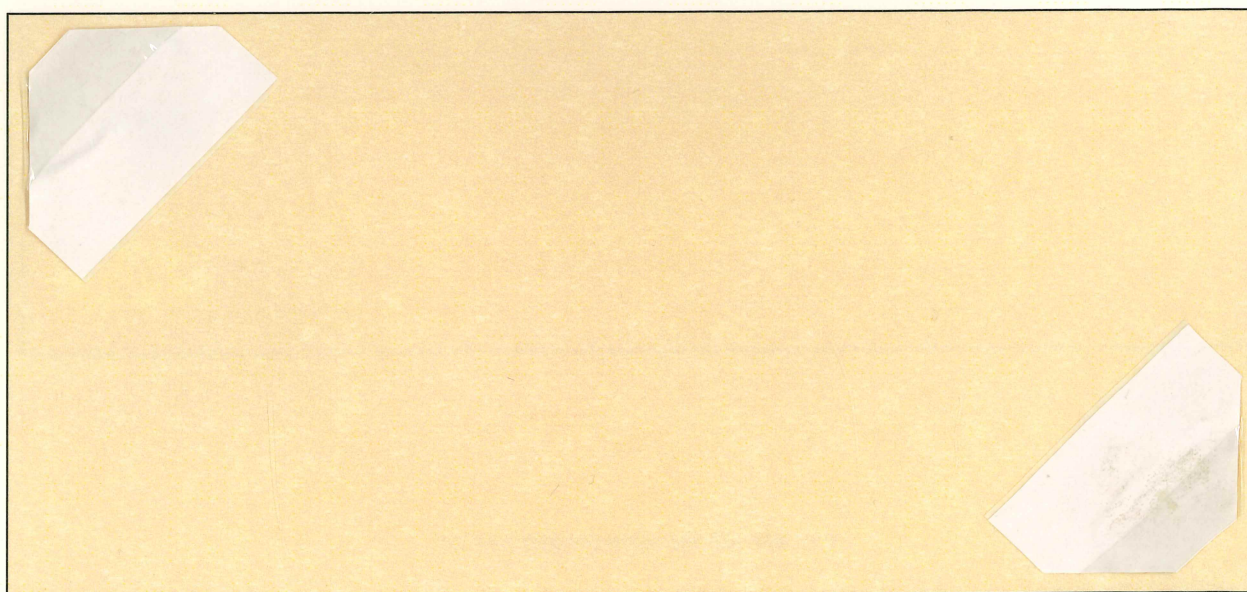
