THE DATED CANCELS

RL Type PL



Standard type used to date mailed matter, and as a backstamp.

Later (From c. 1870) used also to cancel the adhesive, until April 1882.

Diameter about 25mm. Letters about 4mm. high. Sanserif letters.



THE SAME TYPE SLIGHTLY SMALLER



Both types are usually found only on the De La Rue issues.

TRINIDAD

THE DATED CANCELS



Similar to single-lined c.d.s. RL Type PQ, but no town number and no letter A, etc. to denote time of posting.

Diameter varies from 19 to 20.5mm.

Known used from c. April 1882 to c. December 1890.

Found only on the De La Rue issues:
