No Insurance is valid until the premium is paid and an official Cash Receipt obtained.

In consideration of the payment of an additional premium it is hereby declared and agreed that the words "Burglary and Housebreaking (excluding theft by servants)" occurring in Section (b) of the operative clause of this Policy shall be deemed to have been deleted and the following substituted therefor:—

"Burglary, Housebreaking, Larceny or Theft"



The Company shall not be liable in respect of any theft if the discovery of the same be not made within 60 days of the theft or the attempt at theft.

5. On the happening of any loss, destruction or damage in respect of any property insured under this policy the Company and every person authorised by the Company may without thereby incurring any liability, and without diminishing the right of the Company to rely upon any conditions of this Policy, enter, take or keep possession of the building or premises where the loss, destruction or damage has happened and may take possession of or require to be delivered to them any of the property hereby insured and may keep possession of and deal with such property for all reasonable purposes and in any reasonable manner. This Condition shall be evidence of the leave and license of the Insured to the Company so to do. If the Insured or anyone acting on his behalf shall not comply with the requirements of the Company or shall hinder or obstruct the Company in doing any of the above-mentioned acts, then all benefit under this Policy shall be forfeited. The Insured shall not in any case be entitled to abandon any property to the Company whether taken possession of by the Company or not.

6. The Company may at its option repair, reinsure or replace the property stolen, damaged or destroyed or any part thereof instead of paying the amount of the loss, destruction or damage or may join with any other Company or Insurers in so doing, but the Company shall not be bound to reinsure exactly or completely but only in a reasonable and sufficient manner. If the Company think fit to reinsure or replace the Insured shall furnish the Company with such plans, specifications, and such other particulars as the Company may require and no acts done or caused to be done by the Company with a view to reinstatement or replacement shall be deemed an election by the Company to reinsure or replace.

7. The Insured shall, at the expense of the Company, do and concur in doing, and permit to be done, all such acts and things as may be necessary or reasonably required by the Company for the purpose of enforcing any rights and remedies, or of obtaining relief or indemnity from other parties to which the Company shall be or would become entitled or subrogated upon its paying for or making good, any loss, destruction or damage under this Policy, whether such acts and things shall be or become necessary or required before or after his indemnification by the Company.

8. If at the time of any loss, destruction or damage happening to any property hereby insured, there be any other subsisting insurance or insurances, whether effected by the Insured or by any other person or persons, covering the property hereby insured either alone or together with any other property, this Company shall not be liable to pay or contribute more than its ratable proportion of such loss, destruction or damage.

9. If the property hereby insured shall, at the time of the happening of any loss, destruction or damage be collectible of greater value than the sum insured thereon then the Insured shall be liable to pay the difference of the value of the property at the time of the happening of any loss, destruction or damage over and above the sum insured thereon.

1. The Insured does not cover:—

(a) Loss destruction or damage directly or indirectly proximately or remotely occasioned by Eruption Earthquake or other convulsion of nature Invasion act of foreign Enemies Hostilities or Warlike Operations (whether before or after Declaration of War) Civil War Strike Riots Civil Commotion Rebellion Miliary or Usurped Power or by any direct or indirect consequences of any of the said occurrences and in the event of any claim hereunder the Insured shall prove that the accident loss damage and/or liability arose independently of and was in no way connected with or occasioned by or contributed to by or traceable to any of the said occurrences or any consequence thereof and in default of such proof the Company shall not be liable to make any payment in respect of such a claim.

N.B.—In the event of any claim being made under this Policy the Insured shall, when required by the Company, produce proof to the Company's satisfaction that the loss, destruction or damage was not occasioned by or through or in consequence of any of the events or occurrences hereinbefore referred to.

(b) Deeds, Bonds, Bills of Exchange, Promissory Notes, Coined or Paper Money, Cheques, securities for Money, Stamps, Documents of any kind, Manuscripts, Medals and Coins, Motor Vehicles and Accessories or Live Stock unless specially mentioned.

(c) Loss, destruction or damage by Burglary, Housebreaking or Larceny:—

Where any tenant, lodger or member of the Insured's Family is concerned as principal or accessory, or arising while the premises or any part thereof are let or sub-let, unless such occupation be previously notified to and sanctioned by the Company.

If the premises in which the property is contained be left unoccupied for more than sixty days in any one year of Insurance, whether at one time or in the aggregate, unless specially allowed by Endorsement hereon and the additional premium required be paid to the Company.

Upon the occasion of, or consequent upon, fire or explosion within the premises in which the Insured's property is contained.

2. The Insurance may be terminated at any time at the request of the Insured, in which case the Company will retain the customary short period rate for the time the Policy has been in force.
