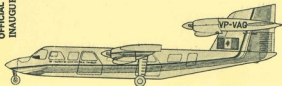

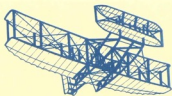

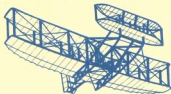

SIR ROWLAND HILL CENTENARY 1879-1979

		<p>"A bit of paper, covered at the back with a glutinous wash, just large enough to bear the stamps showing that the tax had been paid..... This was how Rowland Hill described his invention of the first adhesive postage stamps, the "Penny Black" and "Twopence Blue" introduced by the British Post Office on 6 May 1840. Postage stamps were gradually introduced by other countries and on 8 May 1861 St Vincent issued a "Penny Red" and "Sixpence Green". The new definitives of St Vincent reflect the postal heritage of the Island and depict markings of various Island Post Offices.</p> <p>Stamp users and collectors of the world salute Sir Rowland Hill on his centenary and in May 1980 meet in London to celebrate 140 years of postage stamps.</p>

I have examined the Registered envelope sent from Kingstown, St. Vincent, to Leicester, England, posted on April 10th of 1897, franked with two postage stamps issued by the Colonial Administration of St. Vincent in 1893, "Queen Victoria" horizontal pair of four pence yellow, perforated 14, on medium white wove paper with watermark "Crown and Block CA" upright, Scott Classics Specialized #49; Stanley Gibbons #56, tied to the cover by the circular datestamp cancellation "KINGSTON ST. VINCENT / A / AP 10 / 97", which is repeated alongside, with large "R" in oval and registration label on reverse used also as seal; with London transit datestamp in front of April 29th, 1897, and arrival datestamp of Leicester of the same date on reverse, a colour reproduction of which is on the reverse side of this certificate, reduced to 90% of true size, and am of the opinion that:

The cover, postage stamps affixed, and postal markings indicated above are **genuine in all respects**. The envelope is in excellent state of preservation. The adhesive stamps are in perfect condition. The cover is properly franked, according to the rate schedule which came into effect on April 12th of 1882: 4 pence for registration and 4 pence postage for a single weight letter to U.P.U. member countries. I have signed the cover.

BICENTENARY OF THE BIRTH OF SIR CHARLES BRISBANE

Sir Charles Brisbane entered the Naval Service at ten years of age and served in the Mediterranean waters, fighting off the French fleet. In 1807, whilst commanding the 'Arcturion', he was engaged in

blowing up Caracas harbour. After the capitulation, he assumed the functions of Governor of the Island for a short period. He then resumed command of the 'Arcturion' until the autumn of 1808.

when he was appointed to the 'Blake' and shortly afterwards to the Government of St. Vincent. In January 1815, he was reappointed a KCB, and in August 1819 was made Rear-Admiral.

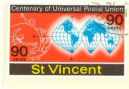
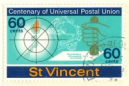

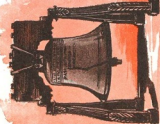
