For the small stamps, a new form sC was laid down. The words now read down, spaced 13.5-14.5mm.

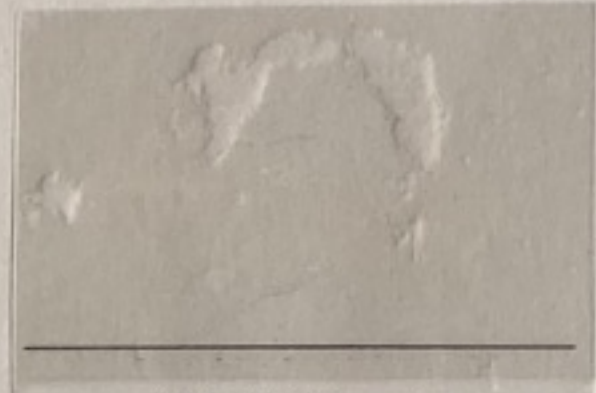

The literature does not report Var B, O'Ffisieel, but shown here is the discovery block, which places it in Rx/2, and almost certainly R4/2.

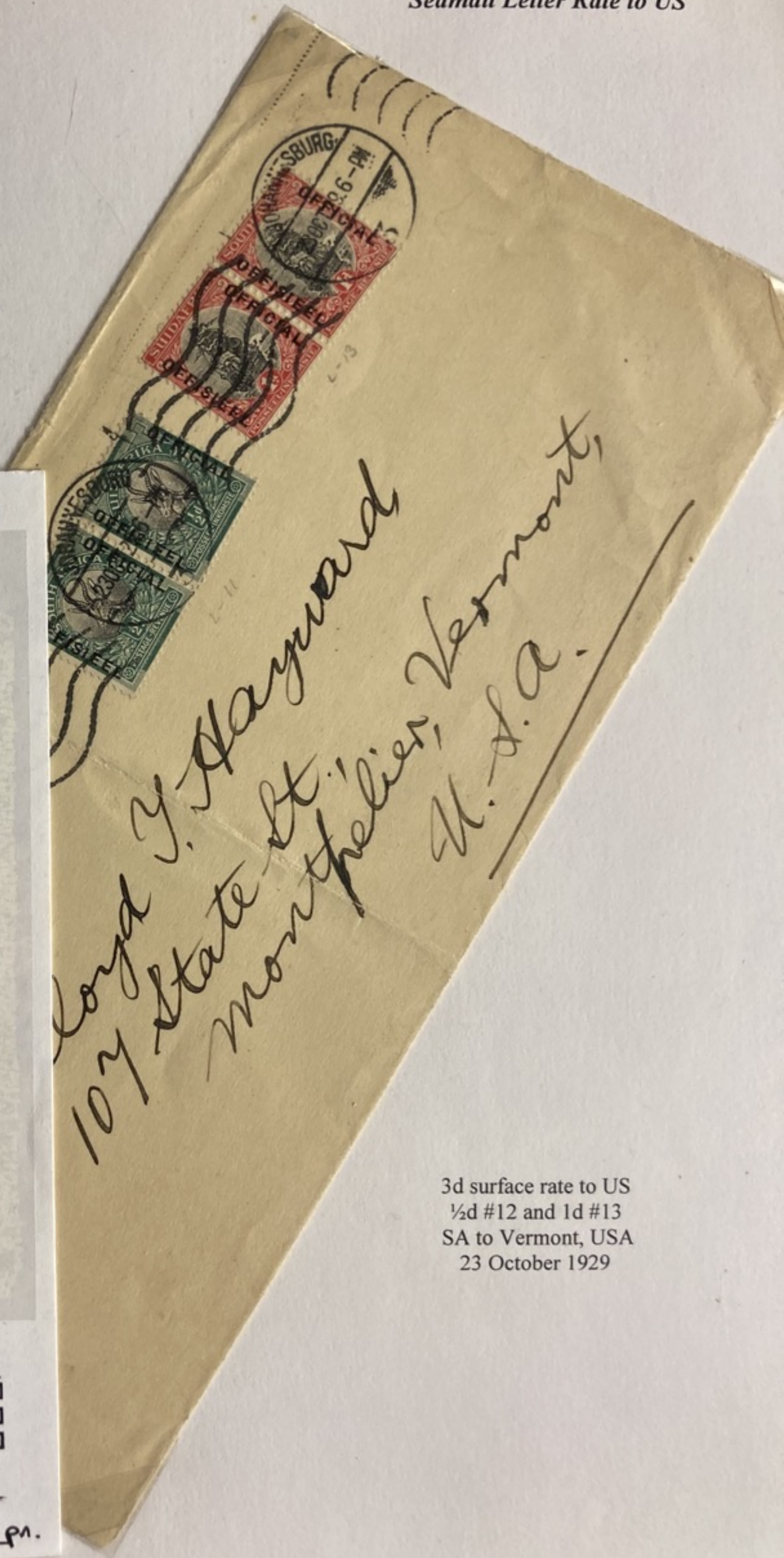

Contrary to the literature, the small form is not brand new, since it retains Vars A and D in their previous locations. It also includes varieties B and C, but in new locations showing it had been collapsed and reset. Five new OFFISIEEL slugs were cast with a stop after the word, and five slugs with varieties were eliminated. Only one of these, at R9/12, was directly replaced. Previously unrecorded Vars 9 and 10 are found.
