Unfranked, taxed 25,000c. Correct African rate Rate \$25,000.

2. Serif T

Serif T in 30mm circle, with both rate and shortage shown.
23 October, 1985

Red RSA as wrongly addressed to Zimbabwe.

15c is South Africa rate, franked 9c, so short 6c, not the 2c shown.



Serif T 30mm circle with heavy line with red MS 1/20. Crossed out and initialed.
Then taxed 13c with thin T, no line.
26 November 1985, arrived 16 days later.

20c is world rate, so wrong. Franked 11c + franked 11c = 24c
Rate to South Africa is 19c, +5c fee. (Fee application is erratic)



Black Serif T in 30mm circle, Heavy line, Red MS 4/25
24 August 1987.

Franked 15c, Correct rate 19c so 4c no fee is correct. 25 is world rate.

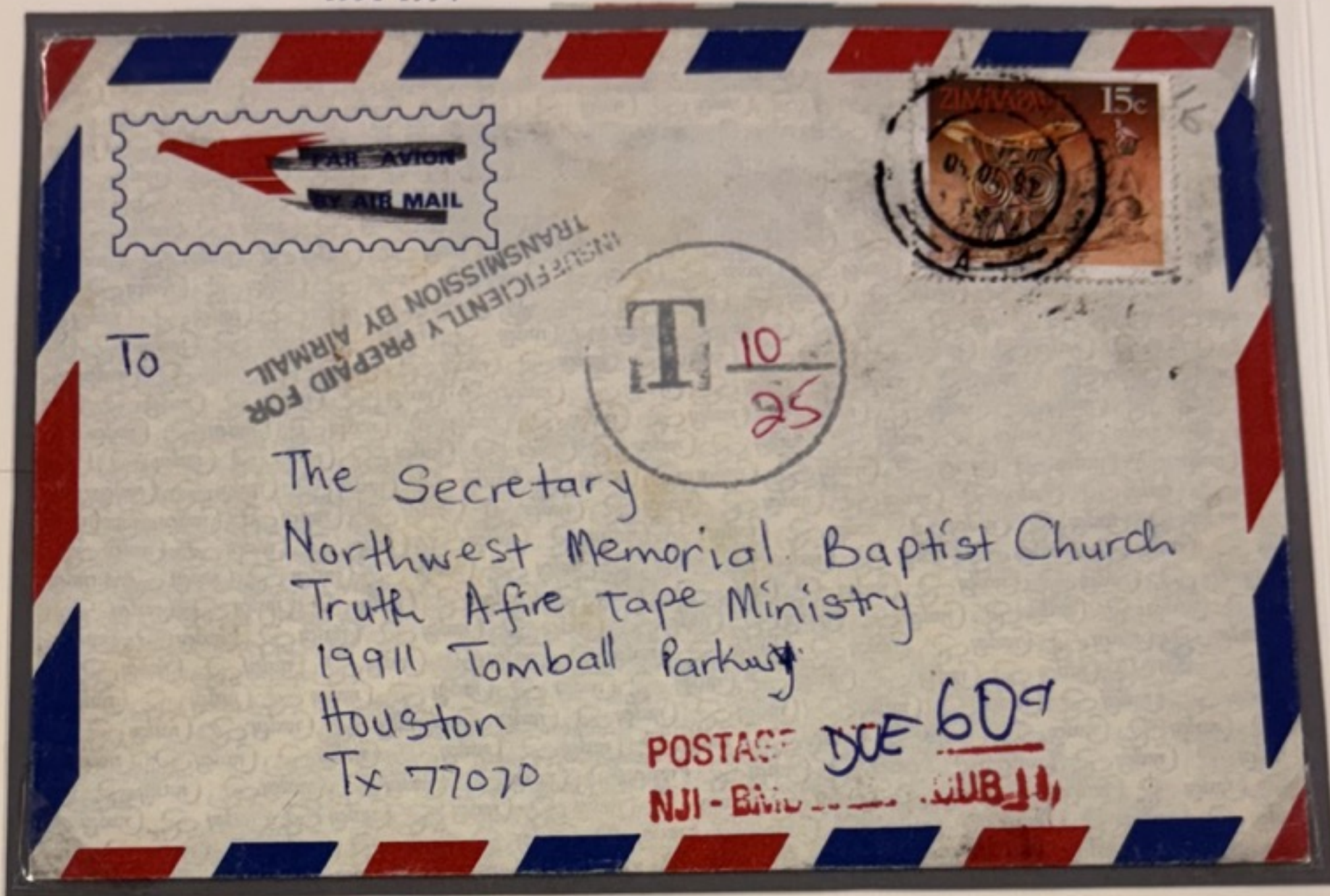

"Insufficiently franked..."
19 Dec 1995

Franked \$1.05, correct surface rate \$1.30, short 25c
So taxed double plus 5c fee.

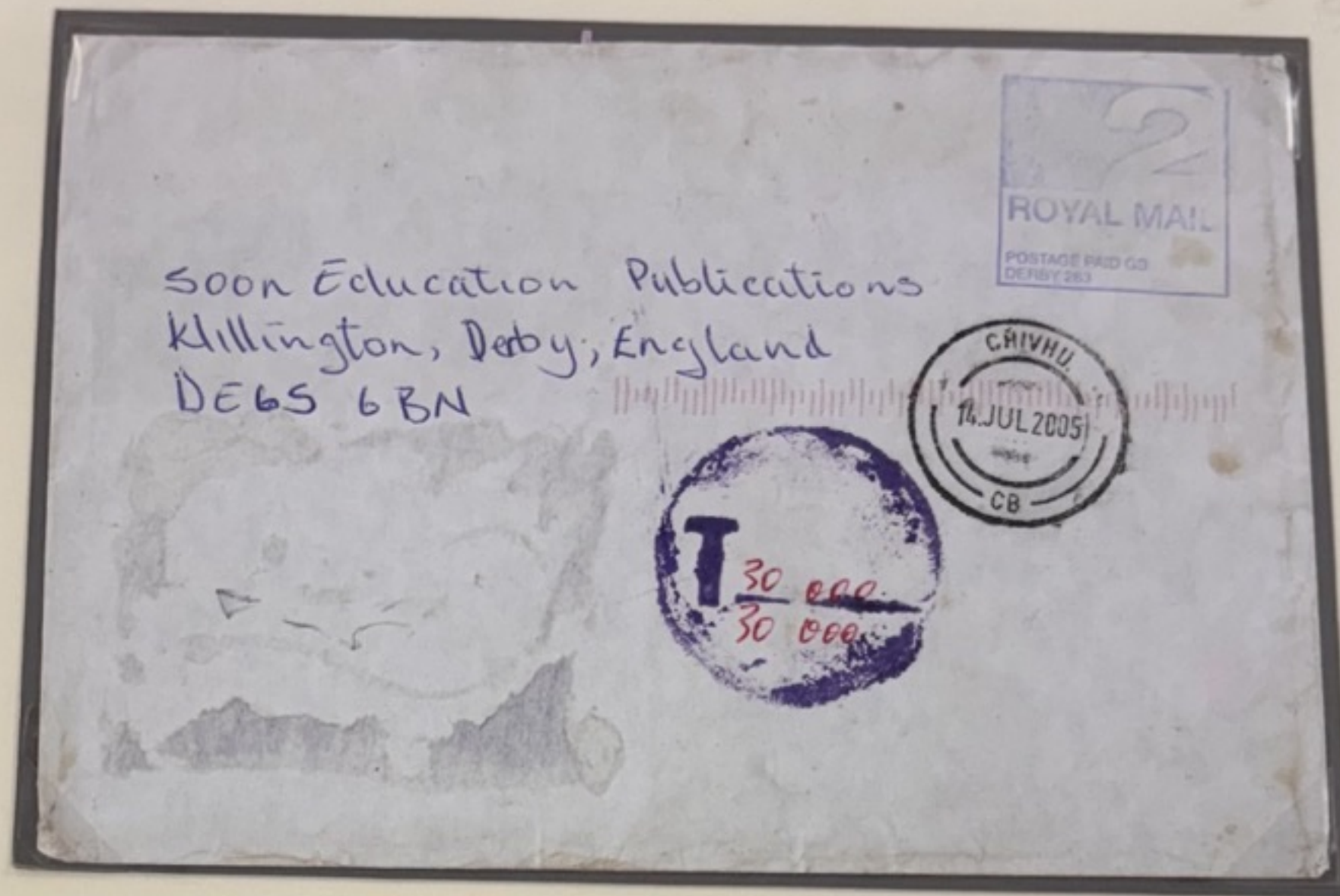

Few examples seen of doubling shortage.

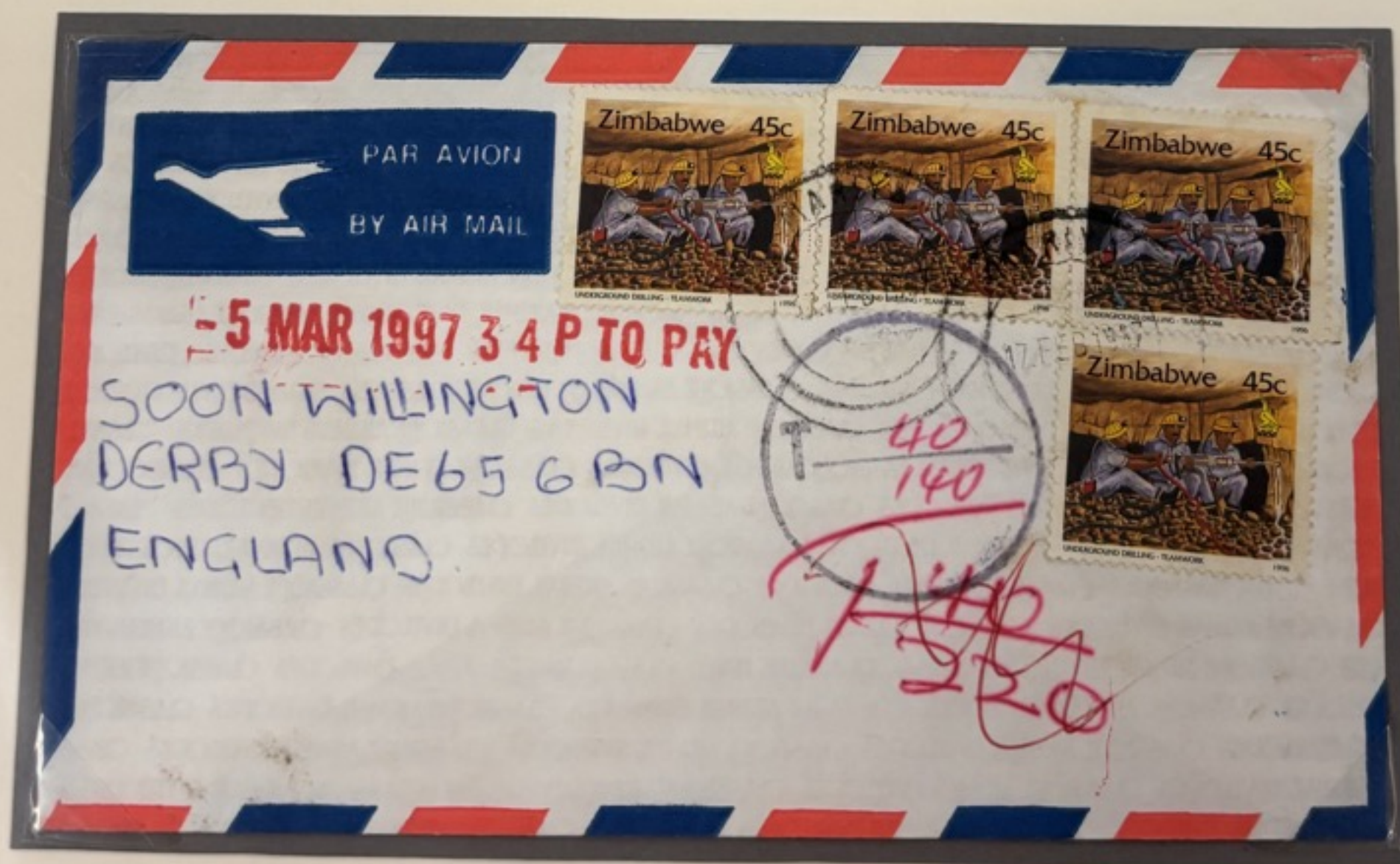

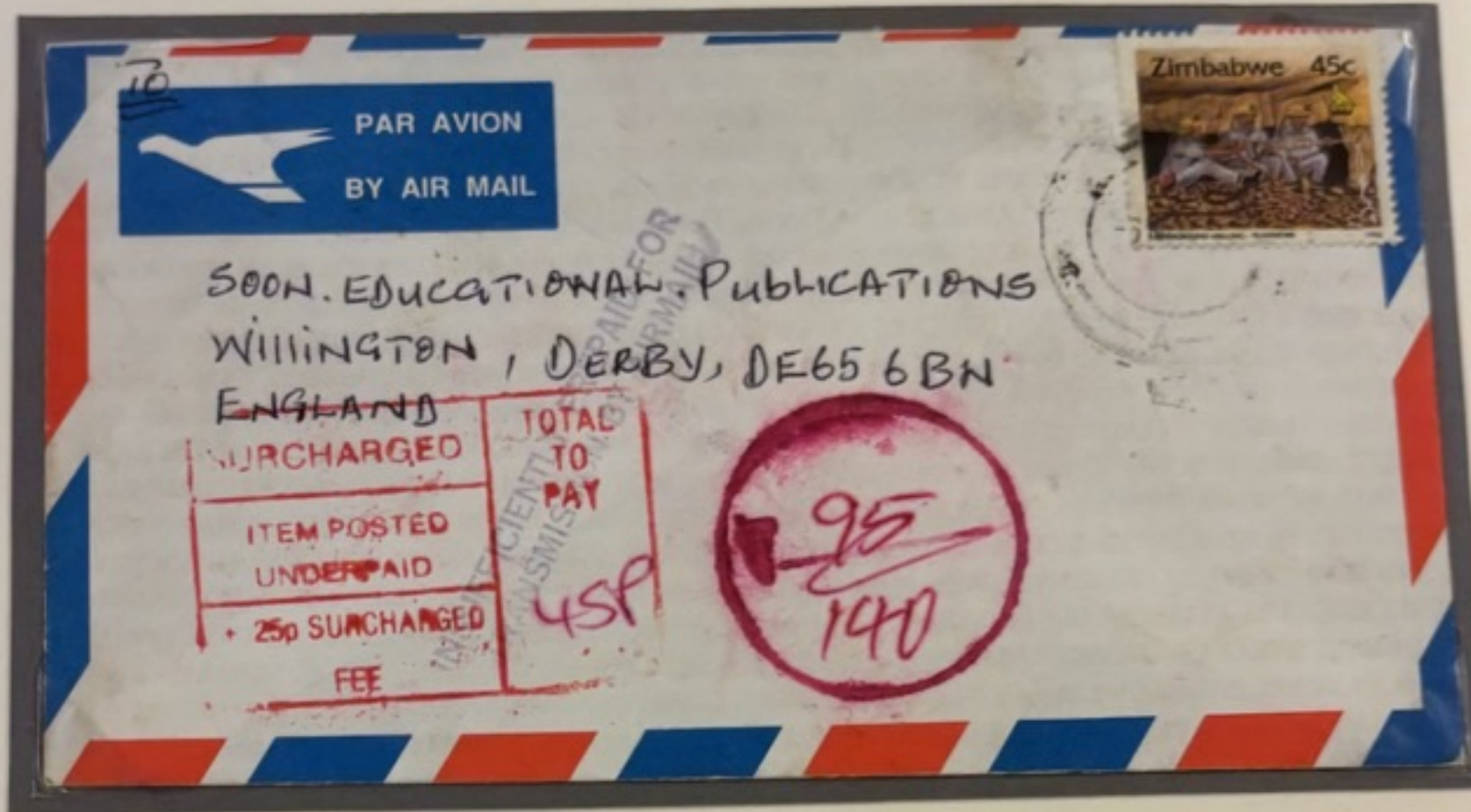

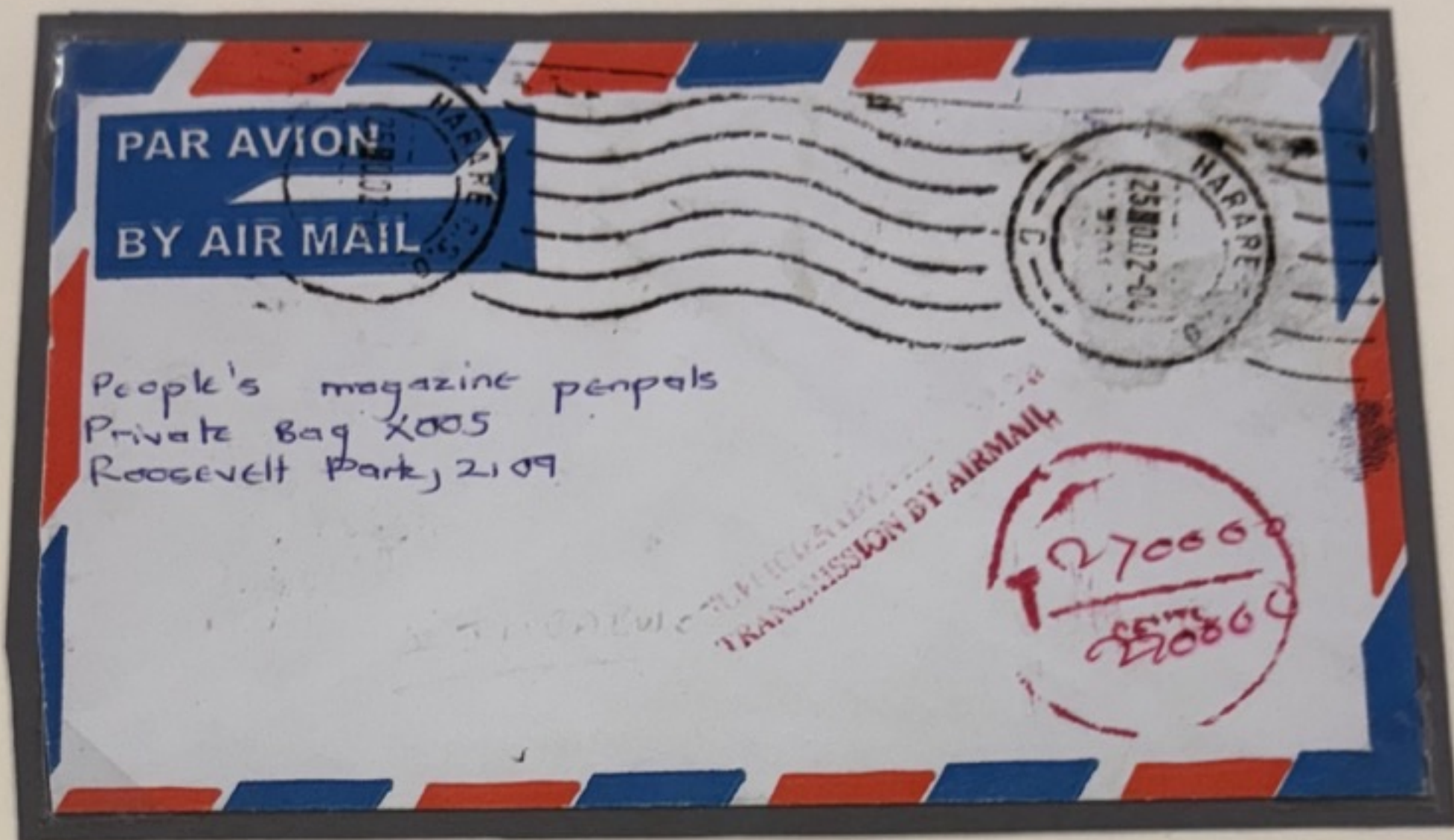

Unfranked, taxed 1400 correct for surface UK, but cancelled by UK!

 Both applied at Harare Central Sorting Office.

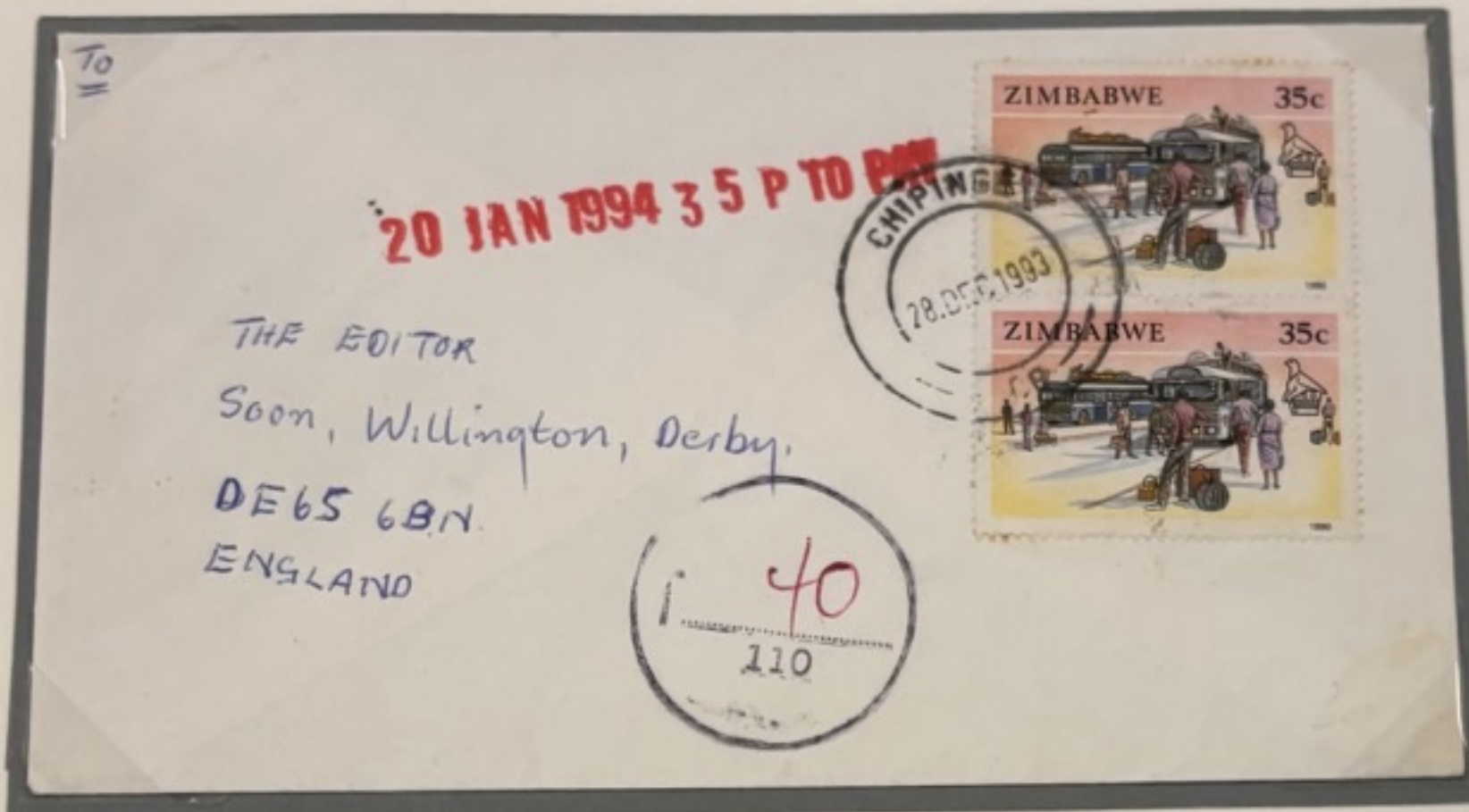

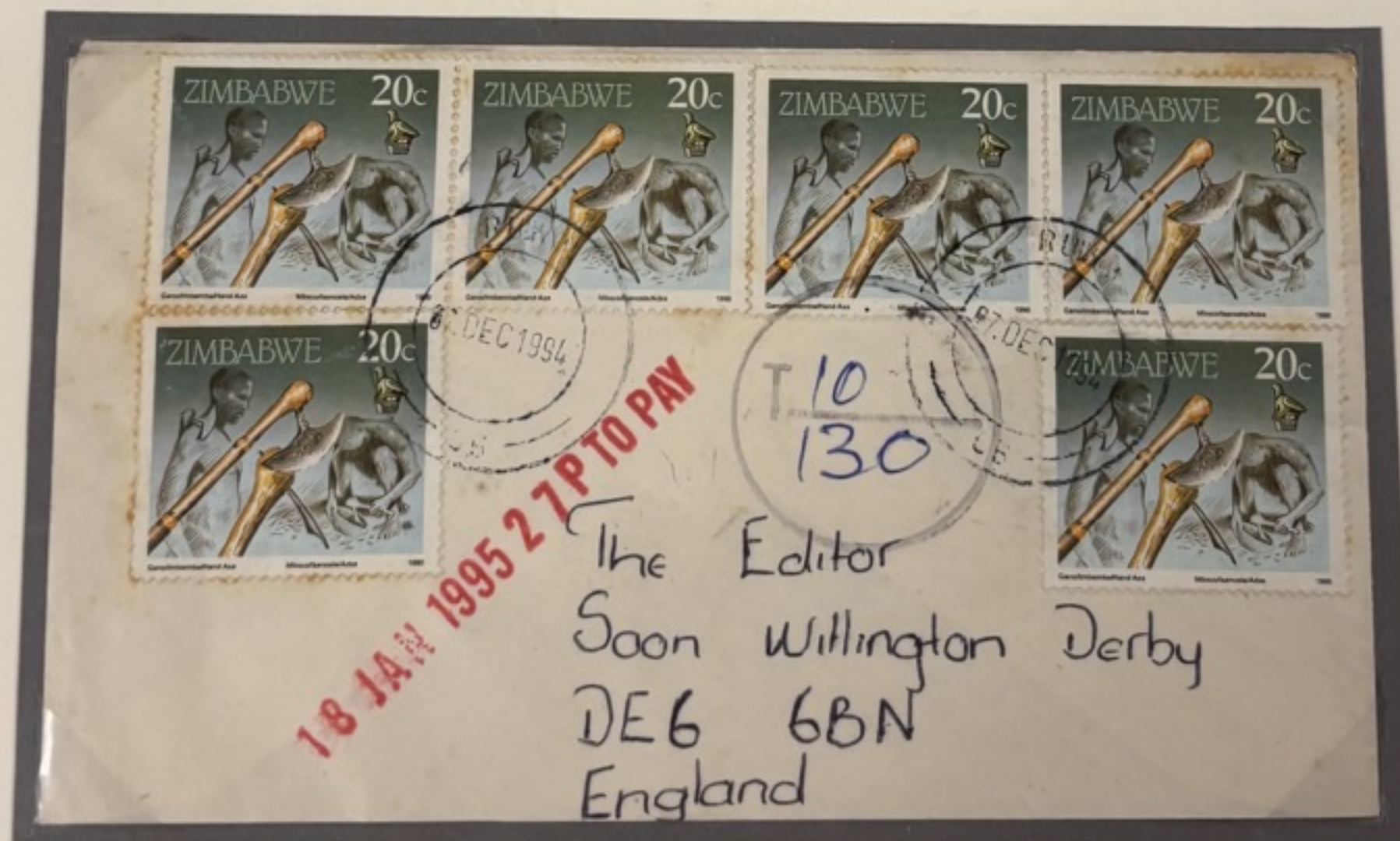

Franked 70c (double domestic), taxed 40c=110c, correct World & UK rate



Black 30mm circle, solid line. 7 December 1994

Franked 120c, taxed 10c-130c, correct world and UK rate.

Blue 30mm circle, solid line, 130 rate below. 7 Jan 96

Also "INSUFFICIENT ENT..."

Franked 35c, taxed 95c=130c, correct world/UK rate



Blue 32mm circle, Line. 26 January 1996. Harare Central Sorting Office. Also plain Blue "INSUFFICIENTLY PREPAID..."

Franked 90c, taxed 15c=105c, Correct rate now 120c. No known 105c rate.

Blue 32mm circle,
no line, but Clerk no 101.
6 February 1996
Also MS red TAX applied
locally and blue boxed
"INSUFFICIENTLY
PREPAID..."

Franked 45c, taxed 95c

Again, incorrect,

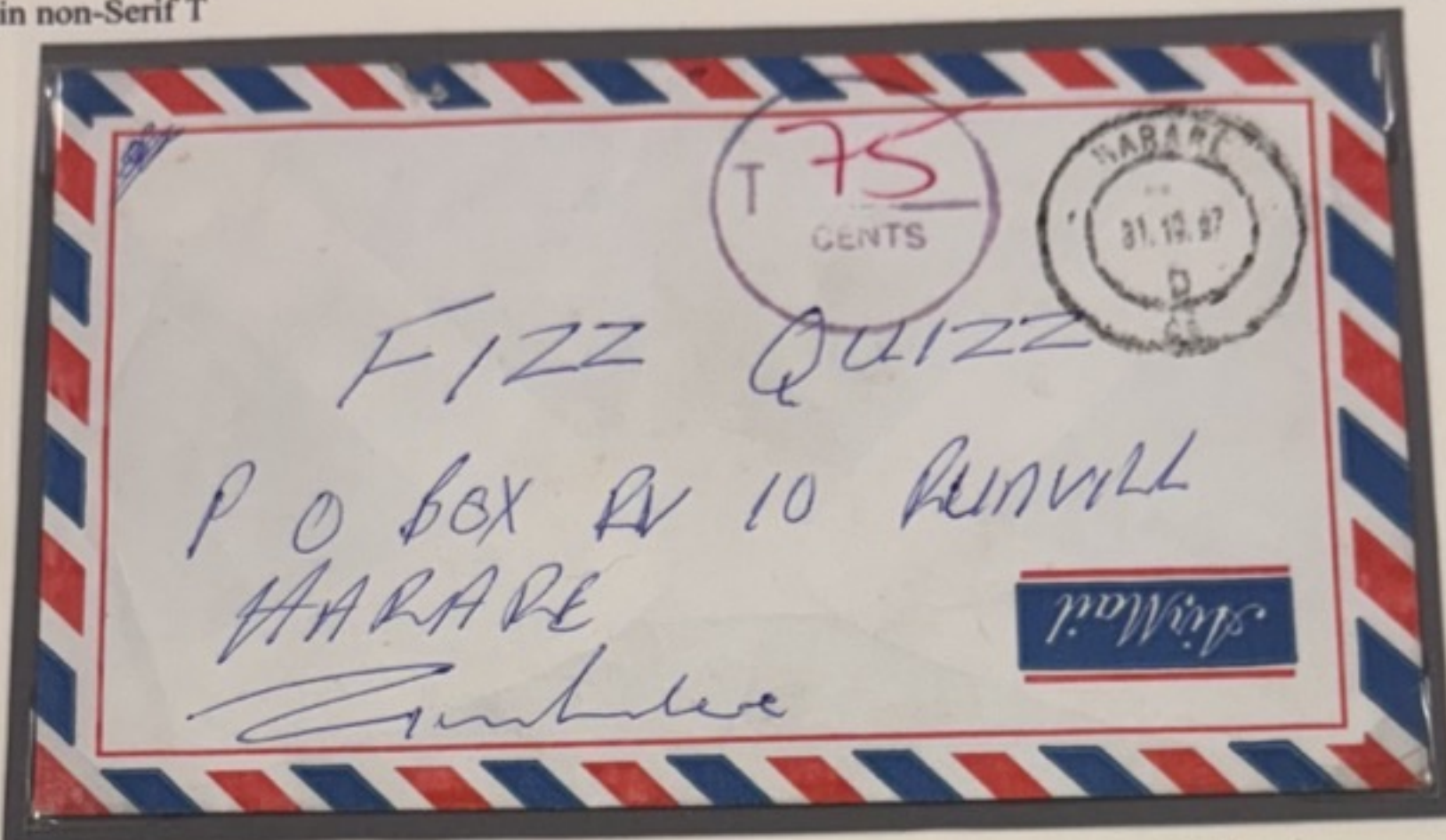

Franked \$3, taxed 70c=\$3.70. Correct Africa rate is \$2.70. Should not have been taxed.

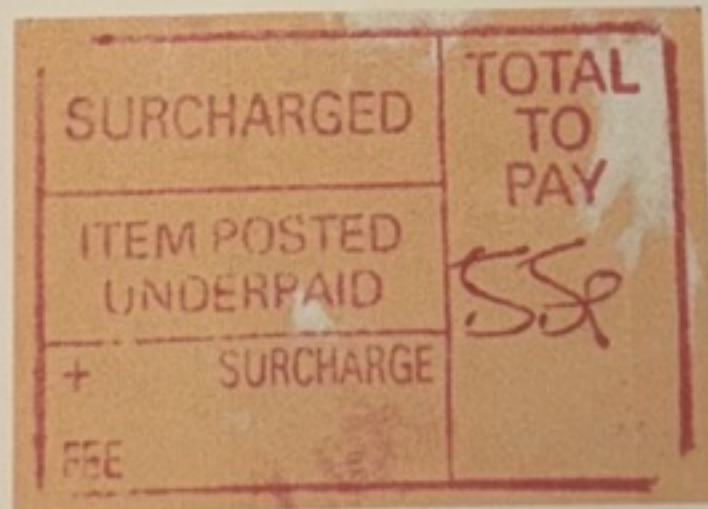
