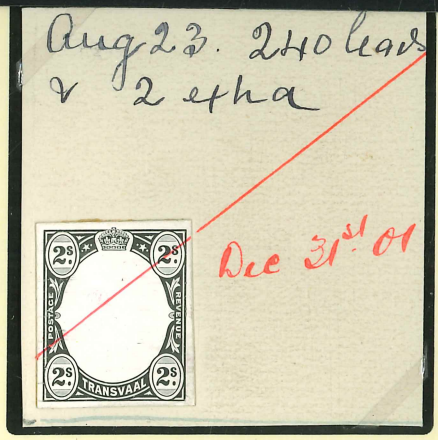
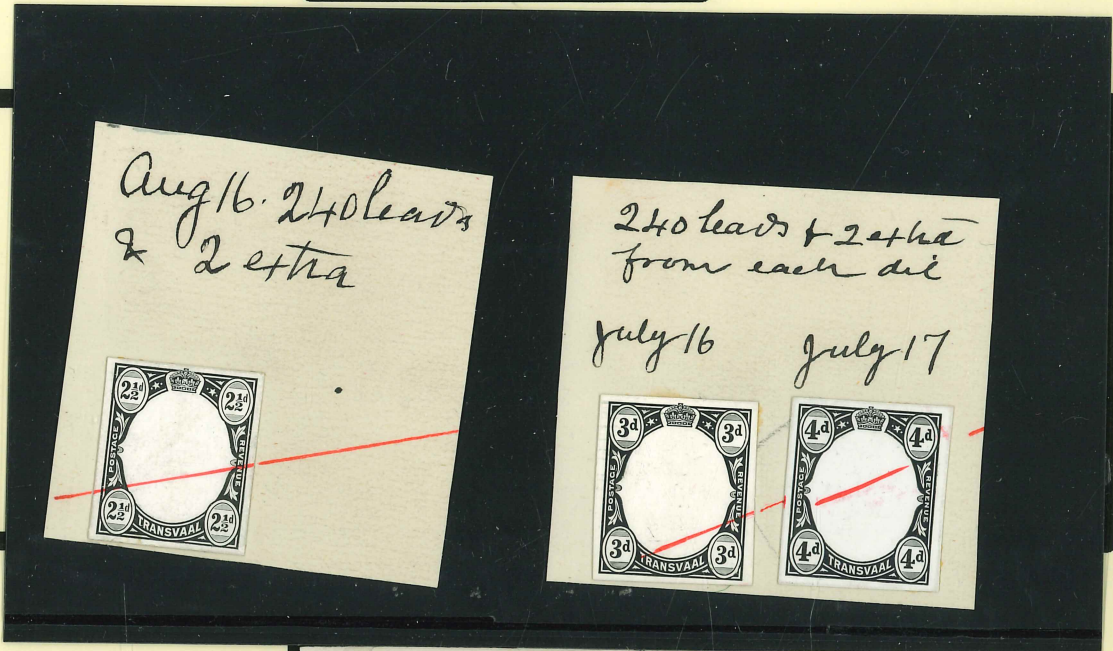
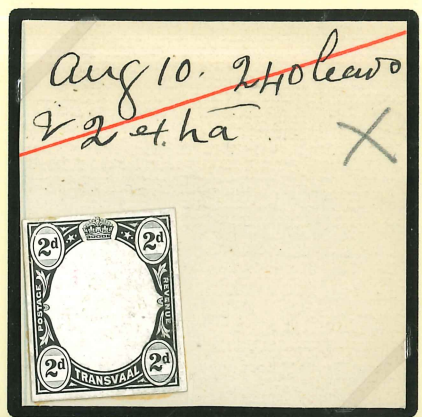


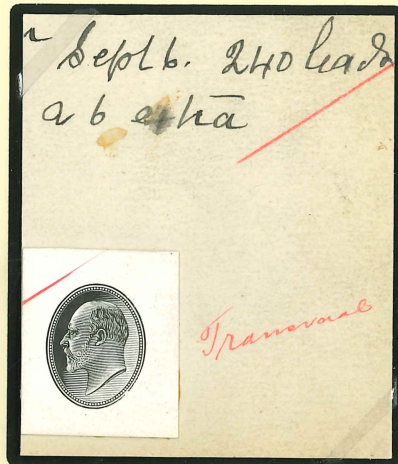
Dual Purpose Postage and Revenue Stamps



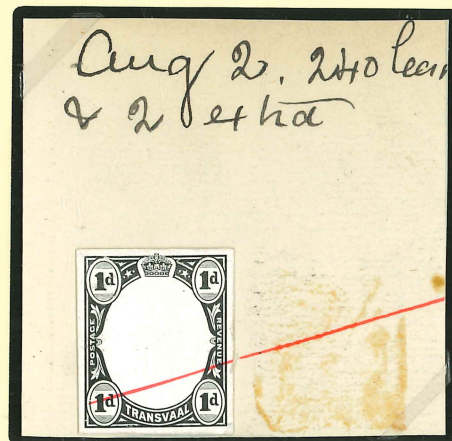
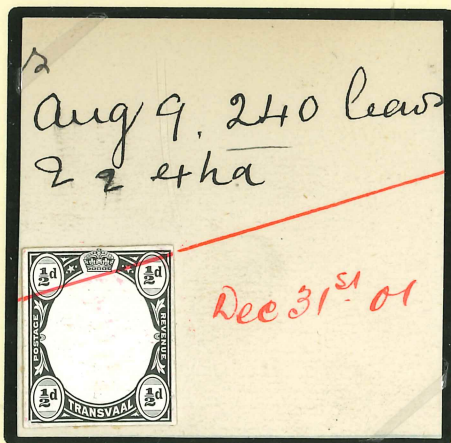

Dual Purpose Postage and Revenue Stamps

In addition to the large size revenue stamps, the Transvaal also issued small size dual purpose postage and revenue stamps.

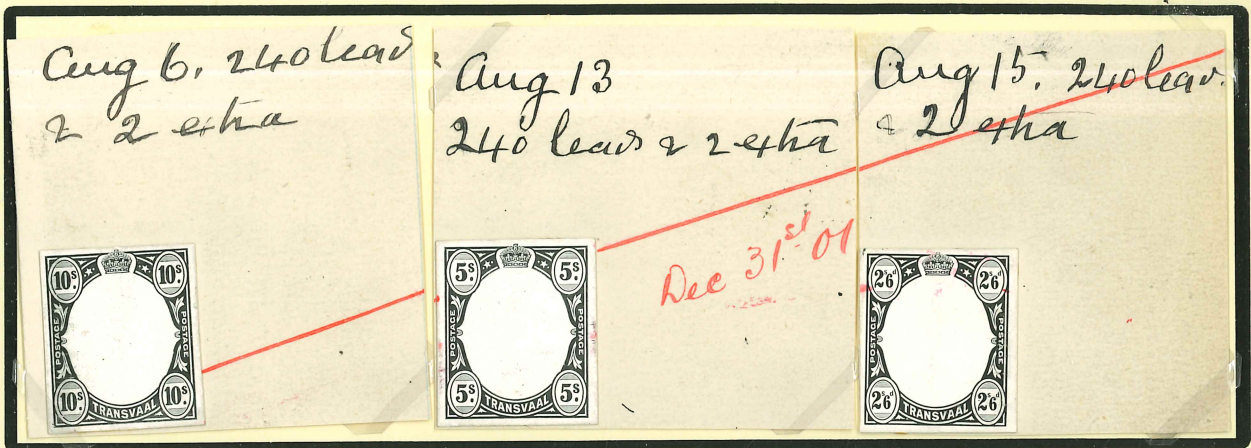

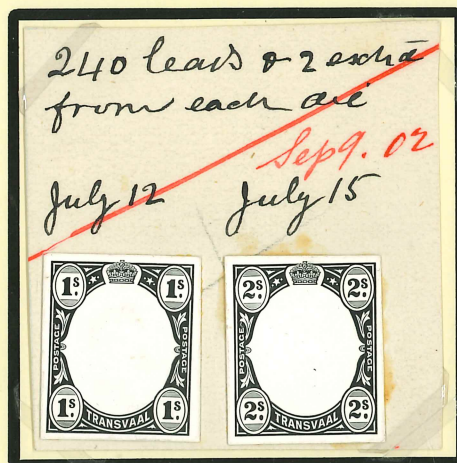

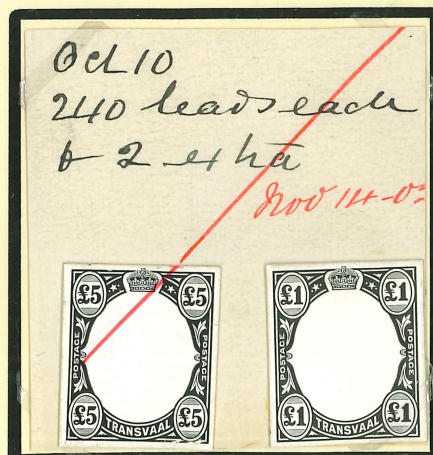
Die Proof for Postage Stamps
