# 1901 Emergency Issue 5p

In line with the russification tendency, preparations for an overall reform of the stamp design for the Grand Duchy of Finland started in the late 1890s. The validity of lion-type stamps ended on 14 January 1901; as regards letters abroad, their validity had officially already ended on 14 August 1900. As ring-type stamps were sold out at the post offices, Russian stamps had to be used instead.

The first stamp with the new design was the letter press stamp that has the same design as the Russian stamps but the face value is in the Finnish currency. Comb perforation 14 1/4 : 14 3/4. These stamps were valid for use until 14 May 1911.

## SHORTAGE ISSUE 1901

01/14/1901 Finland Stamp Office printing press work O / Y Tilgmann kemigraafisesti manufactured by procedures involving the 25 cliches, of which 100 characters comprising the printing plate was assembled. Burrelage (model, Pp1, pictures 14) was similar to the printing plate. Peripheral watermarked paper, vellum white. Comb-tooth, 14 1/4 x 14 3/4.

The imperf items are possibly scrap.

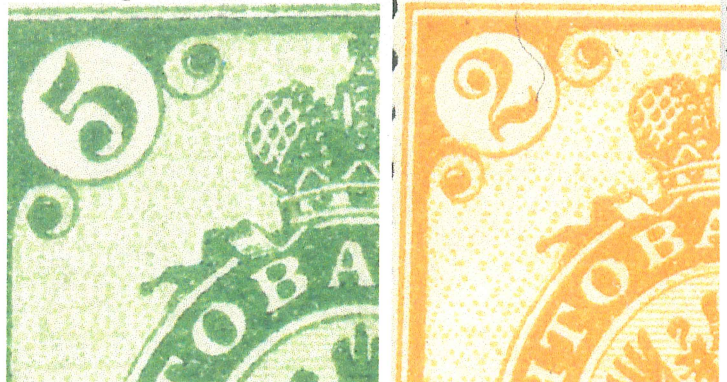
Note! Character cliches are spaced group of projects the image smaller than the group of icons from.

Unusual perforations had not been seen used. O / Y Tilgmann delivered the ordered number of cliches on day 8 12 1900 (p. 10) and the print job was started printing at stamp office the next day, but

was terminated on 16 12.1900 because it proved that it was not possible to obtain acceptable results. The plate was scrapped, as well as most of the printed characters. Only a small part of (200,000) were endorsed in order to be able to supply distant POs with new stamps in advance of the 14 1 1901. The finished stamps were delivered to the post office 24.12.1900. Unused stamps are known very little, maybe only 2 sheets. In addition, in the last twenty years or 2-3 sheets of scattered items.

"Trials" on stamp paper scraps, as well as a color range from gray to green, without burrelage. Both have a field type 83 plate error, the southern outer frame in half to about 2 mm. So far, this error is not found in all actual postage stamp. Similar "trials" are found on paper with large amounts. They come from the stamp office printer and represent the kind of wreckage, which should have to be burned.

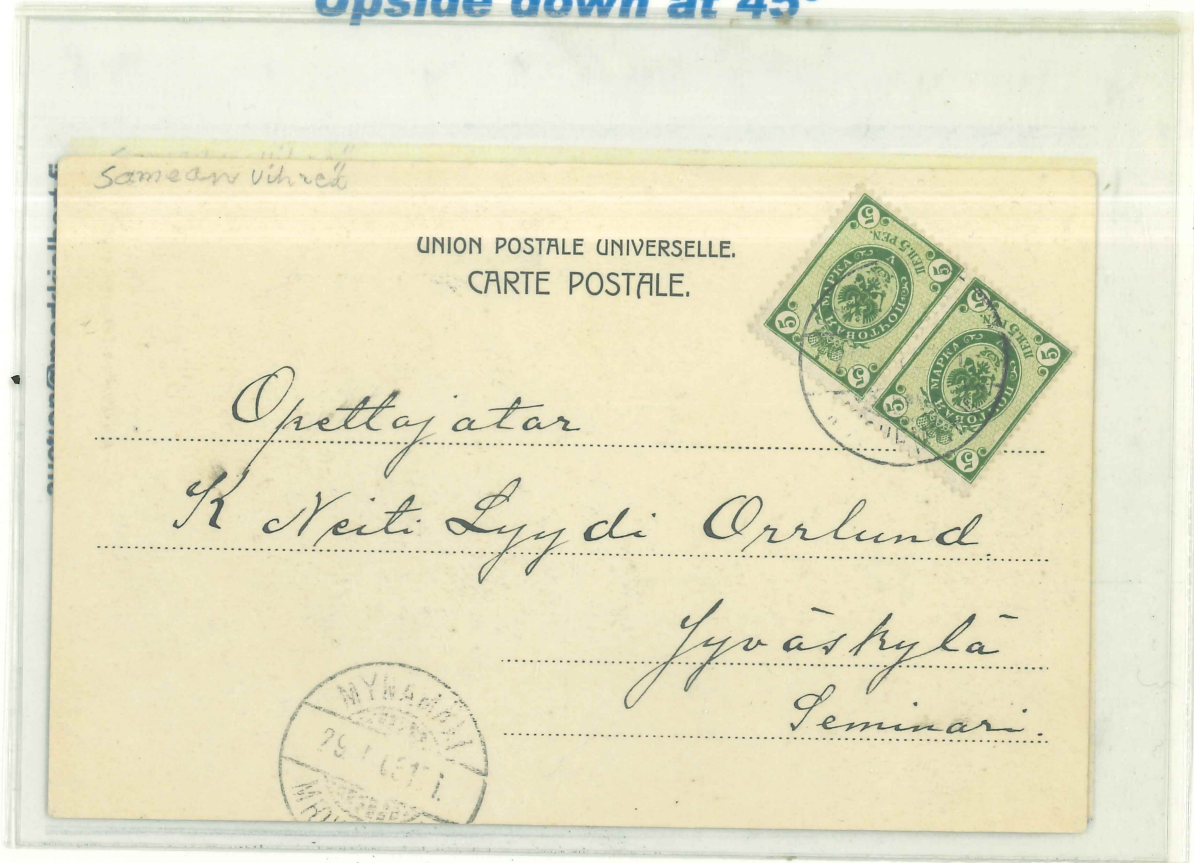

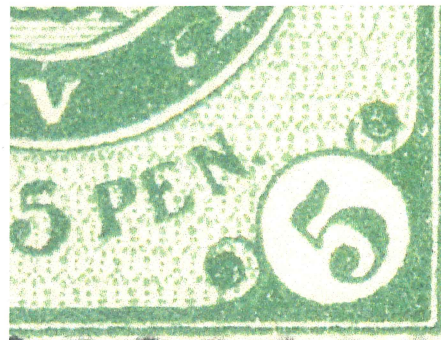
