The block below shows the first of the two arrows of plate 1. The B12 shows the original small arrow, as well as the sheet number. It is from an early printing, with inverted W/M and no line on the left spire. No doctor blade marks, and the 11th row flaw has not yet appeared on 20/6.

The four corner blocks have inverted W/M and are apparently from the 1st printing. Or at least very early. None of the doctor blade scratches have developed. Also, No. 20/6 does not show the spire on the left steeple.

Coil Stamps**

2d coil stamps were issued in November 1931 for the convenience of business. Very short lived, due to the introduction of meter machines. Issued between plates 1 and 2. Colour generally lighter than plate 1, almost the London colour. They are quite scarce, especially used, as they are hard to identify. Many of the stamps show no flaws, and most are so light that flaws often do not print. many stamps have not been seen at all, so identifying marks are unknown. Printed 6 wide, 22 long.

Booklets-Aeroplanes**

The most outstanding flaw on the Roto 1 booklet stamps are called the Purple Aeroplanes. There are two of them, on the English 5/3 and the Afrikaans 16/1. Oddly enough, they are not mentioned in the Handbook. Considerable mystery surrounds them, as the two examples are identical, but reversed. This implies that they are actually a form of Multi-positive flaw, although 5/3 is considerably larger than 16/1. The printing was done after plate 2, but before plate 3.
