Experimental Marking 1856-1859

To Peterboro, Canada West, 22 July, 1859 —15 days approximate

Unpaid letter from Row, Scotland. 29 manuscript: 25¢ US equivalent to 1/- rate and 4¢ inland Canada due. 22 July Helensburgh, parent post office for Row, 22 Glasgow, 23 Liverpool Carried by Cunard Persia 3 August arrival New York, inland via US to Petersboro.

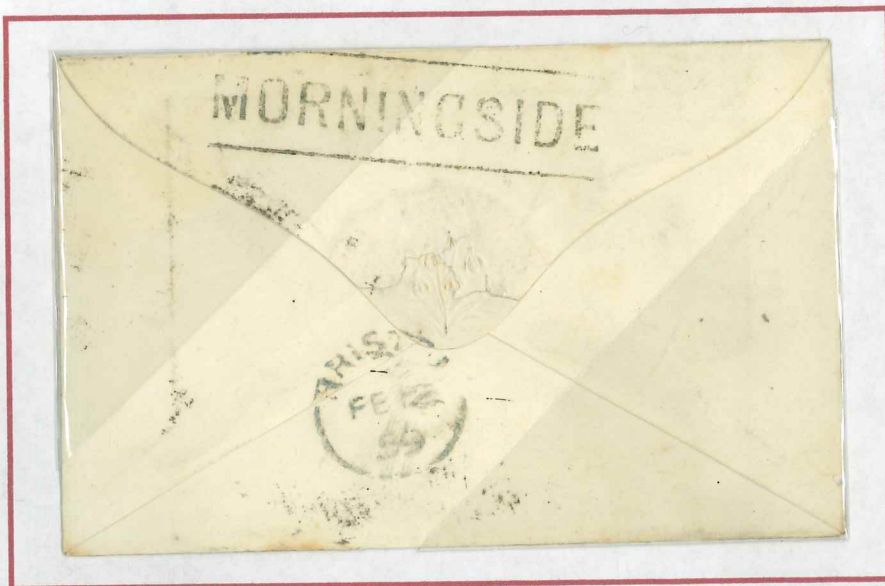
