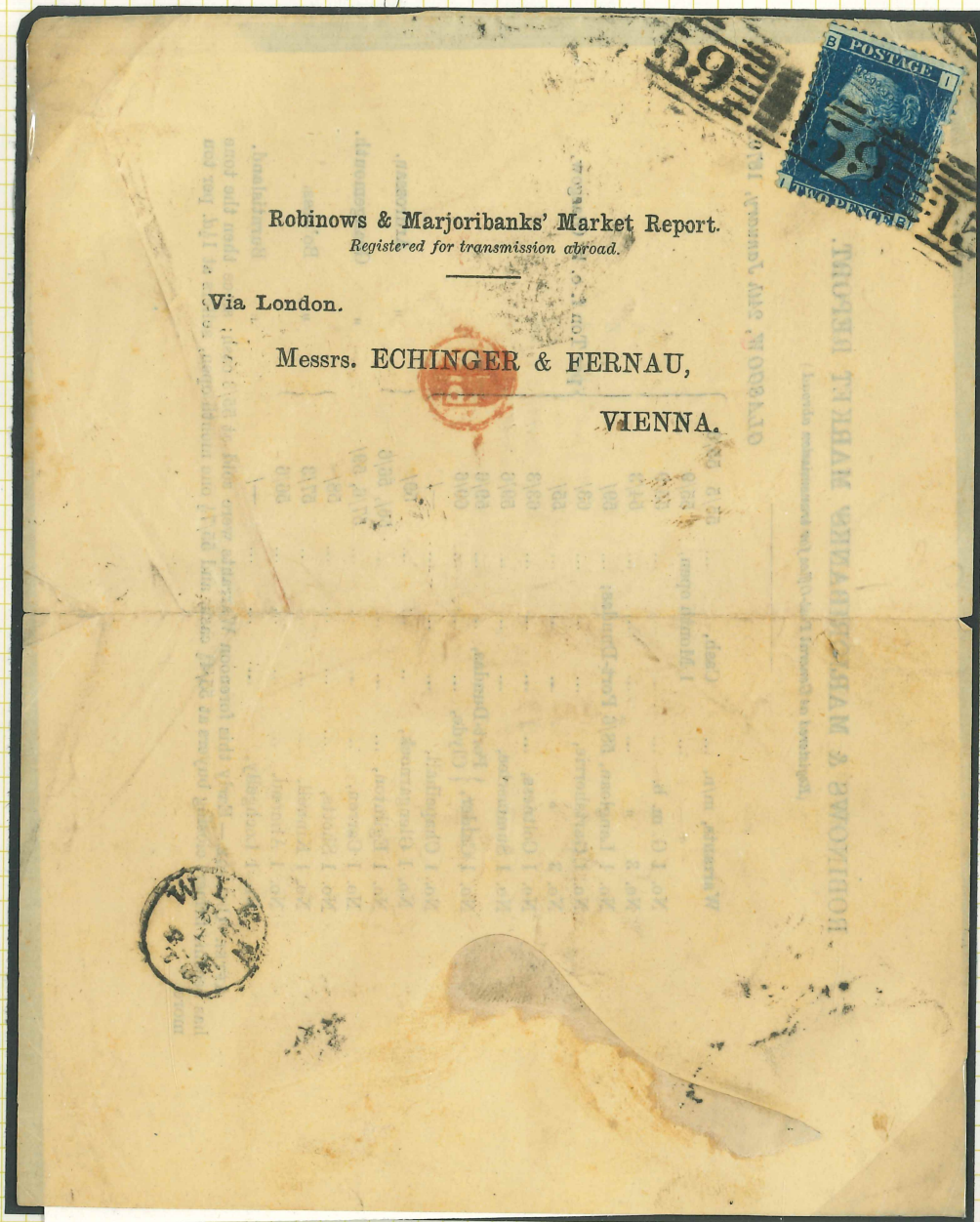

Vienna arrival backstamp 23 January.

December 1857. Glasgow to Jerez, Spain.

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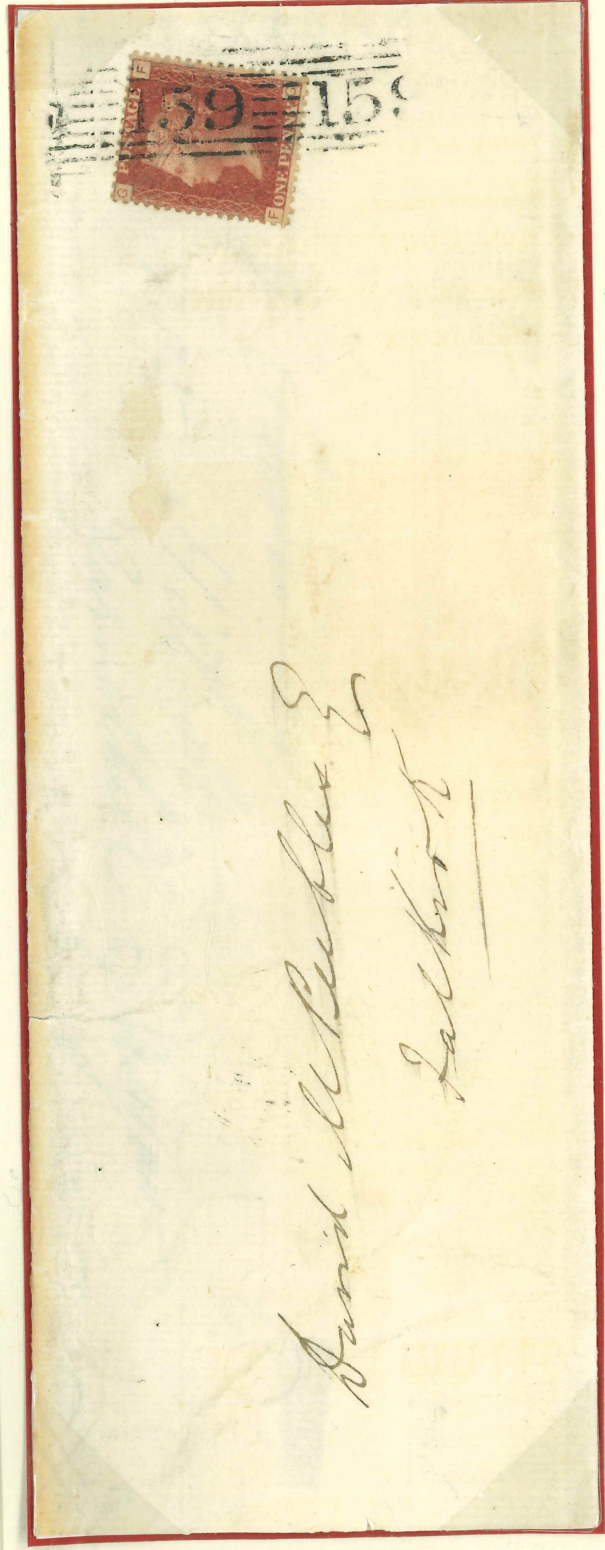

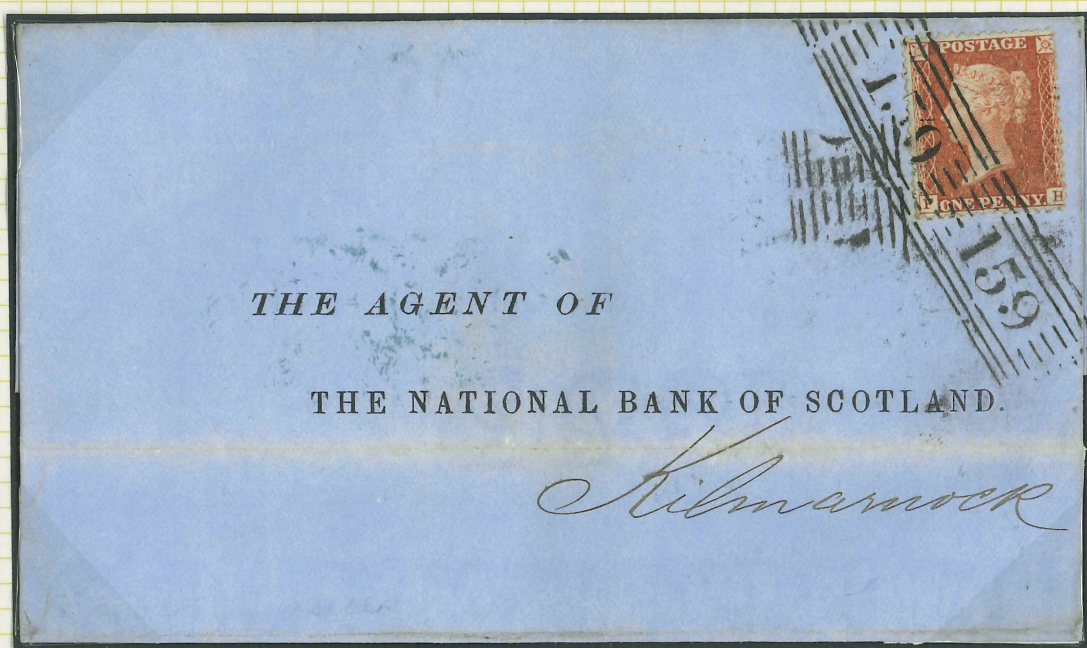
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Glasgow Postal History

The Glasgow 'Roller' cancellation



June 19th, 1857. To Kilmarnock.

Red paying postage cancelled by '159' roller.

Glasgow departure and Kilmarnock received backstamps.

The first roller cancellation was issued to Edinburgh in 1855. The exact date of commencement and period of use is unclear. Greenock and Stirling were also supplied with humeral rollers (thought to have been used to speed up cancellation their exact use, if any, is far from certain).

RETURN for the Assessment of Profits in Trade, Professions, &c., under Schedule D, for the Year ending 5th April 1861.

This letter, dated November 29, 1856, shows the first type of roller cancellation.

Hand Roller Cancellations
In the mid-1850's, roller type cancellations were used for the first time in Edinburgh. The first roller, which gave a repetitive pattern, consisted of three horizontal bars above and below the office number with four lines at the sides and a vertical dividing line between these components.
