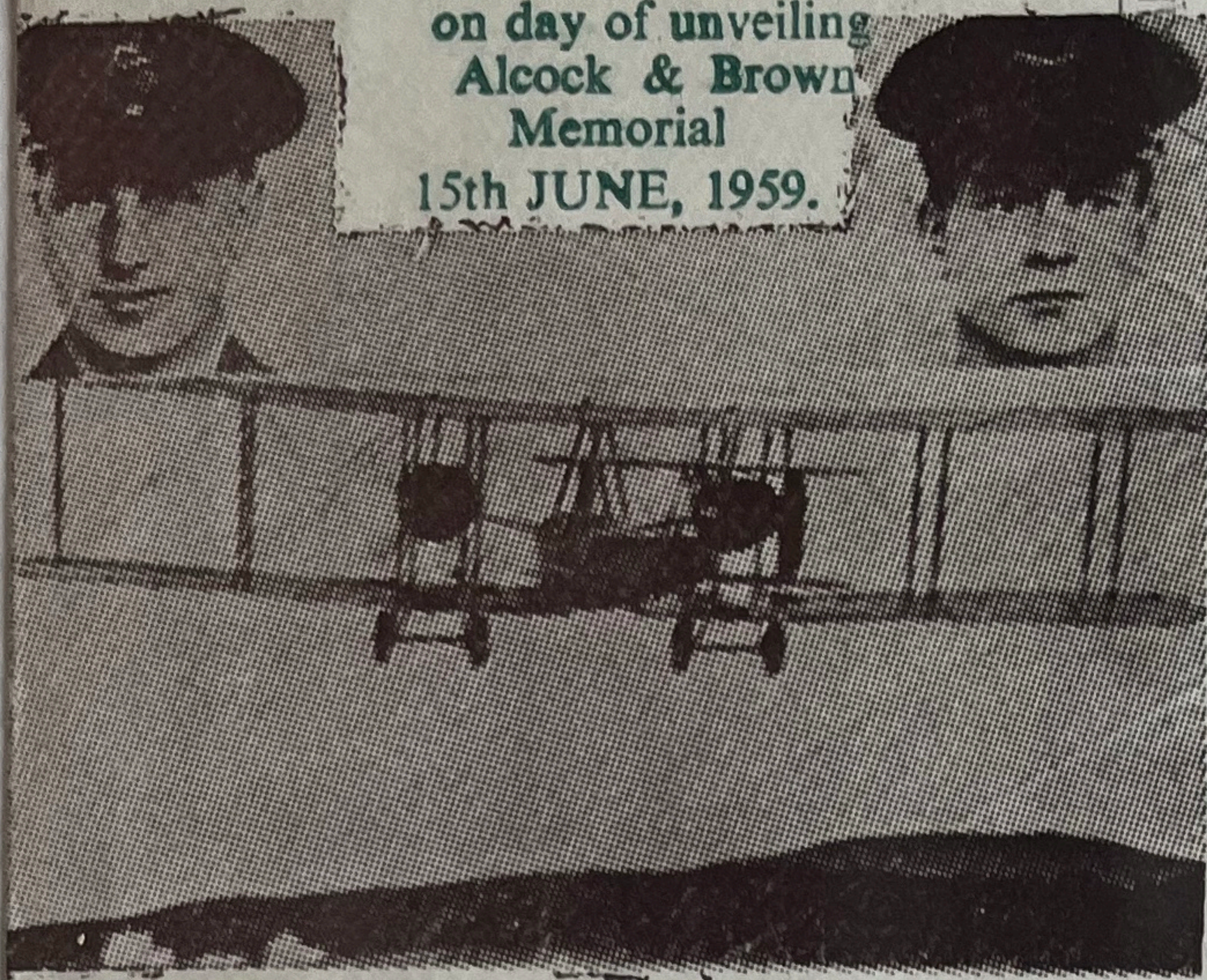

The original Iolar, a five-seater DH Dragon, was the aircraft which launched Aer Lingus fifty years ago. On 27 May 1936 it operated the inaugural flight from Dublin to Bristol. The aircraft was lost during World War 11. A sister ship also named Iolar now holds the original registration EI-ABI and re-enacted this first flight from Dublin to Bristol on 27 May 1986.

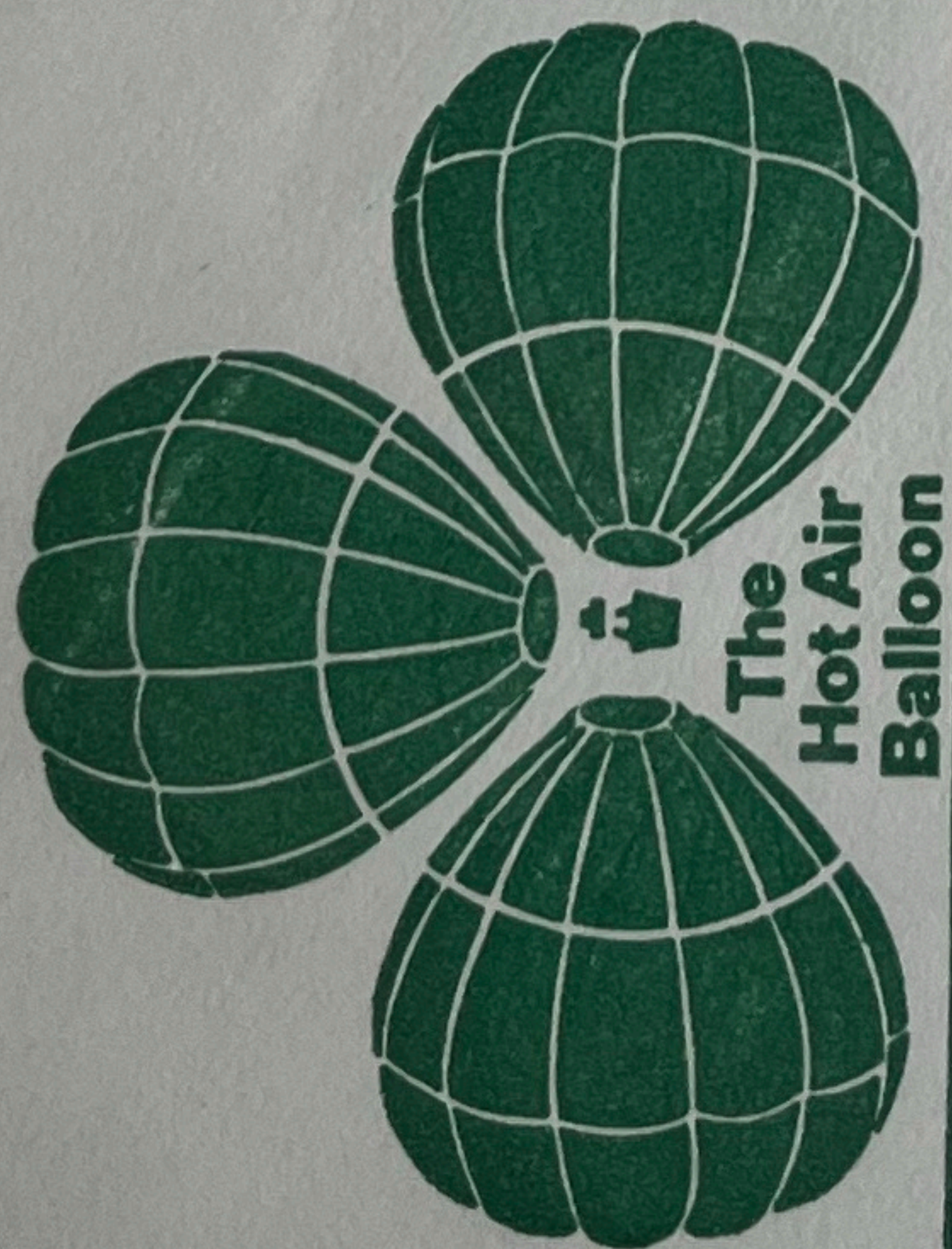
