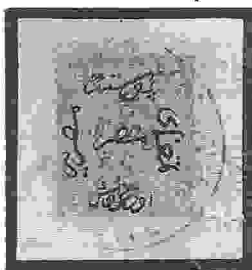

REMARKS This stamp is from the sixth row of the 5 piastres sheet of 200 subjects, but bears the inverted overprint of the fifth row of the 10 piastres sheet (5 piastres design type II, 10 piastres overprint type II, inverted). It is used on piece, tied by the type I-2.5 cancellation of CAIRO/E MARZ 66 (showing inverted '3'). Both the design and the overprint are lithographed on this value.
