Col. The Hon. North de Coigny DALRYMPLE, M.V.O.

2nd son of John Hamilton Dalrymple, 10th earl of STAIR, born on 31st October 1853. Educated at Harrow and joined the Scots Guards in 1871. Married to Marcia Kathleen Anne, daughter of Sir Adelphus Liddell and there were two sons. Served as Adjutant to the 1st Brigade, Scots Guards in the 1st Division in Egypt and was at the Battle of Tel el Kebir, 9th September 1882 later in the Soudan campaign where he was wounded. A major by 1892 and in the South African Boer War he was severely wounded. In 1900 to 1904 he was Lieut. Colonel of the 3rd Battalion, Scots Guards. A member of the Guards and Brooks Clubs. Died on 4th November 1906. Addresses were Bargany, Dailly, Ayrshire and 9, Southwick Close, Hyde Park Square, London
