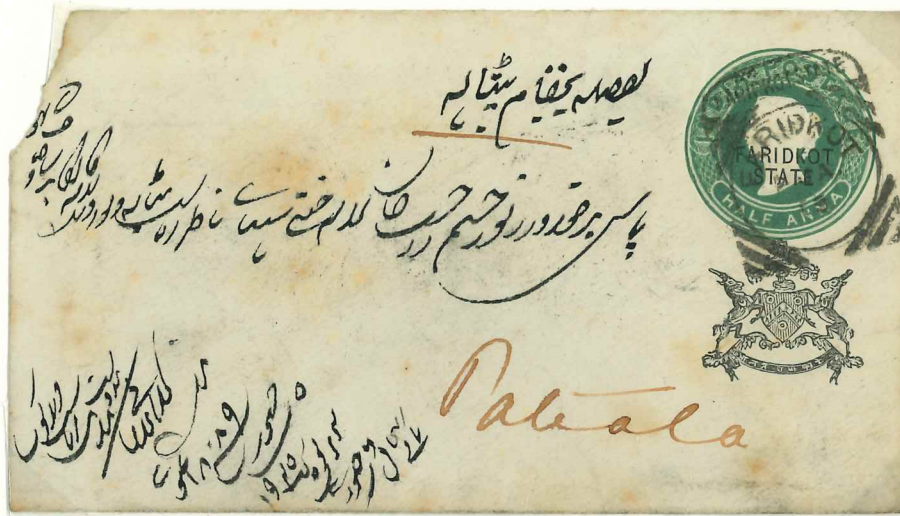
A printed stationary postcard overprinted with "GWALIOR". This also had the state coat of arms printed in black. The card was first issued in 1885.



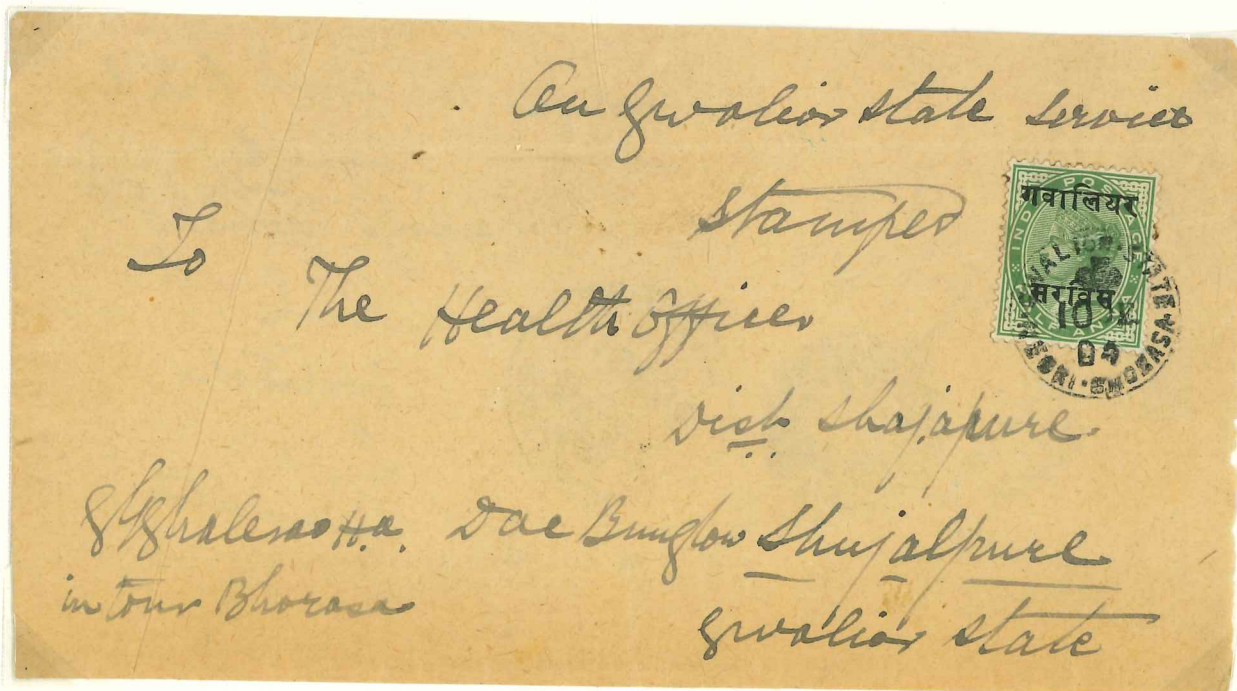
A George V embossed registered envelope for postage ½ Anna and registration 2 Annas, overprinted with "GWALIOR" also in Hindi. With the coat of arms in black. On the reverse are additional stamps to the value of Rs.1-4 ½ Annas. Clearly contained valuables

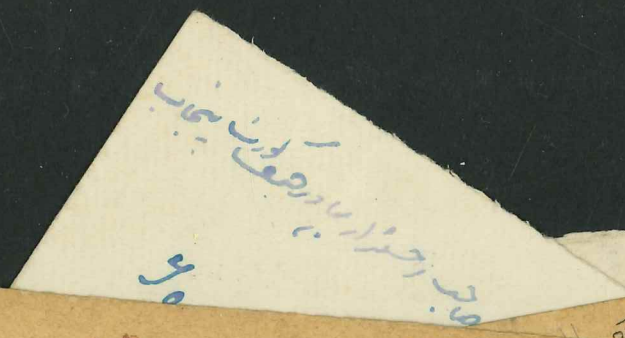


A 1/2 Anna Queen Victoria postal stationary envelope overprinted for the "FARIDKOT STATE" in black with the State coat of Arms. The cancel is Faridkot and the address is Patiala, another Convention State.



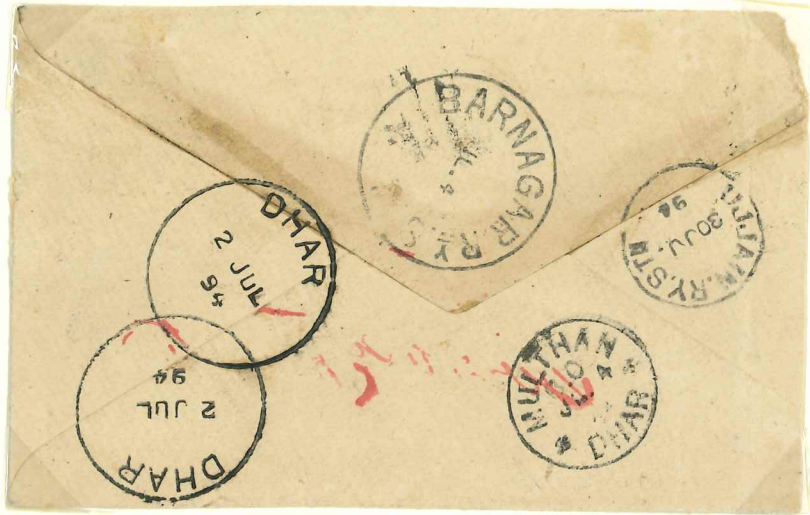
An envelope with a 1/2 Anna Queen Victoria Stamp. The stamp is overprinted in Hindi "GWALIOR STATE" indicating that it is an official letter. The rear of the cover is interesting. There is a Gwalior State "Sholapur" seal and a Sholapur delivery cancel. Apparently an invitation to a marriage.





A Queen Victoria 1/2 Anna postal Stationary envelope overprinted for the Convention State "Gwalior". This is a R.L Type EP1 with the State Arms, in black, below the stamp and the overprint with the Urdu equivalent. The envelope was first issued in 1885. The letter addressed to "Dhar", crossed out and altered in red "moulthan". The letter was posted with the "Ujjain Railway Station" cancel On the reverse are the following transit and receipt handstamps: "Ujjain Ry. STN. 30 Ju '94 : Dhar, two cancels both dated 2 JUL : Multan Dhar dated 4 JUL : Barnagar Ry Stn 4 JUL.

Clearly the letter was received by the Post Office in Dhar who redirected it to Moulthan where it was received in the Moulthan Dhar Post Office.. Presumably Barnagar was its final destination.

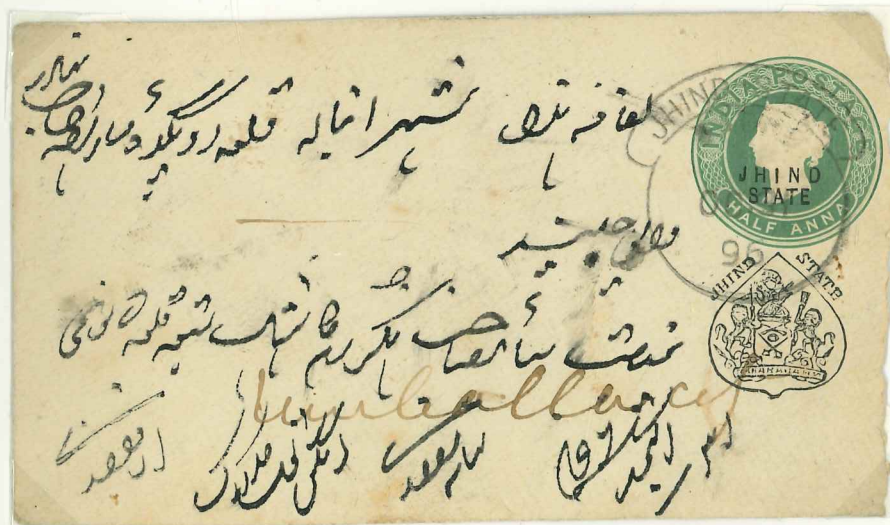

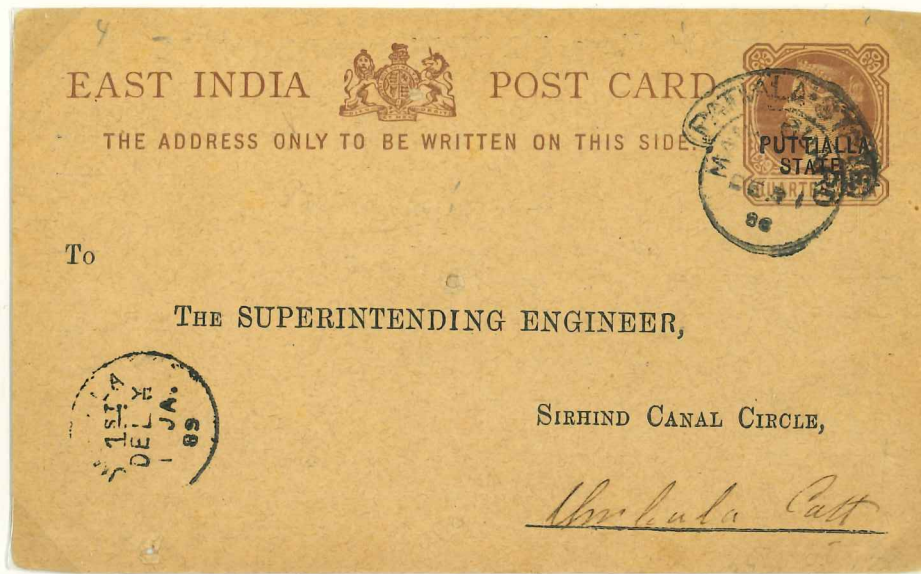
A ¼ Anna printed postcard overprinted "JHIND" in black with the State coat of Arms also in black. This card was first issued in 1888. Note: The sender has written the town of the addressee in English. Umballa was a city in British India



An embossed ½ Anna postal stationary envelope overprinted "JHIND" with the coat of arms in black. This was issued in 1888.



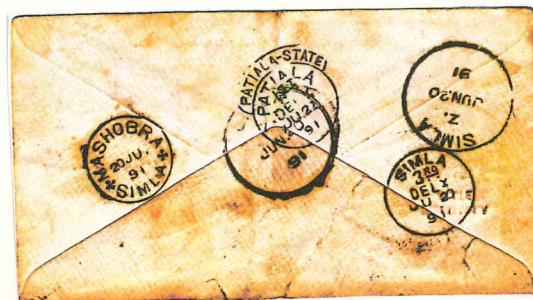
The first printed post card issued by "PATIALLA STATE" in 1884 The overprint is in black and the is no Coat of Arms.



A 1/2 Anna printed postcard overprinted "PUTTIALLA STATE" with the state Coat of Arms also in black. This was issued in 1888. Note: The address is in manuscript Urdu but the town for delivery is written in English



A postal stationary envelope overprinted "PUTTIALLA STATE". There is no coat of arms..The envelopes were first issued in 1885.This envelope was cancelled on the 19th June 1991. It is interesting to note that the address is written in Urdu and the Post Office have clarified it in English. On the reverse it will be seen that it was delayed or returned to Patiala. It did not reached Simla, it's delivery address until the 20th June 91; 18 days later. Not a speedy delivery!!!.



The front of a postal stationary envelope .The George V stamp is overprinted "PATIALA STATE" in black with the State Coat of Arms below. The envelope was first issued in 1922. The cancel is Patiala State and the letter was sent out of the state . No additional postage was required.
