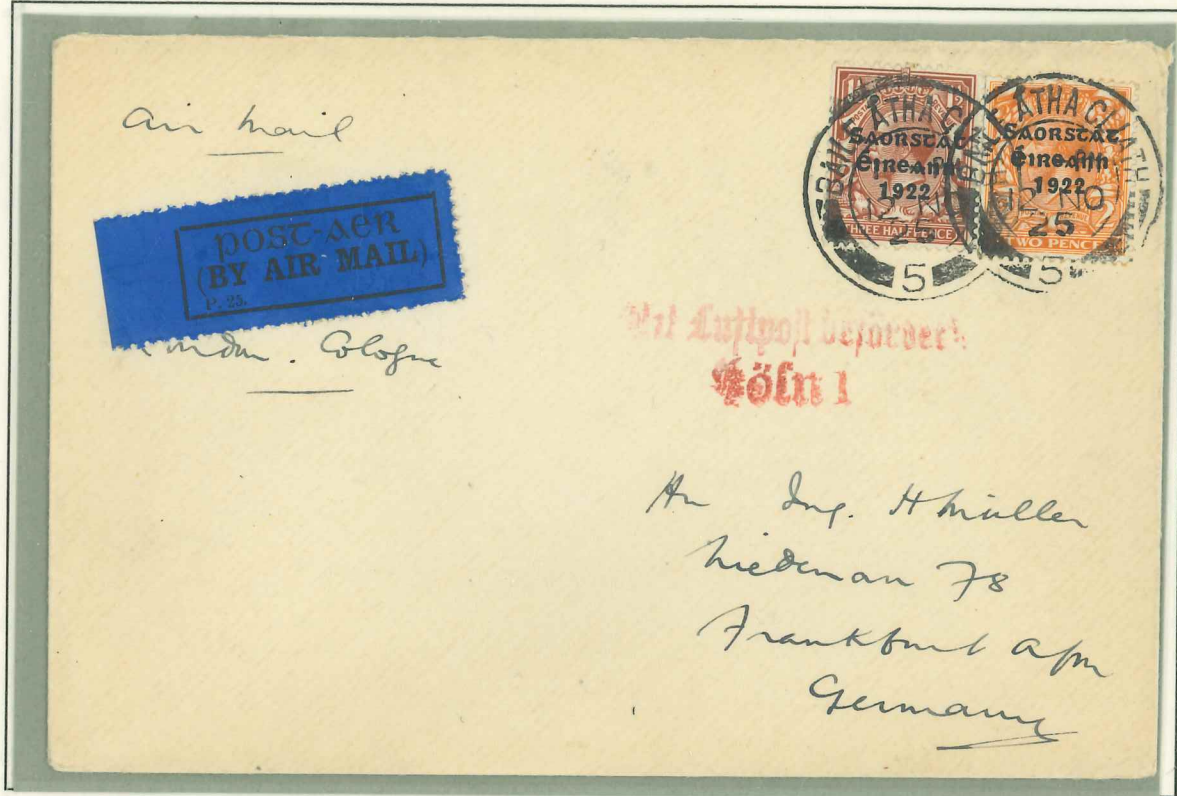

Via London - Cologne Air Mail.

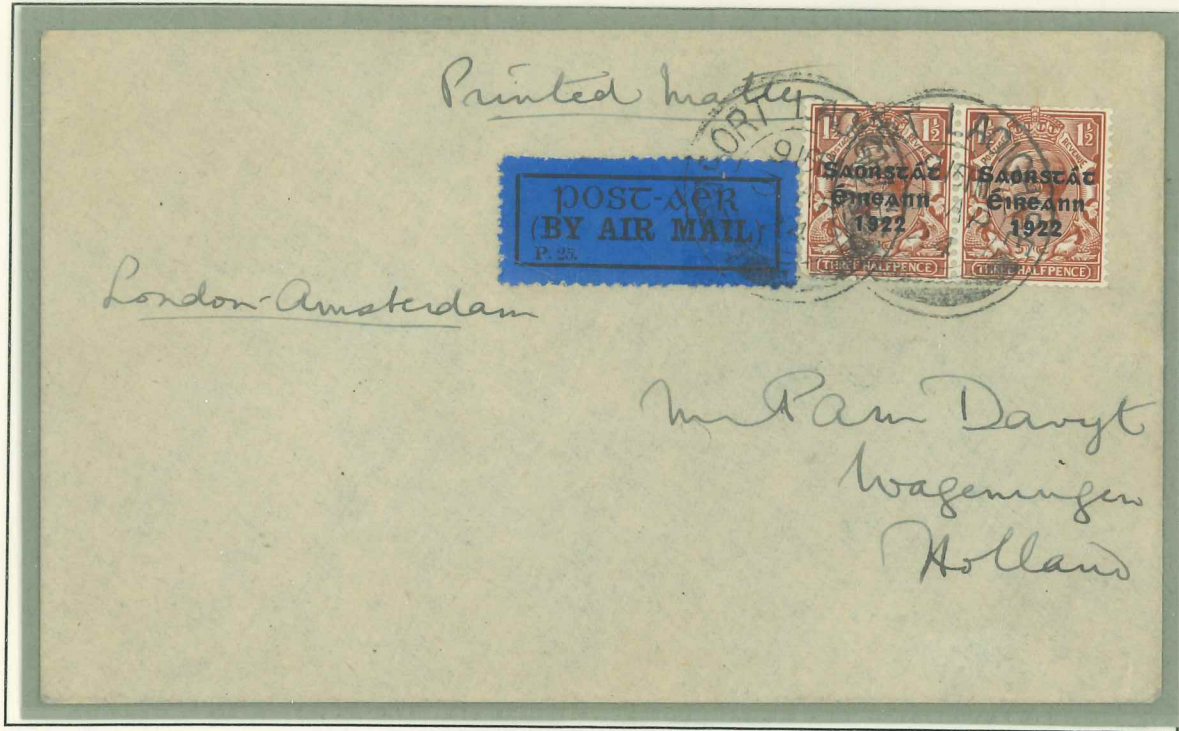
Although intended primarily for British military forces mail, the Instone air service carried mail to civilian addresses. The "British nature" of the destination is indicated by the rate. The foreign letter rate was 3 pence, whereas the British Commonwealth preferential rate was 1 1/2 pence.

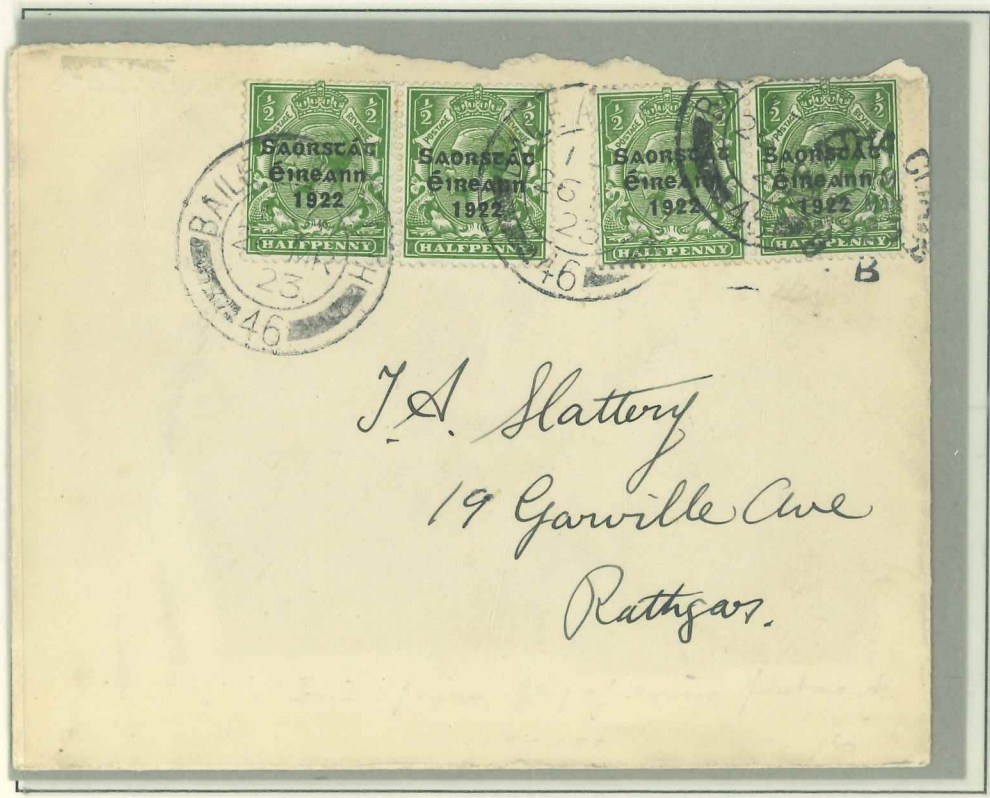
