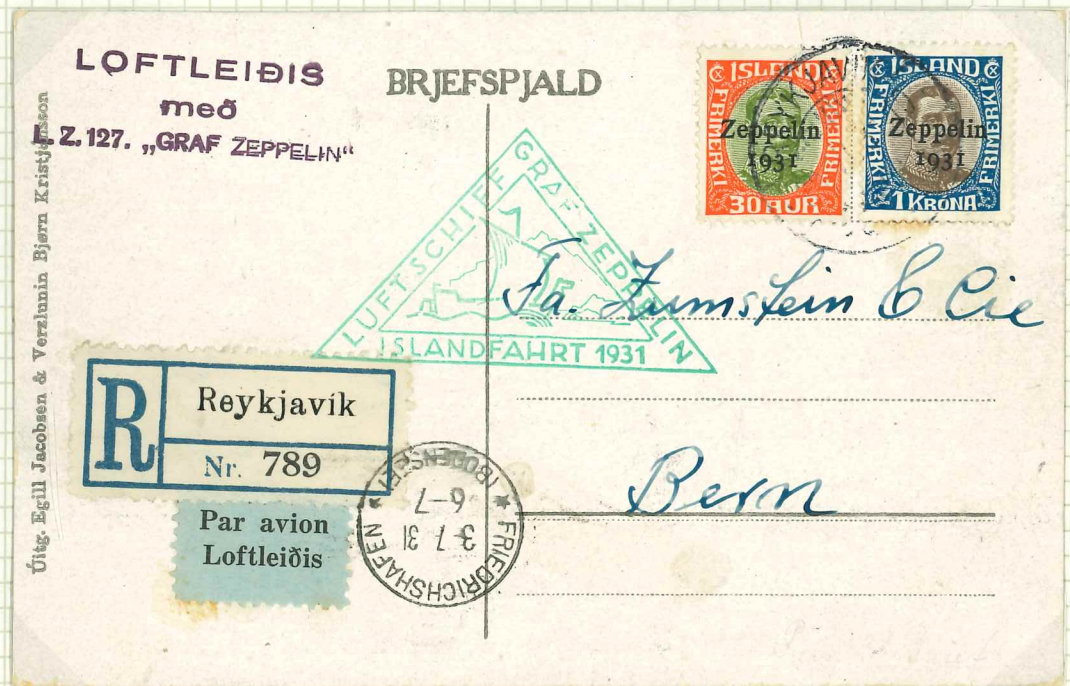
The Graf Zeppelin 'LZ 127' made two flights to Iceland. The first in July 1930, the second in July 1931. Both were proving flights for the Arctic Scientific Expedition which took place in August 1931.

Mail was carried on the return leg of the 1931 flight using the specially overprinted stamps.

1 Krona for Postcards, 2 Kronur for Letters and 30 Aurar for registration, if required.

The Post Office stated that these stamps were only valid for this flight.
