'Dear Buckle, IU received your kind letter of the 17th yesterday morning and should have answered it immediately had I not been writing to my sister and others in England all the day.

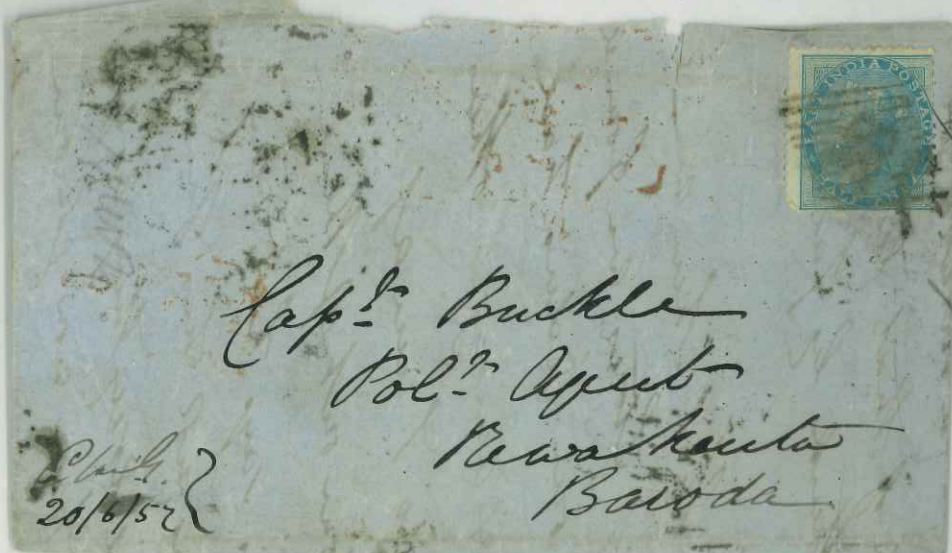
I was very sorry to hear of you having received bad news from England of your mother's health. I am sure I hope and trust it is nothing very serious and that you will be allowed by God's mercy to return to England and see her again but with the heart complaint life is so uncertain that she may be spared for many years or carried off in a moment.

I am very glad that you have at last made up your mind to go to England again for I think you would not recover your health in this country. The work you have been doing the last 8 or 9 months has, greatly impaired your constitution & nothing but a great change in climate would ever set you to rights again. I think we had better change the subject as it is a gloomy one. Martial Law has at last been proclaimed here & everybody going about the streets after dark without a pass and not able to give a good account of himself is to be shot down.

I began to write this yesterday but was interrupted & was not able to finish it so I am now going to give you what news I can. Alban arrived yesterday at 12 o'clock but whether the "horses" have arrived I do not know. Rogers, Davis's successor also arrived yesterday but what his views are regarding this riot I do not know. I only hope & trust he will be more decided in his movements. We have been here a month and during the whole of that time we have been bothered by false alarms etc.

I am sorry to say that when we opened our mess stores we found that several of our orders had not been met and amongst others your Dubba's so I am afraid you will be done out of them this rains Lewis says he is very sorry but it was not his fault, he having ordered everything that you requested. We have now got our mess up and are very comfortable. Davis is going to take up a post at Bhowanagger and that is the reason Rogers is coming up, I suppose however you knew this some time ago. Everything is quiet just now but I dare say we shall have something to do before long as they are going to snatch some of the ringleaders either today or tomorrow.

A local prestamp cover sent from Bombay to Madras. The letter has the **BOMBAY** HG Type 18 (37mmx25mm) in use from 1845-58. The date of despatch is Nov 1853 and the postage paid As.10. The letter was received in Madras early December. The "**G.P.O.1853 DEC**" HG MX5 was applied. The "AM" is the time of delivery.



A local cover sent from Shubkudur (Peshawar) to Amritsur. The cover has an As.1/2 stamp cancelled with an all India Cancellation RL Type 9ii Peshawar (47) dated 9th April 1866. There is a transit stamp "Amritsur" dated 11th April 1866 and a receipt stamp "Umritsur".



A local cover with a number of post office handstamps. The earliest would appear to be "KOTLA" dated 20th April. It is probable that this office applied the TOO LATE stamp to indicate that it had missed the 20th April. There then follows the following stamps. DEOLEE:22nd April : SEEKUR:23rd April. NUSSEERABAD:23 April (probably a transit stamp in a hexagon);NAWALGHUR:26th April. All offices are in the Ajmere District. There is no year indicated which would be after 1870.

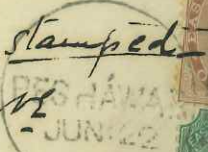

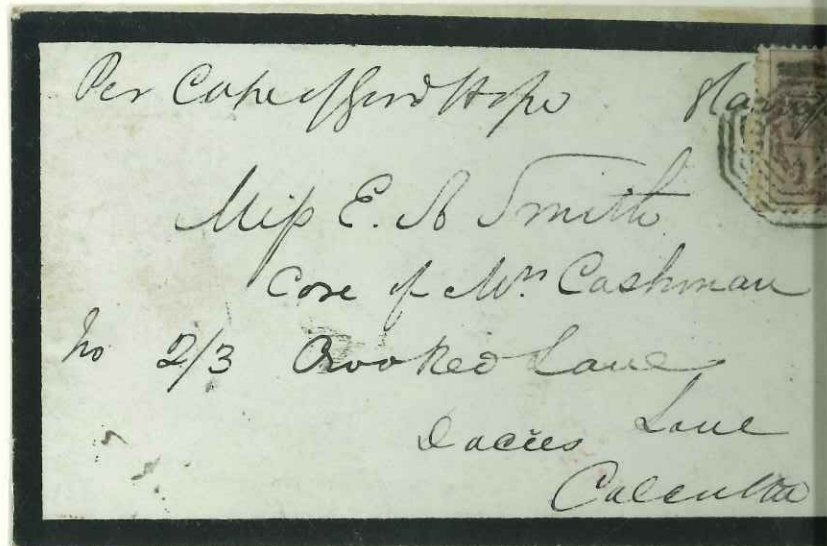
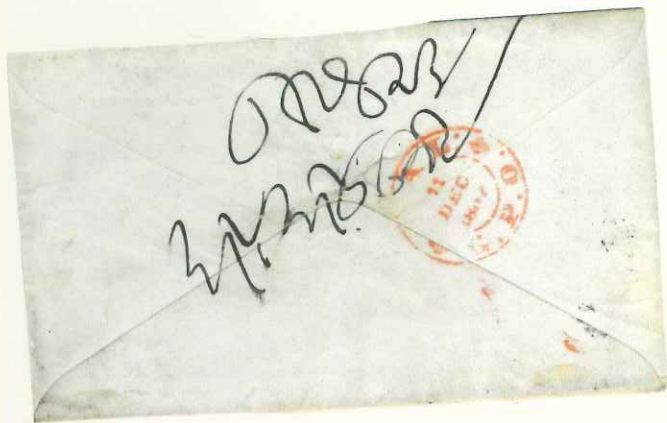

A cover addressed to a lady in Calcutta. The letter has a One Anna stamp, Gibbons Type 11 first issued in 1856, cancelled with a B/1 in a series of octagons. It appears from about November 1855 On the reverse is a Calcutta **CAL G.P.O. 11Dec 1857**. This handstamp was applied by the General Post Office. The cover is of interest as the sender has endorsed it "Per Cape of Good Hope" This would suggest that it was handed over to a ship's captain and posted by him in Calcutta.



A local cover addressed to a member of the 68th Regiment Native Infantry posted in Moorshedabad, the headquarters of the Lalbagh subdivision of the district to Berhampore.. It is not clear whether the Berhampore is in Bengal or Madras. The cancel is a series of octagonals one within the other framing a capital "B" over a number, in this case the number "8". The first use was in 1855 and still continued in some places until 1873. The letter passed through the head post office in Calcutta where the transit stamp HG type G21 , in **Red** was affixed with the date 20th April 1858. There is no receipt stamp but it may be assumed that the destination of the letter was Madras Presidency.
