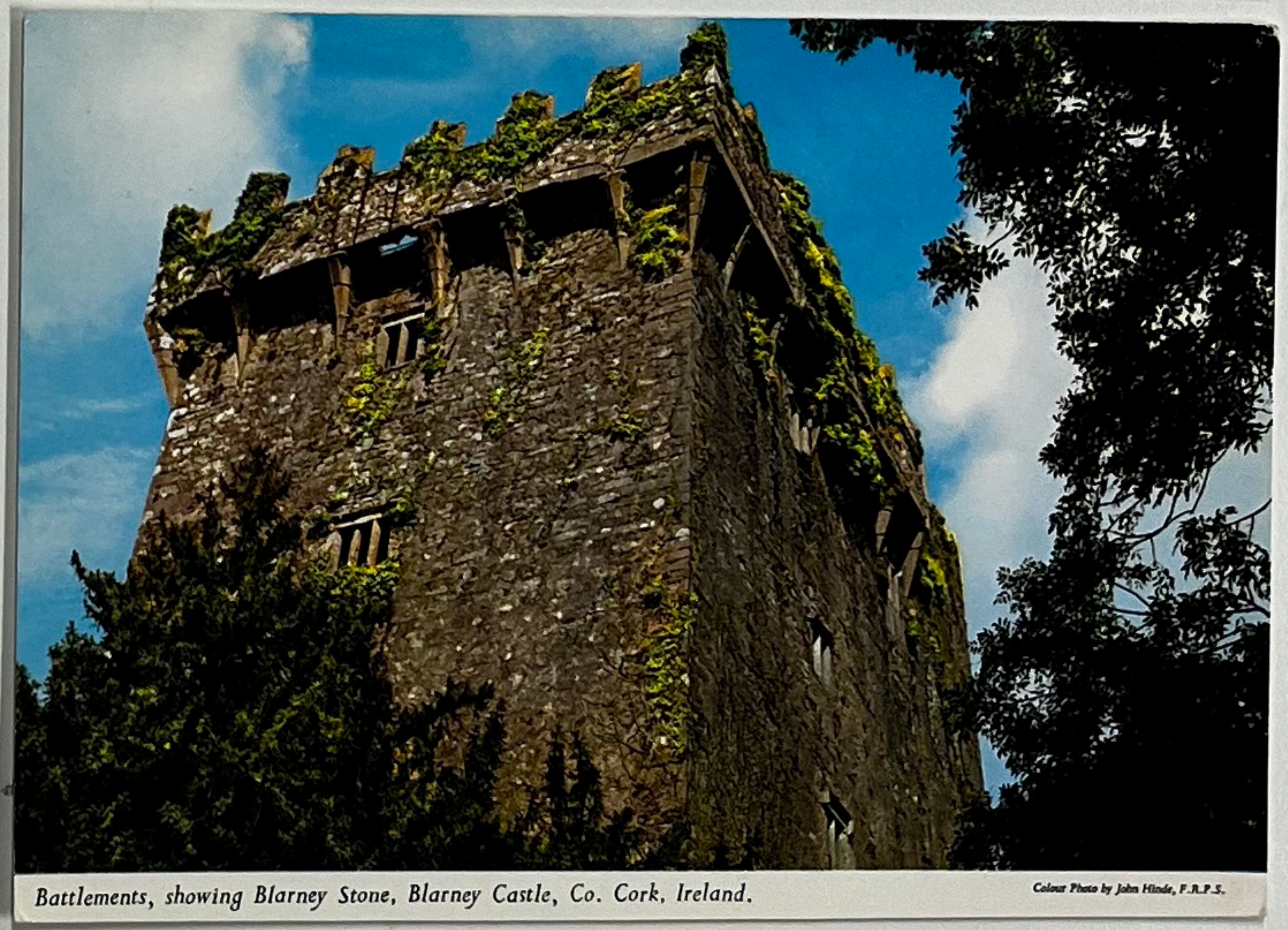
Kissing the Blarney Stone, Blarney Castle, Co. Cork, Ireland



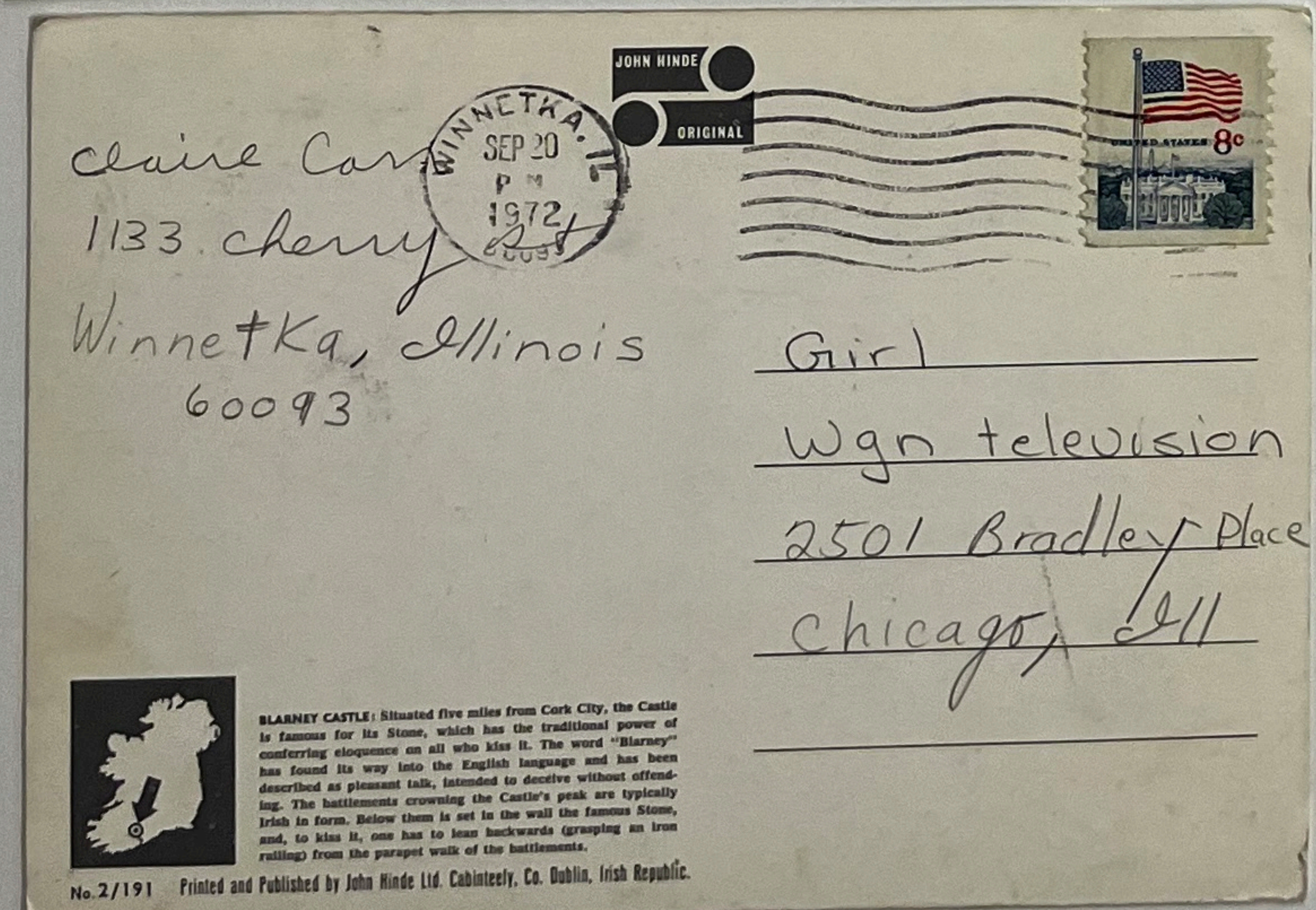

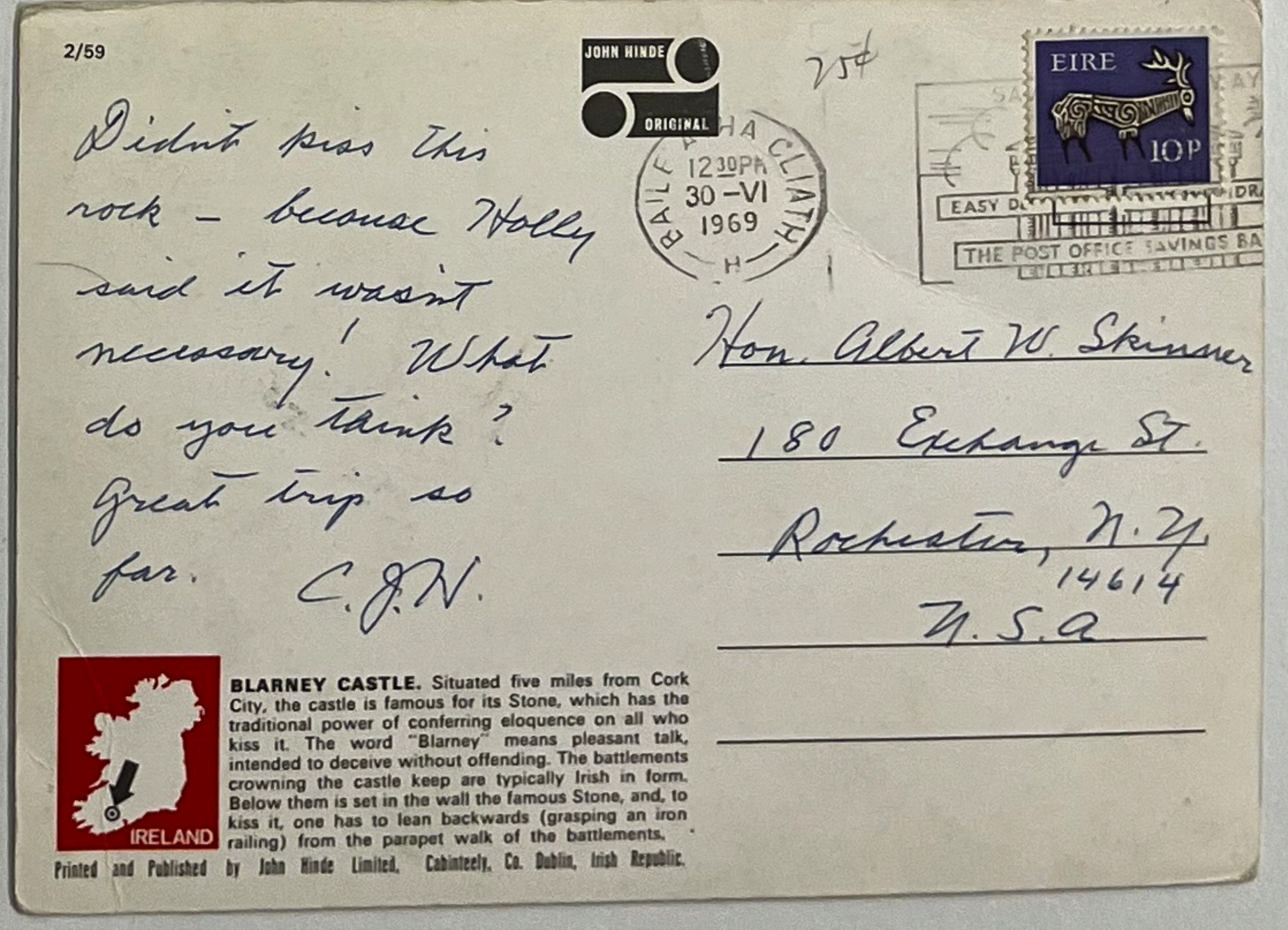

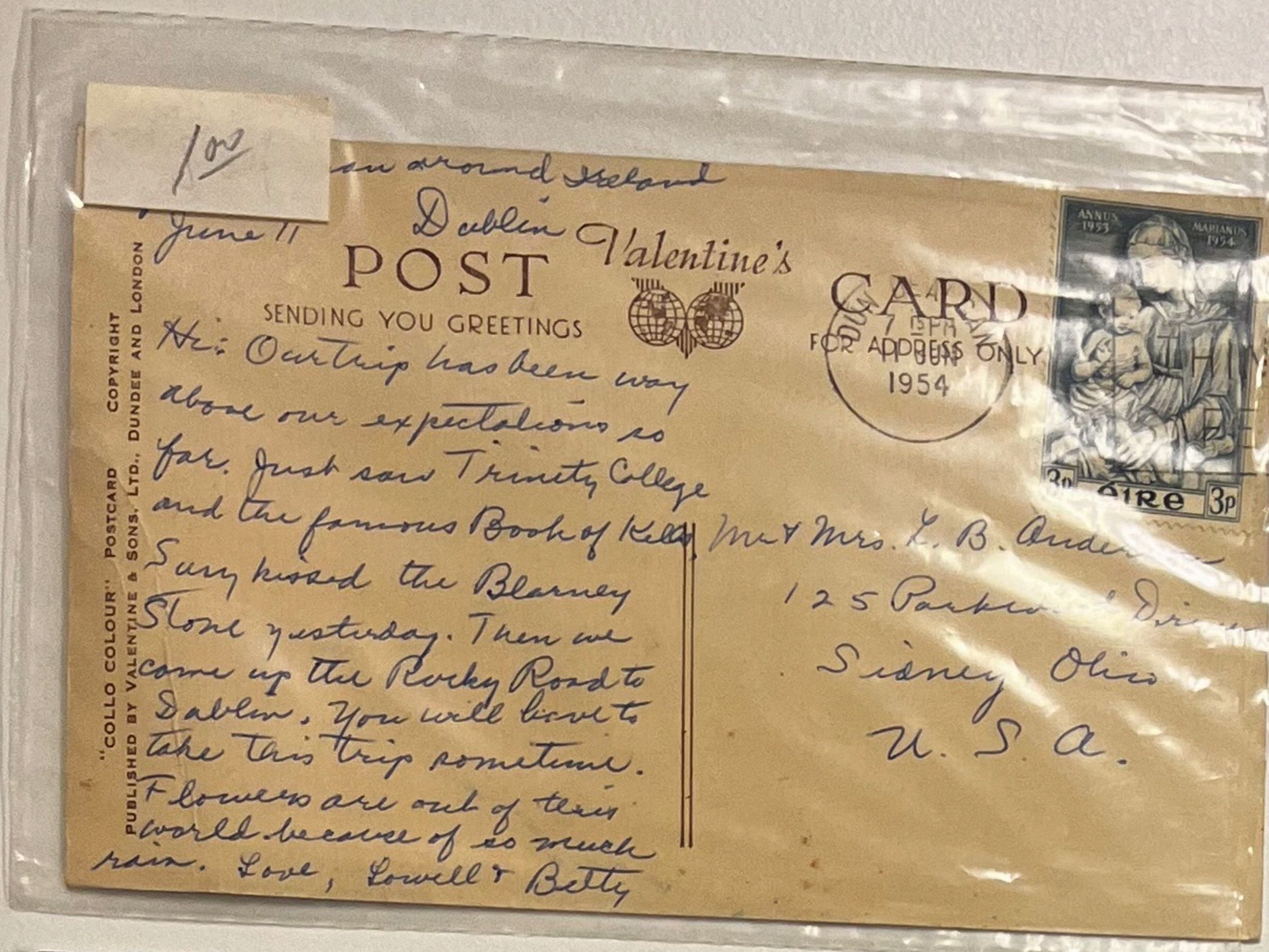
Battlements, showing Blarney Stone, Blarney Castle, Co. Cork, Ireland.

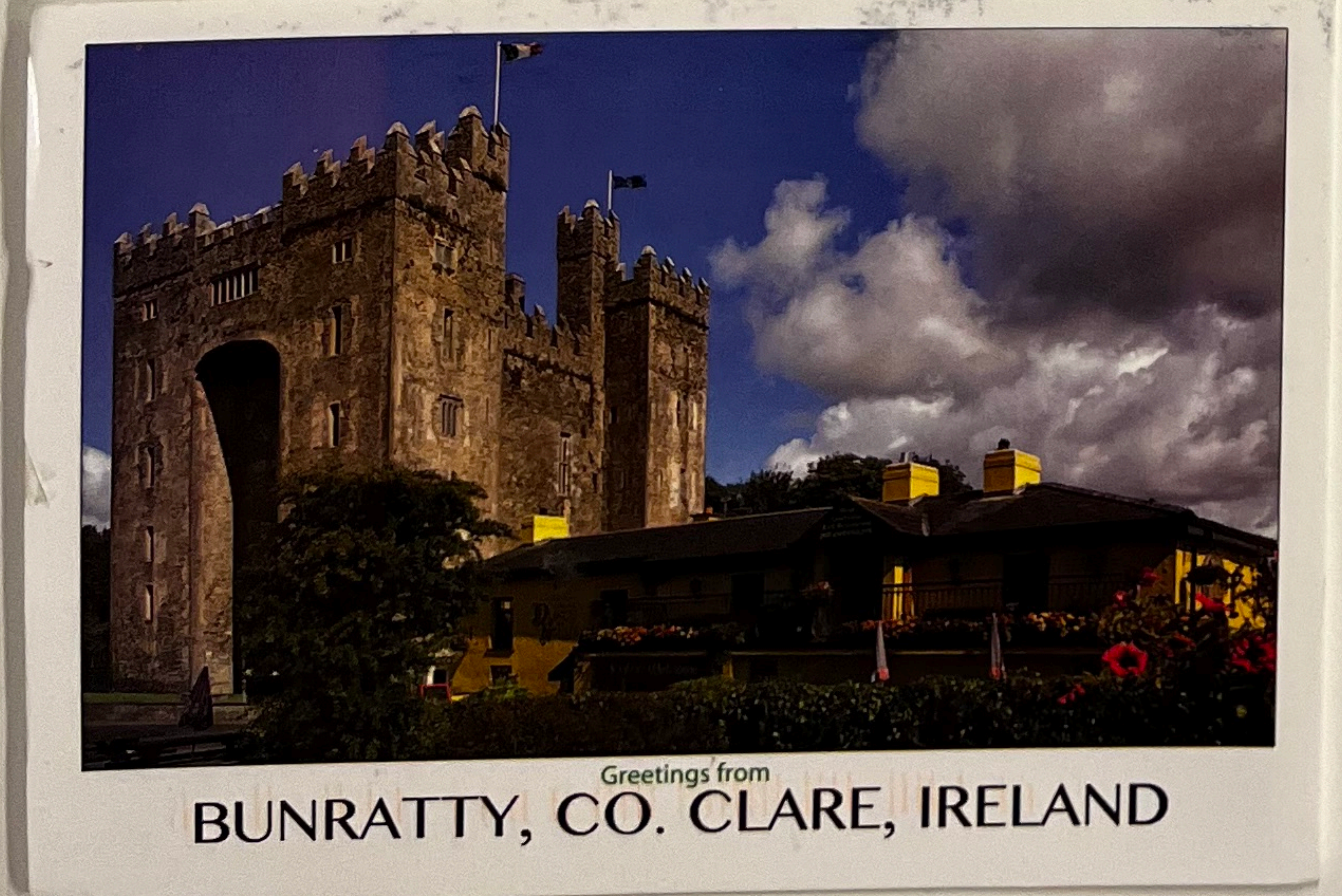
