Issued May 1949—By May 1949 the ONE ANNA on TWO ANNAS stamps were mainly used up and a new provisional stamp was issued with the overprint in red caps **POSTAGE & REVENUE/ONE ANNA** on the HALF ANNA black and deep blue stamps. As for the previous provisional postage stamp of February 1949 the authorities recalled most of the HALF ANNA stamps in the post offices and together with the HALF ANNA stamps in the treasury used the stamps to make the surcharged stamps. A number of varieties are found in both the **POSTAGE & REVENUE** and the **ONE ANNA**. The surcharging was done by the Junagadh State Press.
