Supplies of No. M 1 were issued to members of the Orange
Free State army on active service during the Second Boer War.
To pass free through the U.F.S. fieldpost system letters had to be
franked with No. M 1 or initialled by the appropriate unit
commander. The franks were in use between October 1899 and
February 1900.
No. M 1 was printed in sheets of 20 (5x4) using a setting of
five different types in a horizontal row. The colour in the paper
runs in water.
Typeset forgeries can be identified by the appearance of 17
pearls, instead of the 16 of the originals, in the top and bottom
frames. Forgeries produced by lithography omit the stops after
"BRIEF" and "FRANKO".

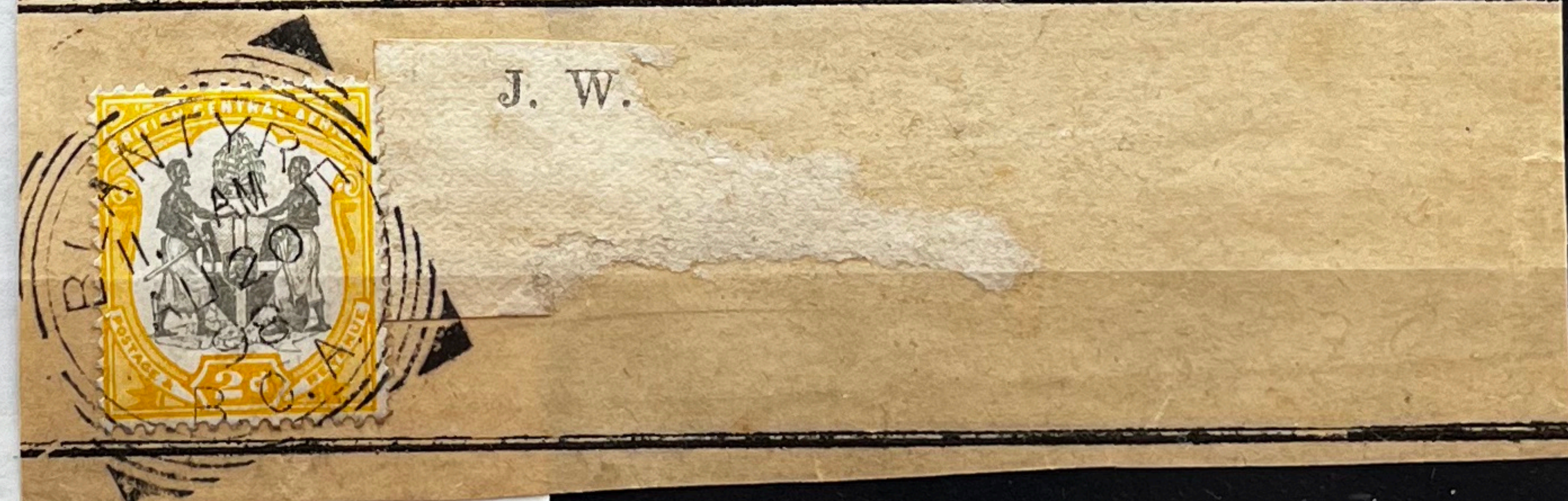
