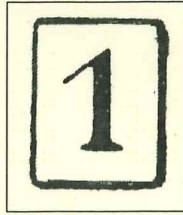


HAITI

1914-15, OVERPRINTED '1' ON 1904-06 INDEPENDENCE AND NORD ALEXIS SERIES

By mid-1914, the stocks of the lowest-value stamps, 1, 2, 3 and 5 cents, in both Gourde and Plate currencies, were completely exhausted. Since the American administration had denied the funds for the printing of new stamps, perhaps out of economy due to the ongoing war in Europe, it was decided to overprint the postage stamps in stock, both the normal ones and those already overprinted. This practice was maintained until 1920, creating one of the most curious, and very little aesthetic, philatelic issues known.

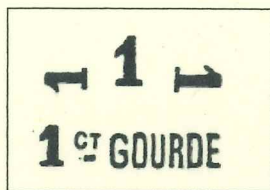

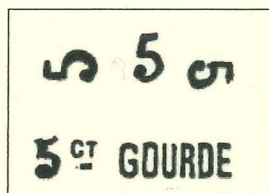

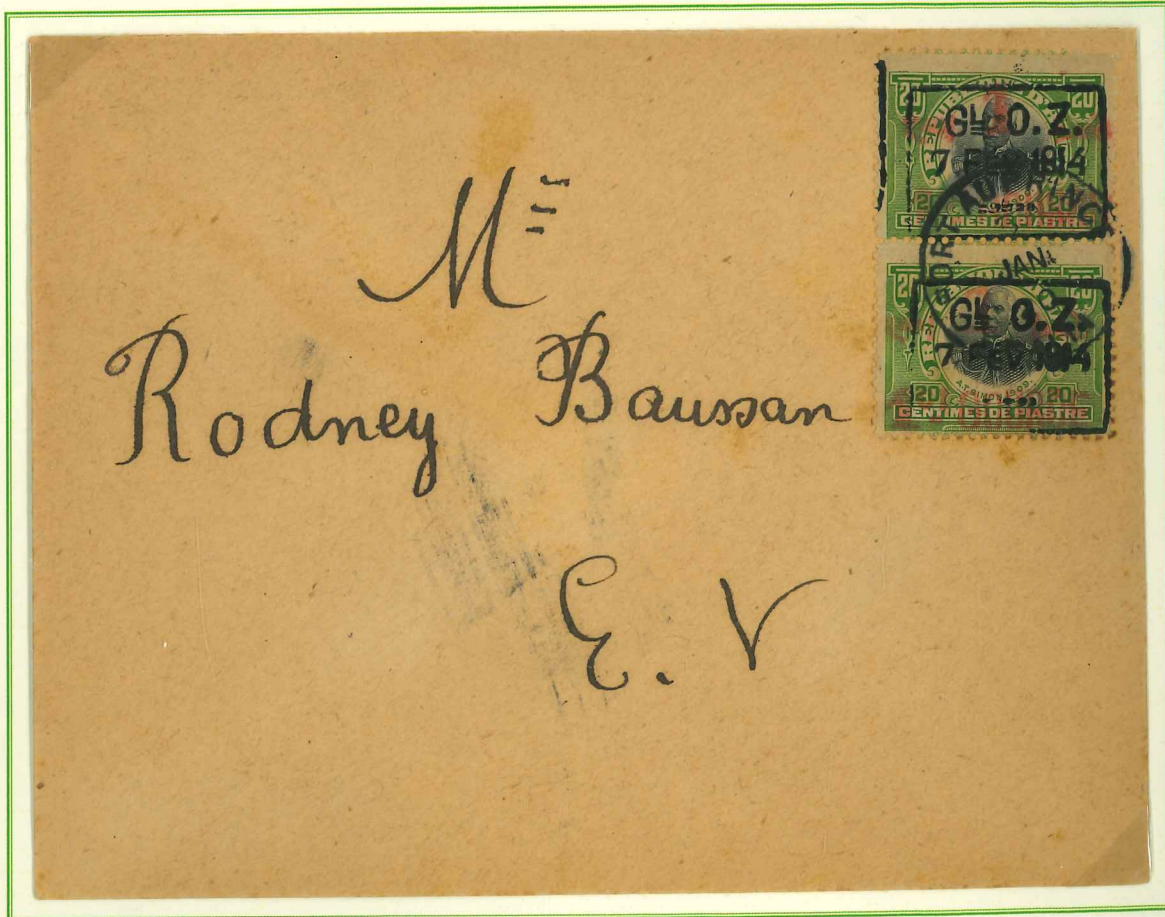

3 January 1920, from Port au Prince locally addressed, rated 2 centimes and franked with a pair of the 5c. stamp bearing double overprint. The stamp is a 20c. of 1910 (president A. T. Simon) overprinted in black in 1914 for General Zamor's presidency and again overprinted in 1917 in red.

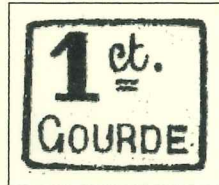
8 December 1918, from Port au Prince locally addressed, rated 5 centimes and franked with a single 5c. stamp bearing double overprint. The stamp is a 1 Piastre of 1906 overprinted in black in 1914 for General Zamor's presidency and again overprinted in 1917 in red brown.

1916-1920, OVERPRINTED PROVISIONAL STAMPS

By mid 1914, the stocks of the lowest-value stamps, 1, 2, 3 and 5 cents, in both Gourde and Plate currencies, were completely exhausted. 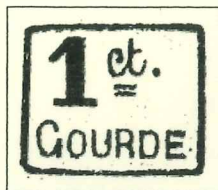

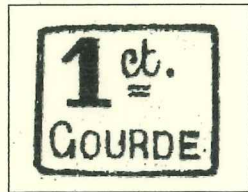

In this group there are stamps prepared for the mail sent abroad, in centimes do Piastre, of the issue with the effigy of Nord Alexis reprinted in 1909 with the wrong date, and then set aside.

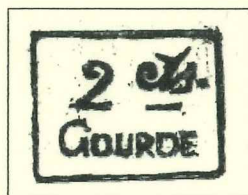

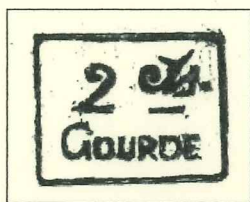

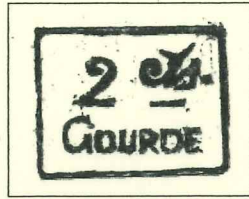

1916-1920, OVERPRINTED PROVISIONAL STAMPS

Following continued unrest in the country and for strategic reasons, the United States decided to intervene by sending an expeditionary force, which landed on July 28, 1915 in Port au Prince. The intervention, which had to be temporary, was also justified as it was intended to protect the new president Sudre Dartigenave, but the occupation lasted until 1934. The postal authorities, while maintaining a certain autonomy, however, had to submit to the directives of the Americans. Thus, being denied funds for a new supply of stamps, they had to resort to the expedient of overprinting the unused stamps in stock. Many of these, having already been overprinted, sometimes bear three different overprints, irreparably disfiguring them.

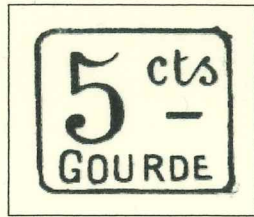

As no more ordinary stamps were available for overprinting, the use of postage due stamps was used to obtain the 5 centime value of Gourde. The overprinting was done in black.
