It is my opinion that the above stamp is SG 141ab from the Thick Ear I Head-plate, State 1.

Confirming Position 21: "Parallel, diagonal (NW) flaw lines 1.5mm to 2mm W of the Queen's 2nd rayon" (Thick Ear I Head-plate flaw).

NOTES: This stamp is genuine, hinged with large part original gum

FAULTS: There are 3 or 4 bluntish perfs on the top margin. Two tiny adhesions on reverse (album page?).
