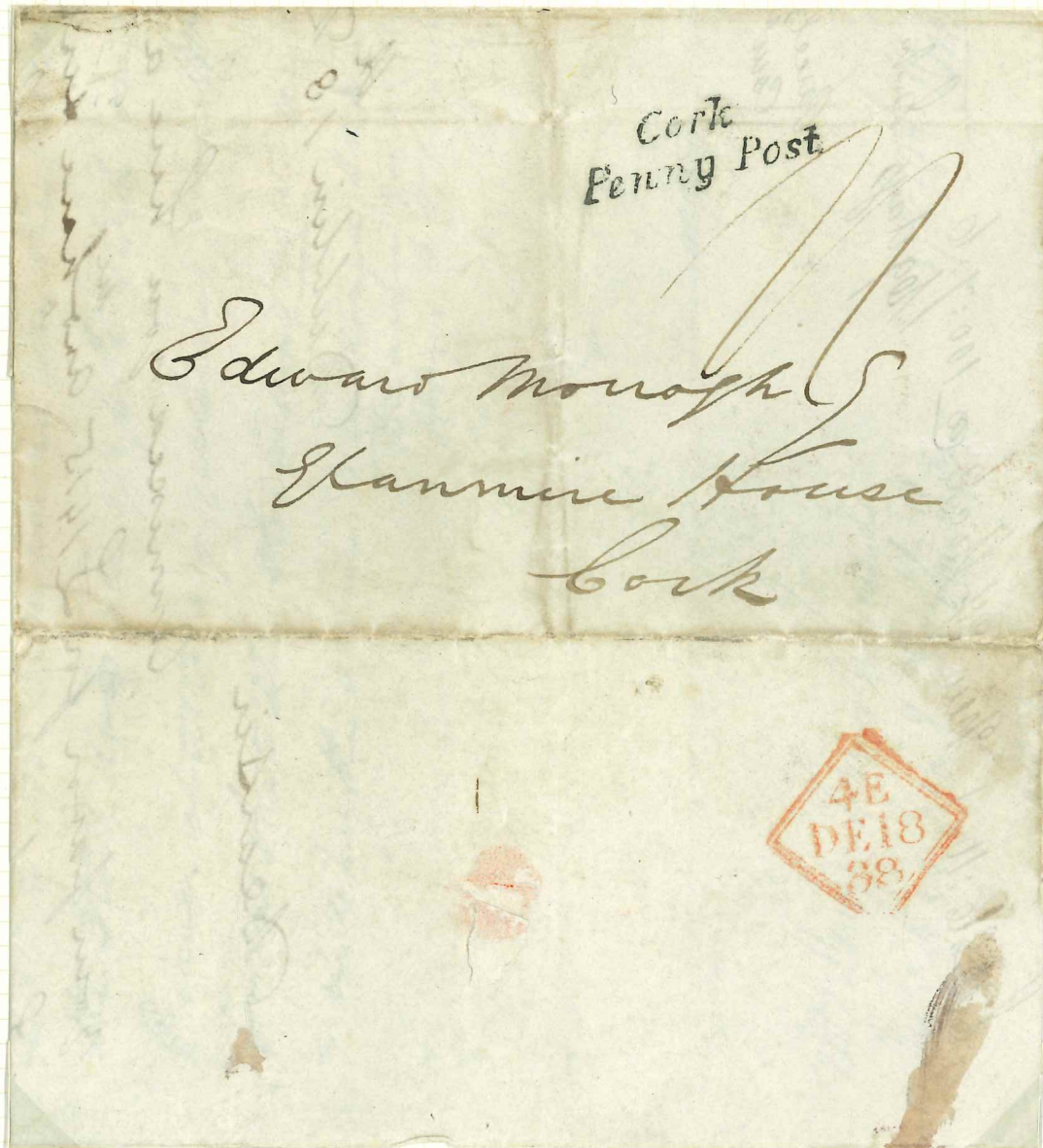


IRISH POSTAL HISTORY.

Provincial Penny Posts.

It was only in March 1832 that the Penny Post was established in the Post Towns.

This letter was written in Dublin 18 December 1838 and bears the Dublin General Post office receiving strike. Elevenpence has been charged for conveyance to Cork (the rate prevailing at that time). Then the letter appears to have been transferred from the general post to the Cork penny post for delivery.
