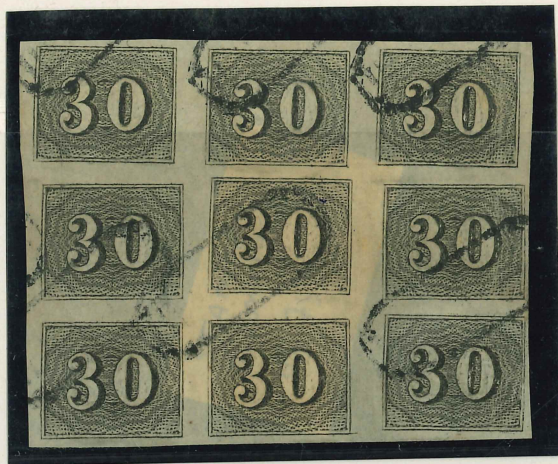

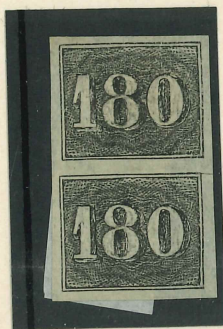

BRESIL/AMB.CALAIS cds (5 May), different framed 'PD' markings in black and in red plus arrival backstamps

I have examined the above item and, in my opinion, it is genuine in all aspects but please read the notes below

Notes: The cover was roughly opened across the back resulting in tears, faults and repairs to two of the 60r pairs. The total postage is 460r which is a 30r overpayment of the 430r rate effective in 1860
