

The Red Blacks and Black Reds of Queen Victoria

Plate 11

Registered in **Red** 27 January 1841 but put-to-press in **Black** on 1 February 1841 delivering 688 sheets.

Printing in **Red** resumed from 3 February 1841 delivering 58,957 sheets.

The last plate printed in both **Black** and **Red** with plate destroyed 15 January 1842.
