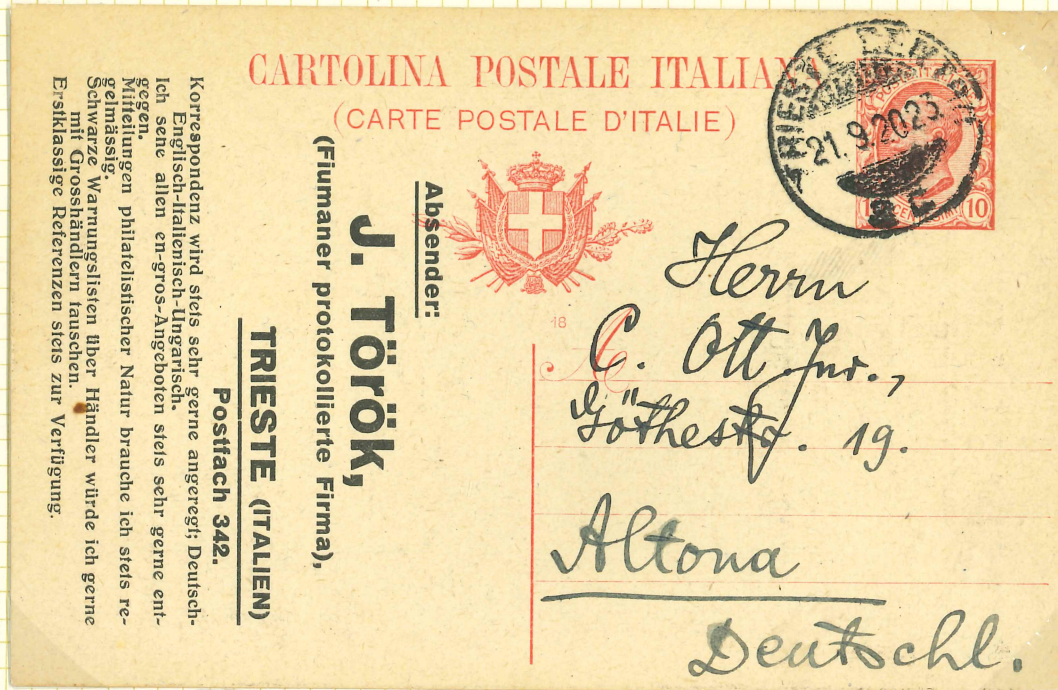

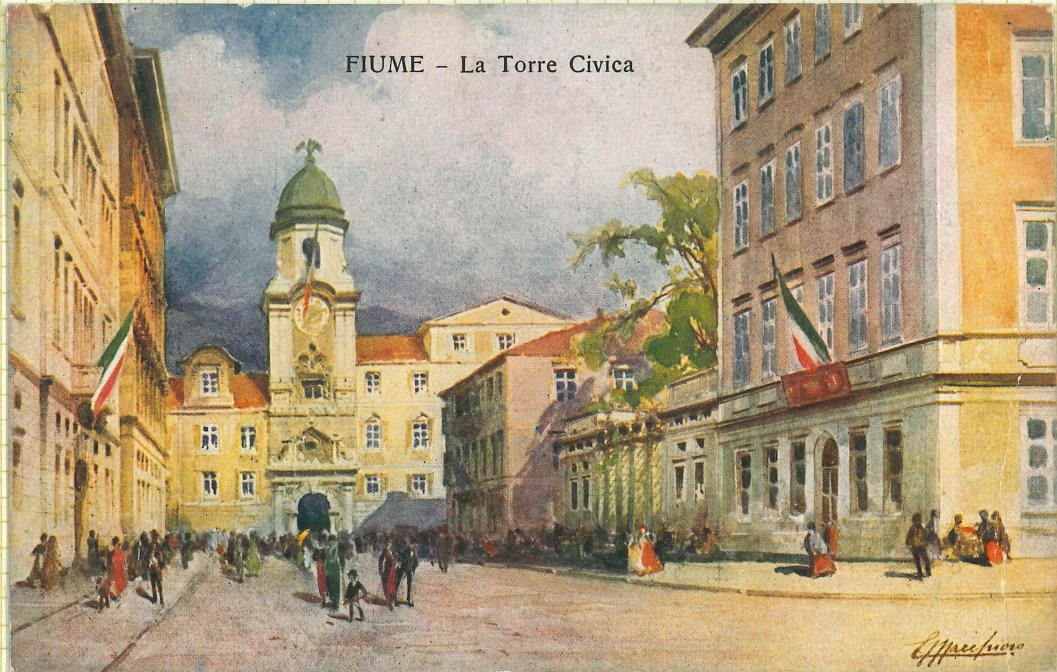

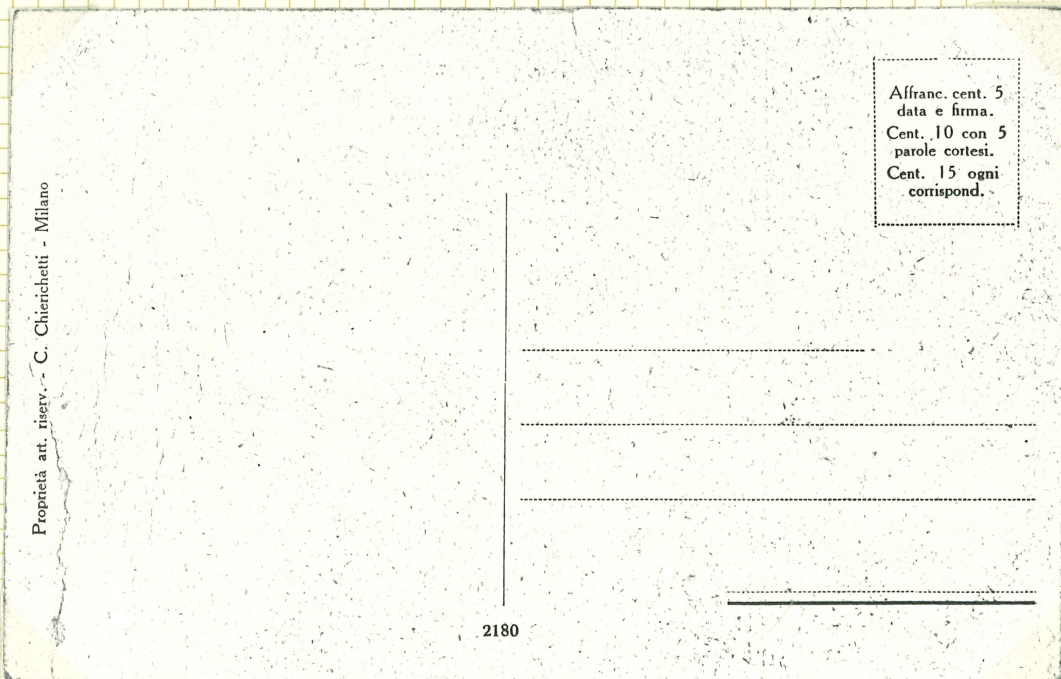

1924 - 43.



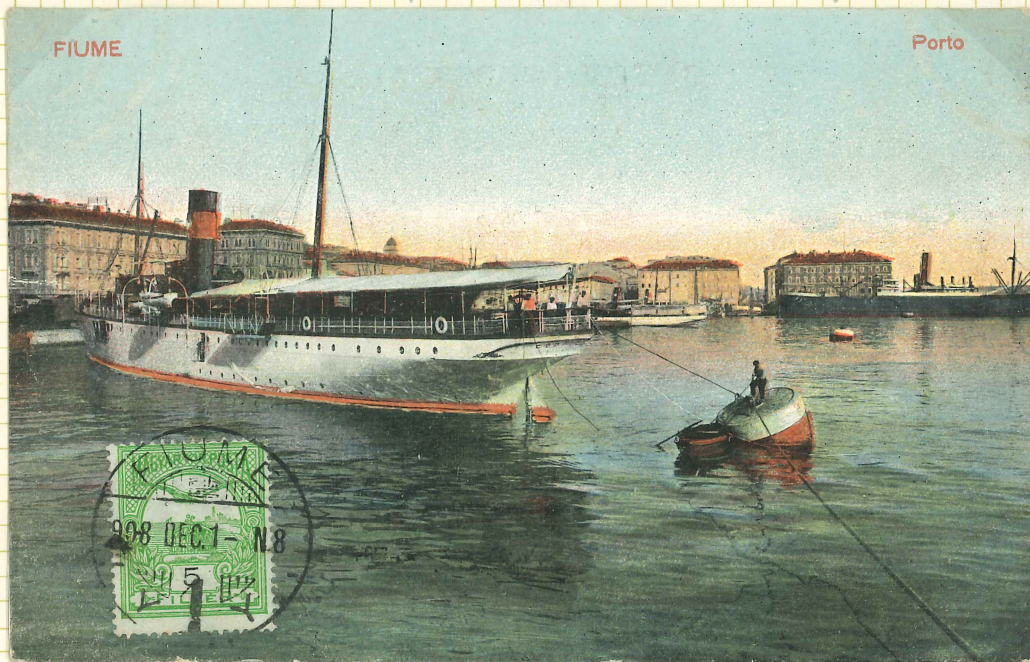

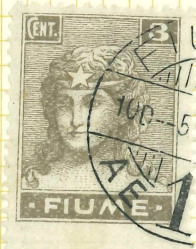
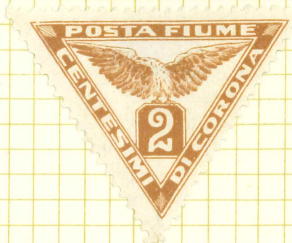

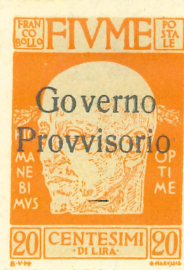


1919-1920. Gabriele D'Annunzio's black-shirted dictatorship - the FRANCO overprints... .. and D'Annunzio's portrait.

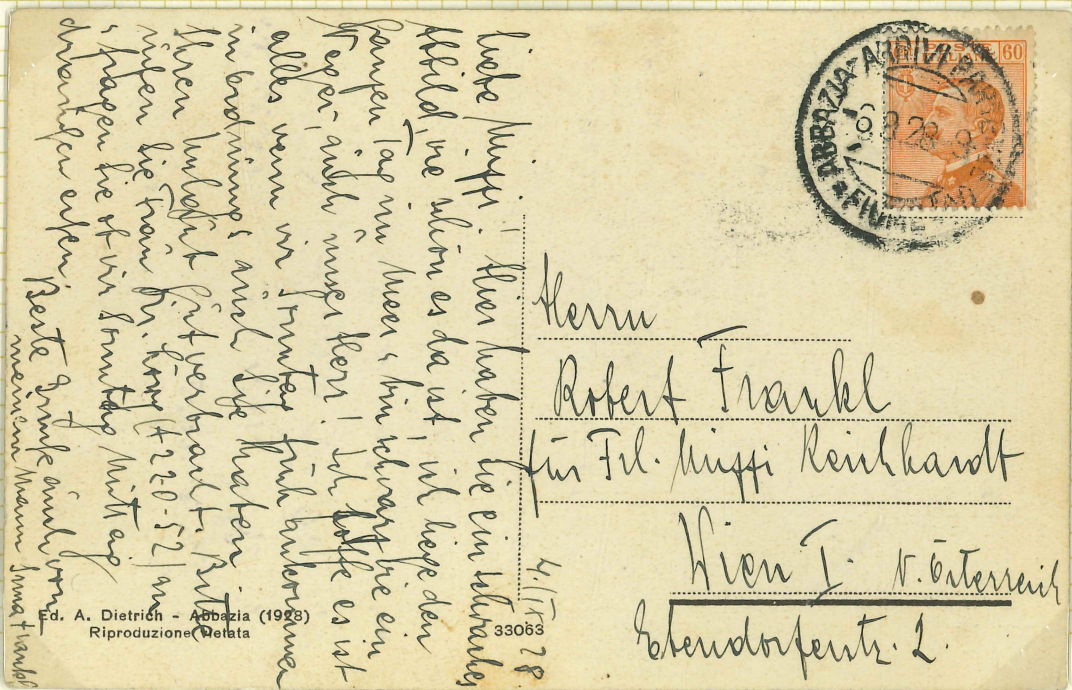

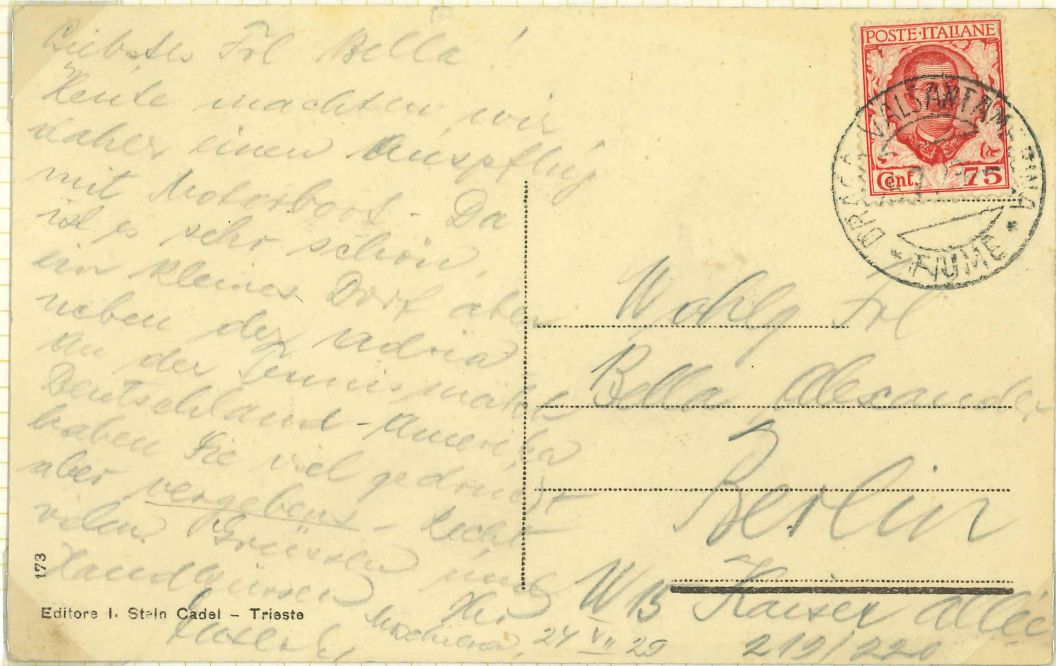

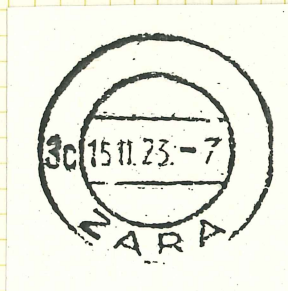
PULA to ZADAR

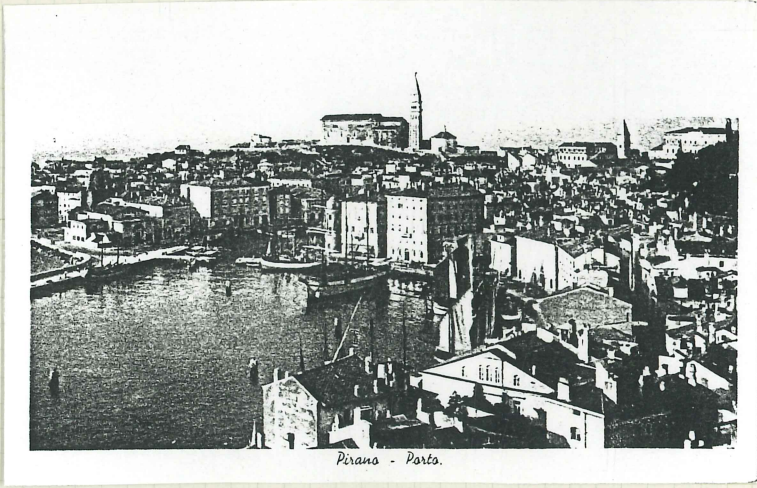
