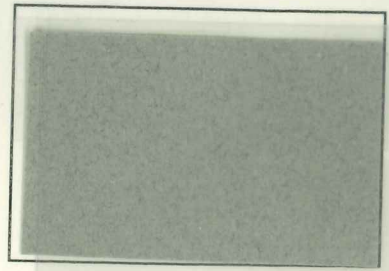

behind head of the King.



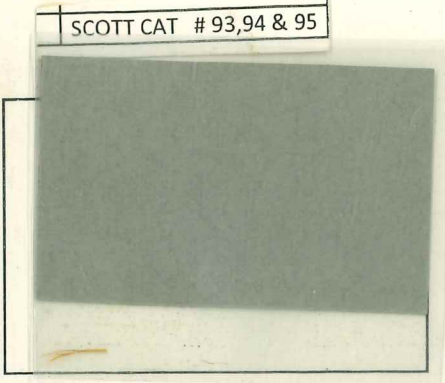
