- 1891, 1/2 anna Blue (shades)
- Litho. at Poona, India
- Thin white wove paper, no wmk., no mesh, no gum, imperf.
- Plate of 64 stamps, four panes of 16 (4 x 4), each stamp laid down on the litho. stone individually. The State was under Imperial administration from January 1888 to November 1891 and it is possible that SG 1/2 may have appeared in late 1887.
- Few covers exist franked SG1/2, but such covers have an undated m/s cancel; other cancels are known on loose stamps.

- Thin white wove paper, no wmk., no gum, imperforate.
- Litho. at Poona, India. Plates of 64 stamps, four panes of 16 (4 x 4). It appears that each of the 64 lithographed stamps were individually laid down on the lithograph stone. Note the different margin settings above and on multiples of both stamps there are "crooked" stamps.
