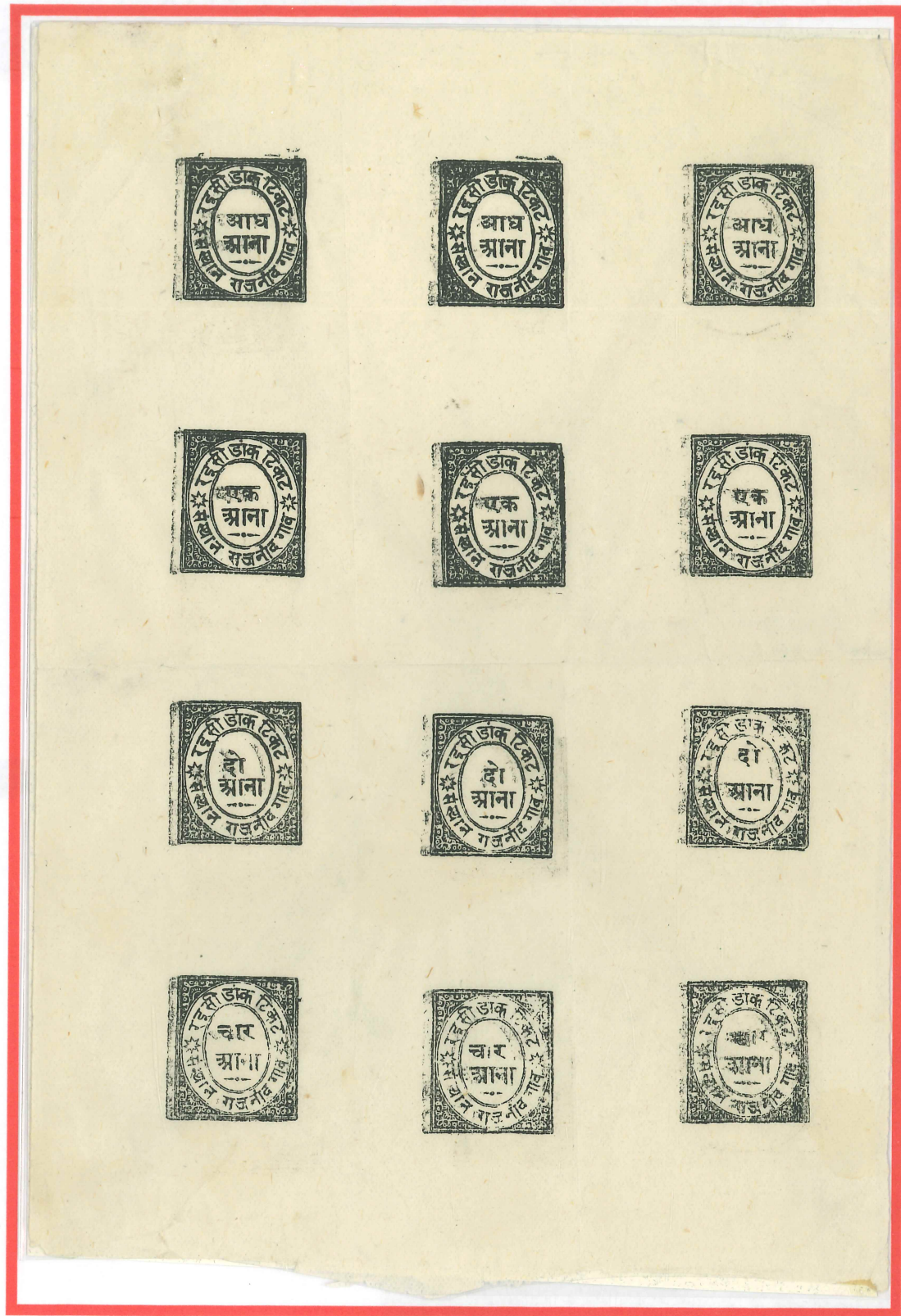

- 1 Jan. 1893, 2 annas Red
- Typo Balram Press, Raj-Nandgaon
- Thin toned wove paper, no wmk., no gum, imperf.
- Printed in sheets of 16 (4 x 4). Stamps printed wide apart (8 to 10 mm) without wavy lines between them

### SG 4

- 1 Jan. 1893, 2 annas Red
- Typo Balram Press, Raj-Nandgaon
- Thin toned wove paper, no wmk., no gum, imperf.
- Printed in sheets of 16 (4 x 4). Stamps printed wide apart (8 to 10 mm) without wavy lines between them

### SG 3

- 1 Jan. 1893, 1/2 anna Dull to Deep Green
- Typo Balram Press, Raj-Nandgaon
- Thin toned wove paper, no wmk., no gum, imperf.
- Printed in sheets of 16 (4 x 4). Stamps printed wide apart (8 to 10 mm) without wavy lines between them.

### SG 4a

- 1 Jan. 1893, 2 annas Dull Rose
- Typo Balram Press, Raj-Nandgaon
- Thin toned wove paper, no wmk., no gum, imperf.
- Printed in sheets of 16 (4 x 4). Stamps printed wide apart (8 to 10 mm) without wavy lines between them
