

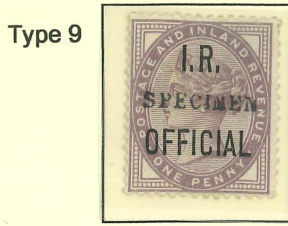
INLAND REVENUE OFFICIAL SPECIMEN TYPES 9, 11, 15 AND 16

Some QV OFFICIAL stamps remained in use until 1904 in Edward VII 's period.

One INLAND REVENUE stamp, 2½d, was not introduced until 1902, over a year after EVII had come to the throne.
