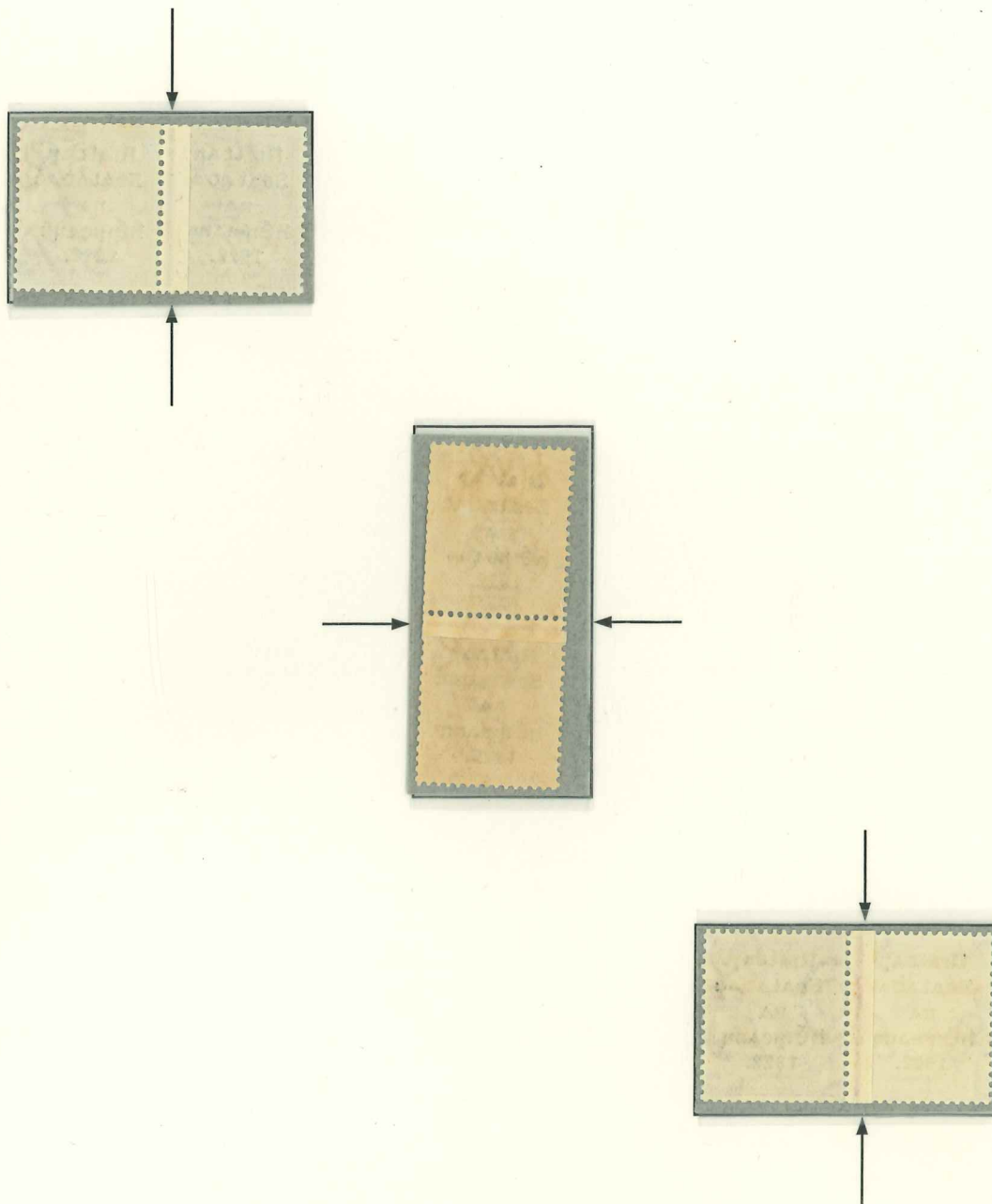

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COIL JOIN PAIRS

Harrison was the only company to produce coil stamps.
Perforated sheets of 240 were overprinted, sheared into horizontal or
vertical strips and joined by trimmed margins to form coil rolls.
