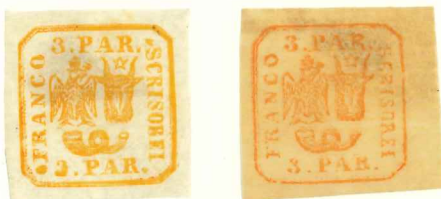

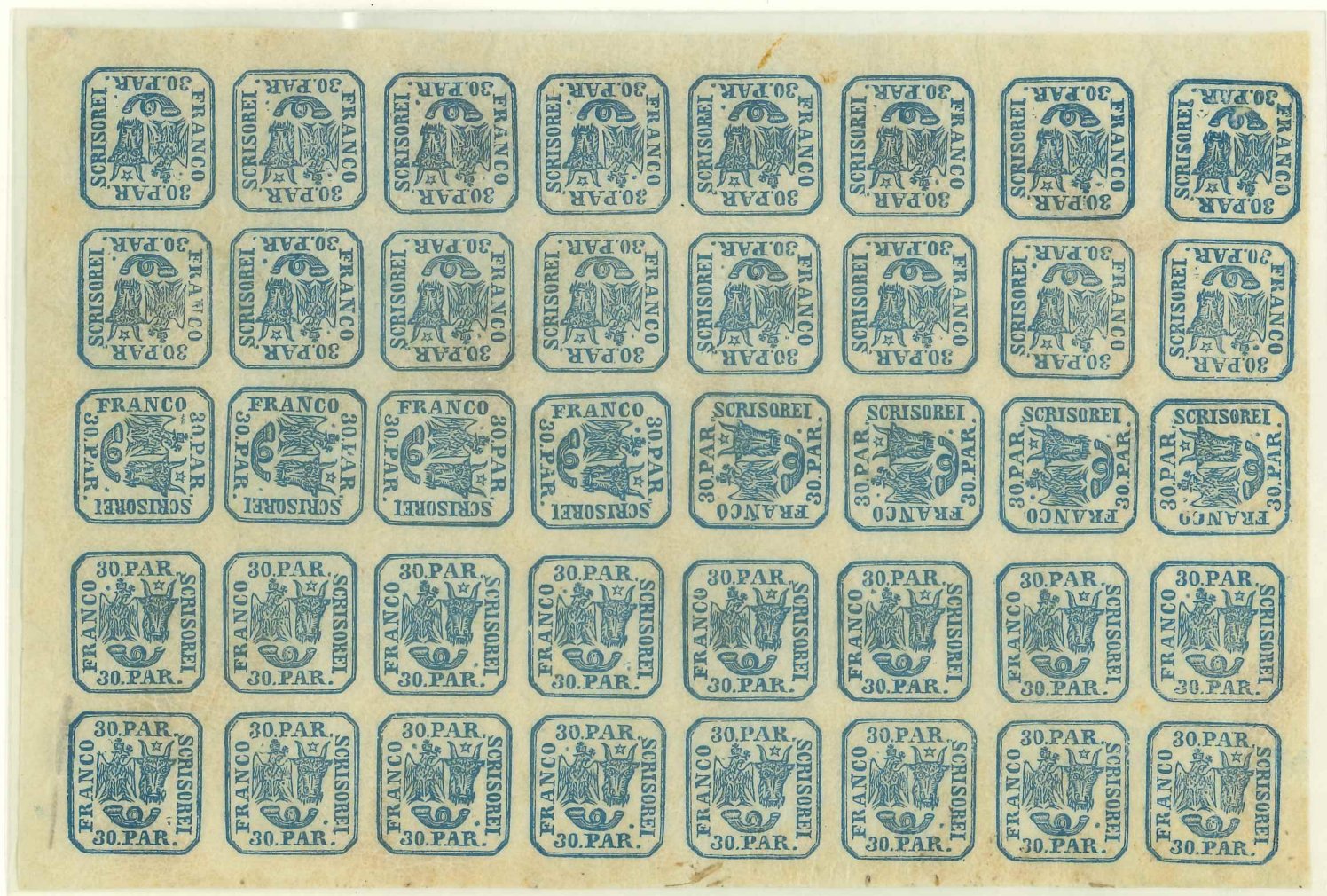

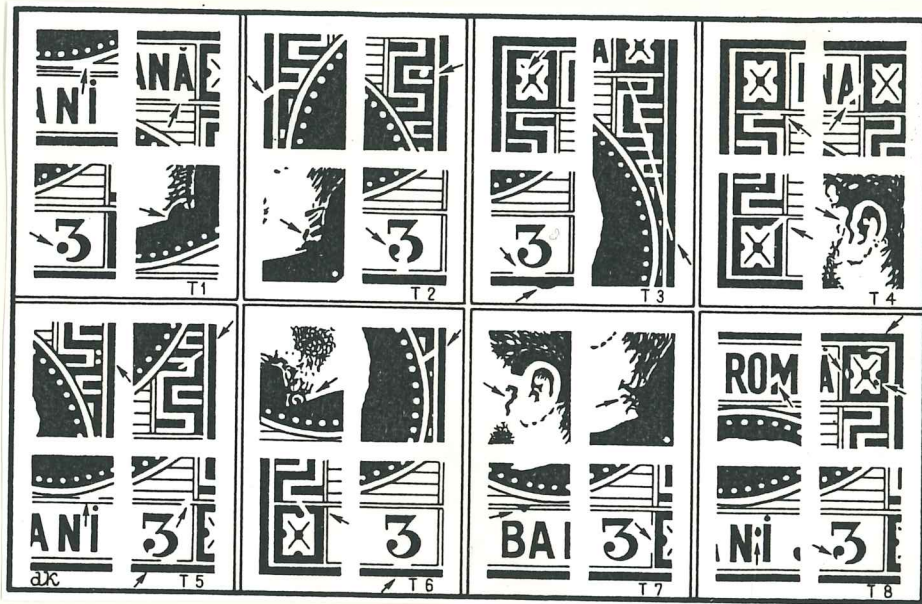
Reconstructed block of the setting of the two bani value.

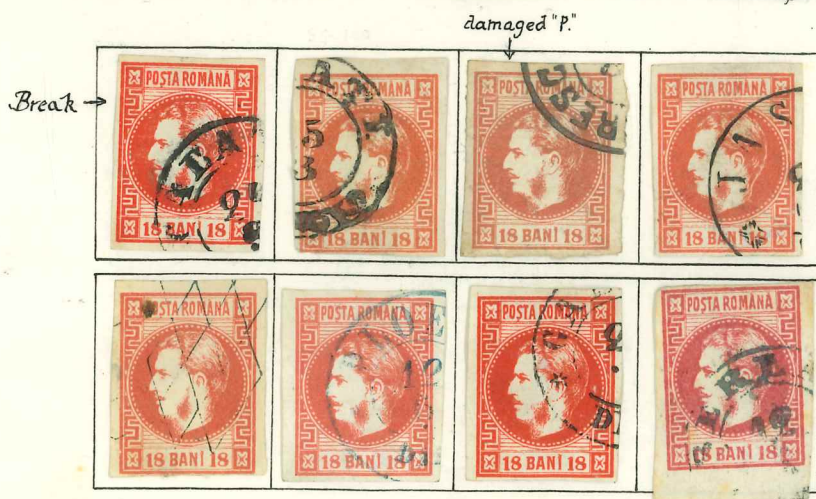
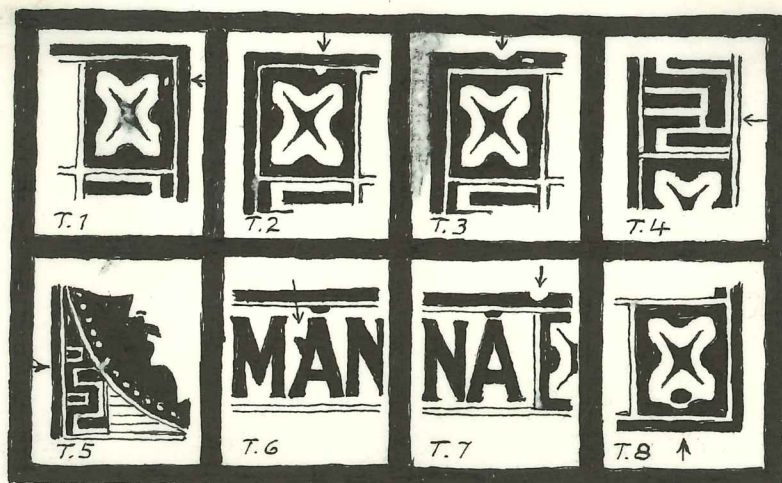
